They tweeted: "White flag! Not doing it! Not going to beat that!"



Ferrari's new California!

The Prancing Horse has steroided its drop top with two turbos and 50 per cent more torques!

- More torque, faster to 62mph and yet less of a thirsty drinker, Ferrari's new California "T" is all about improvements below the bodyshell. But the bit you'll really notice is that this is the first Ferrari equipped with real turbocharged power since 1987's iconic F40. Hence the "T", you see?
- So, for your £153,000 you'll receive a front-engined, drop-top head turner that wears a new Hollywood smile for a grille, and deeper-defined cheek dimples (air intakes) on either side.
- In the name of feeding the twin turbos fresh air, the bonnet has now gained a pair of sculpted vents. Minor tweaks have been made to the side profile and,
- although the rear is still unmistakably a Cali, there's now a new jagged triple-toothed diffuser panel to aid stability when pushing towards the upper limits of its 196mph (3.0mph better than the outgoing Cali).
- It's not easy to make a turbo car howl like a supercar, but a three-piece cast exhaust manifold and flat-plane crankshaft will





- apparently wake the neighbours in that special way that a Ferrari should.
- The RHT (horrid Ferrari speak for the retractable hard top roof) does its thing in 14 seconds to fully unveil a cabin that packs a 6.5in central display touchscreen infotainment system that's said to have been co-developed with Apple's design-obsessed nerds.
- Beyond the trademark, splendidly supple leather, steering wheel-mounted hooligan switches and huge gearshift paddles, there's also a Turbo Performance Engineer display. In English, that's a gauge between the vent pods that displays a percentage figure of what turbo boost is available at any given time. Does anyone remember Outrun?
- Screwing on those turbos means that the Cali is now packing 62bhp more than the old model, with a swell of 49 per cent extra torque over the previous car's 372lb-ft. All of that adds up to it being only 10bhp, 2.0mph and 0.2 secs (0-62) behind the midmotor 458 Italia Spider – and it's a whopping 25 grand cheaper!





They took the entire toe off, right down to the ball and half my instep, and had to do a skin graft. Basically, the blister had turned into an ulcer and made a bit of a mess inside my foot."

I'm not talking about this. I don't even have a bum. My legs go straight into my back. I don't even fart!

Would you be better behaved in real life if you had to report into a *Big Brother*-style diary room every day?

It was crazy. We had a measure up and he got jealous so he kicked me in the face. Ha! It knocked me out. It put me on my bum.


Has it had any long-lasting effect on you? Horsey nightmares, maybe?

ello Joel, tell us how you became a Navy SEAL?

When I was ten years old, I heard a story about one of my father's friends who had attempted Navy SEAL training. He took part in an exercise where his hands and feet were tied behind his back, he was thrown into the deep end of a swimming pool and basically told to survive. Every time I would go into the pool, I would think of ways I could get out of a similar situation. Fast-forward to my early 20s and I still wanted to test those survival instincts. So I sold everything I owned and trained for a year.

What's the process for becoming a Navy SEAL?

First, I had a daily BUD/S training program [Basic Underwater Demolition/SEAL]. That consisted of running five miles in boots, swimming a mile in fins, then doing 400 push-ups, 500 sit-ups and a couple of hundred pullups. That was four days a week and was brutal.

Were you ever in genuine danger in training?

Yeah, this one time we were doing the "double duck", which is where you parachute two Zodiac boats into the ocean and skydive after them. The weather was really bad that day and as I opened my parachute, the winds picked up unexpectedly. I wasn't able to remove my leg straps before hitting the water, so was dragged through the ocean by my 'chute. Just as I managed to get them off I realised my cords were completely tangled around me. To

make matters worse, the parachute started to sink, pulling me down with it.

How did you get out alive?

I blew my emergency whistle but the rescue boats were helping out another trainee. I was thinking: "This is it. I'm going to die." When help finally arrived, I'd been underwater for several minutes. I climbed onto the boat, took a moment, and then jumped back into the water to complete the exercise.

Why did you continue?


You can't dwell on setbacks. It doesn't matter whether you're in a training exercise or a combat situation – a truly skilled warrior replaces his fear with focus.

What made you agree to take part in new survival TV show *Manhunt*?

A friend got in touch and said he knew someone looking for someone with a survival background. I sent my information over to the producer, who called me back. I found out he was an ex-Special Forces soldier – not your typical Hollywood type. We wanted it to be a genuine escape and

evasion scenario – and believe me, this is as real as it gets.

There's genuine jeopardy?

I have no weapons, support, food, water or communications and have 48 hours to make it through enemy territory to an extraction point. We're up against genuine tracking units.

Were you familiar with the units you were up against?

Yes, but even though they all had fierce reputations, I couldn't allow myself to be intimidated. The moment they get into your head, they've won. Before every mission I researched each team thoroughly. I wanted to identify their strengths so I can avoid them and their weaknesses so I could exploit them.

What was the biggest challenge you faced?

The most difficult thing was trying to stop clueless cameramen from giving away my location! Being ex-military, my producer was a real asset, but the guys doing the filming were not. There was a tense dynamic between me and the crew, because they were trying to make a TV show and I was trying to evade capture.

Do you have any horror stories from the filming?

We were in Panama travelling by boat in the middle of the night when a flying fish leapt across our vessel. We were laughing about it when I realised our producer Brian wasn't speaking. I shone my torch on him and saw his face was covered in blood. We all assumed the fish had cut him, but he was rushed to surgery and we were told the fish had pierced through his neck, and was lodged a centimetre away from his carotid artery. Surgeons had to go in from the other side of his neck and pull the fish through.

Blimey! So it's quite intense stuff...

Absolutely. I took quite a battering. Every morning, my bed sheets would be soaked in blood!

How did you manage to evade capture?

I find the best countertracking manoeuvre is simply to get inside the trackers' heads. They think I'm the prey but, if you're smart, you can turn that around and gain the advantage.

So how would you turn the tables on them?

Setting up booby traps is effective. They aren't deadly, but they do slow the trackers down. In the Philippines, I set a trap where a sapling springs out when someone steps into a trip wire.

Thanks, Joel, finally, in all honesty, could anyone become a Navy SEAL?

Yes and no. There's limitless potential in every one of us, but the cost of achieving that potential is so high that few of us will ever achieve it.



Man City vs Barca: head to head!

Footy genius Jonathan Pearce runs the rule over the two teams!

IT'S THE tie that's got the football world salivating:
Catalan giants Barcelona –
Messi 'n' Neymar 'n' all – taking on Manchester City's megabucks men, who are breaking goalscoring records for fun. Who can predict how this epic clash will end up over two legs? We certainly can't, but thankfully we have the expertise of Radio 5Live commentator and all-round football oracle Jonathan Pearce to call upon...

Manchester City vs Barcelona,
 Tuesday 18 February ITV/HD 7 45pm



Manuel Pellegrini's team may be heading for a record number of goals by an topflight English team, but he hates conceding even a single goal at the other end. Yet he persists with Demichelis when it's clear his majestic Bayern Munich days are long gone. His Champions League track record is crucial, however, having taken Villarreal to the semis and rank outsiders Malaga to the guarter-finals.

RATING: 9/10

Joe Hart has rediscovered his form after being dropped following his impetuous mistakes earlier this season. He is commanding his defence, making sound decisions and coming up with brilliant saves again. His stop from Loïc Rémy was simply breathtaking in his magnificent performance at Newcastle last month. England fans need not worry about him – he's back to his best.

RATING: 9/10

Gerardo Martino became the club's first coach to go unbeaten in his first 20 games since becoming gaffer in the summer, after taking Newell's Old Boys to the Copa Libertadores semi-finals. In this battle between two South American tacticians, he likes his team to press high and attack with pace. He beat Real Madrid in the first Clasico of the season, but he's unproven in Europe. RATING: 8/10



Victor Valdés rarely grabs
the headlines at the Nou
Camp but he's been as steady
as ever, moving beyond the
500-game mark for the
Catalans and was recently
voted the fifth best keeper
on the planet. He was
significantly missing with
a calf strain when they lost
2-1 at Ajax in November.
Not very strong in the air.
Will be uncomfortable
during City corners.
RATING: 8/10

They are over-reliant on Vincent Kompany, and Martin Demichelis vs Lionel Messi is an accident waiting to happen. The central defenders will need to be protected from the "tikitaka" quick passing around the box, so the defensive-midfield area will be crucial, as the back four concedes too many goals. Norwich's Nathan Redmond exposed a lack of pace in the full-backs. Pedro will relish that. **RATING: 8/10**

They have sumptuous flair to match Barcelona when they're at their best. But they've missed Nasri's guile and Jesus Navas is beginning to look like he's played a lot of football this season - more than any other City outfield player. The fitness of Fernandinho is vital. He can anchor the midfield and let Touré bomb forward. Yaya's

refined finishing power this

season will swing it City's way.

RATING: 9/10

They'll be the first top-flight team since Liverpool more than 30 years ago to have three players with 20-plus in all competitions when Edin Džeko reaches that tally. Álvaro Negredo has already passed that mark and Sergio Agüero should hit 30 - City have to have him fit for the tie. Negredo and Džeko could destroy Barcelona in the air. Agüero can run them ragged if he's fit. **RATING: 10/10**

Yaya Touré is persistently City's man when it comes to the big, big games. Agüero's fitness race to get fit in time for the match will definitely hog the headlines. He's one of the four best players in the world, so the Argentine will be crucial. So will Džeko and Negredo in the air. But I have a sneaky feeling that Touré could well prove decisive and will burst through to get the decisive goal.



Alves, Pique, Mascherano and Alba are still their best back four. Their three defeats this season have come when they haven't fielded that quartet. Bayern Munich shredded them in last season's semi-final when Mascherano was missing. City will study that and Valencia's recent win, when Barca were exposed in the air. Álvaro Negredo and Edin Džeko will be licking their lips.

uts SPORT

Xavi and Iniesta are hitting form. Pedro has lightning pace. Fabregas will create and score. Busquets will sit behind the rest to protect the defence. They have bewitching skill and variety. They could pass City to death if they get the chance. But do they have anyone who can track and physically deal with Yaya Touré? I don't think Busquets will handle him. That's the key to the tie.

For me, Lionel Messi is still the best player in the world. Critics say his two-month injury break has blunted the Argentine. He scored eight goals in his first ten games back - if that's blunt imagine him sharp! Neymar has had recent injury concerns, too, but can win a game in the blink of an eye. Chile's Alexis Sánchez has also weighed in with 14 goals of his own. They can be frightening.

RATING: 10/10

It has to be Lionel Messi you simply can't look beyond the best player in the world. A hat-trick destroyed Ajax at home and three strikes against Milan earned four crucial points against the Italian side. City must shackle him at home to have any hope of coming away with a result. When he's scored at the Nou Camp, they've subsequently only lost one of those 107 games.

PEARCE'S FINAL VERDICT! Pellegrini's extra Champions League experience will count, as will City's danger in the air against a suspect Barcelona defence. But I fully expect the Catalans to score at the Etihad, without a doubt. They might even get two. But City can match that if they're on form and catch them with set pieces at the Nou Camp. Look to Yaya to produce the winner. A draw and then a City win will pay out at 11/2 in some places. I'm on board!


Is it true you and Xabi Alonso used to play football on the beach as kids?

Thanks for the chat, Mikel, Finally then, is it only Arsene Wenger who's allowed those long coats?


The big zippy one? He's got a real problem with that zip – he really could do with getting a new coat, to be honest. I could actually use one now as well, it's really cold in here!


