Looking at your photos what is it that you would like to get across to anyone looking at them: I'd like to portray as much sexuality as possible without appearing classless. I am an extremely sexual person and I think that is a very natural thing that not many people understand in our culture today. I'd also like to show that staying in shape is a key part of being healthy and that improving your beauty isn't always a bad, narcissistic thing.

How do you come up with such sexy outfits: I am always on the hunt for new sexy outfits! I look for things that will flatter me as well as be a little different from anything else I have seen. I came up with the 'Tara Babcock' shirts because, besides underboob shirts looking HOT on me, I knew it would be a good marketing ploy and I knew I didn't want to be just another pretty face in the industry. Can you think of the one think that you would love to see in an upcoming photo shoot: I would love to shoot a cheerleader themed set! I used to cheer when I was younger and I like to try and keep the flexibility and the skills. Maybe some action shots in mid-jump or while doing the splits. I even have two Tara Babcock cheer outfits that I made (yes, I make my own clothing sometimes) one in red and one in blue! They're super cute!

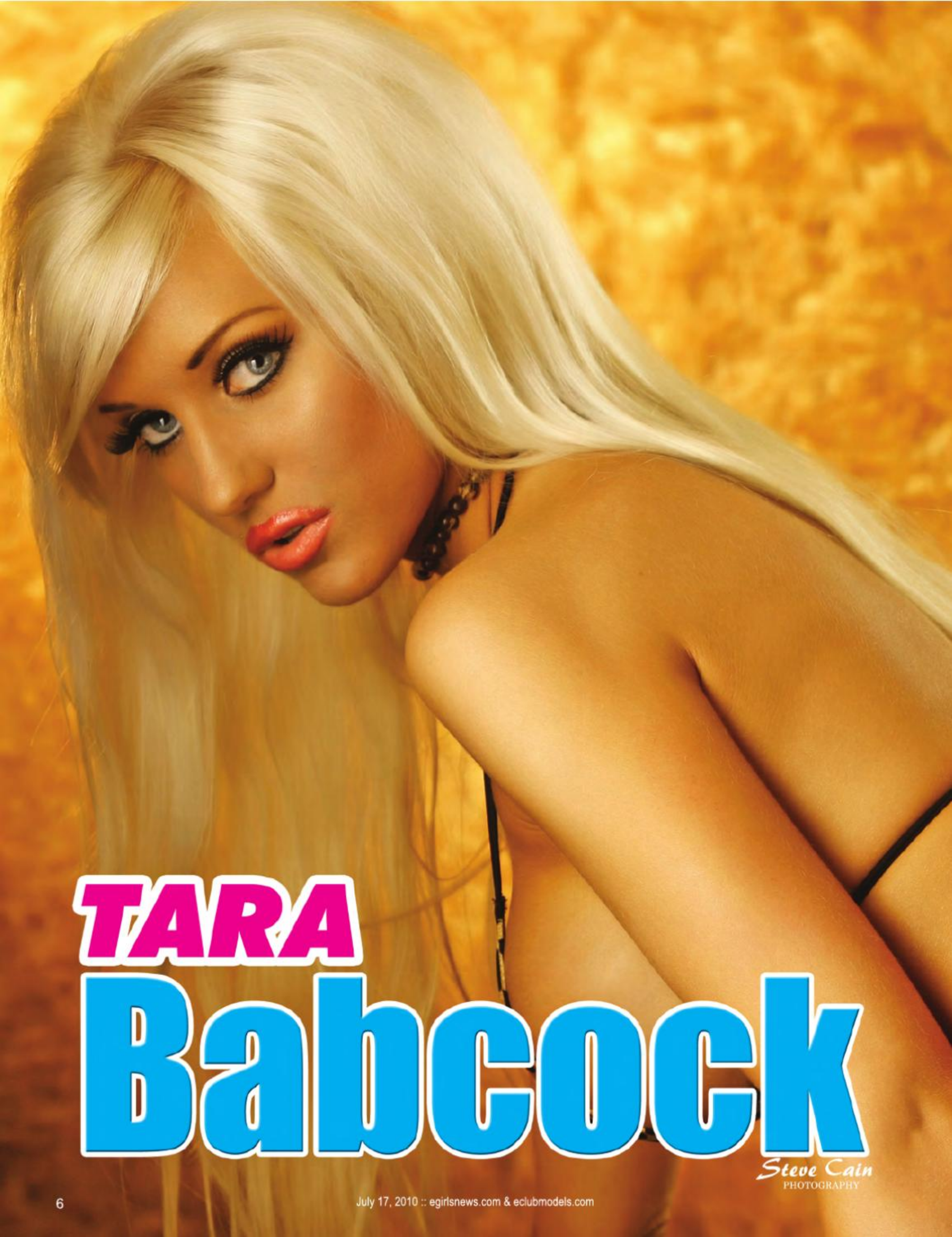

I know that as a model my fans definitely make a big impact on my career and that they are my support backbone. They make me smile and their unique personalities are intriguing. I have worked conventions with girls, often even amateurs, and they treat their fans with such disrespect as if they are better than them. I always stay modest and grateful to the people who've helped me. Secondly, I am not out partying on the weekend or out in the club (unless I am paid to host) like many models. I don't drink or do drugs. I am very career-focused and I have more respect for my body and self image. Also, I'm very business-minded and instead of letting a company control my name I have kept all my contracts non-exclusive and I've marketed my own career as well as making good networks. Finally, I actually look as I do in my images. I get a lot of compliments from clients on this topic. I hate misrepresentation and improving my look and body are some of my biggest hobbies.

How can a guy get your attention? What kind of man do you usually go for: Mostly, a guy can get my attention by just being sexy. I am not looking for a relationship beyond a safe and trusting friendship with benefits right now so what mostly interests me right now is looks. I love large muscles and I like my guys to be tall with dark hair. I love it when a man makes me feel tiny and protected and I like guys who are a bit possessive, within reason. Weird, I know. Some turn offs are bad hygiene, an obvious lack of intelligence and disrespect and being ugly of course. Ha-ha!

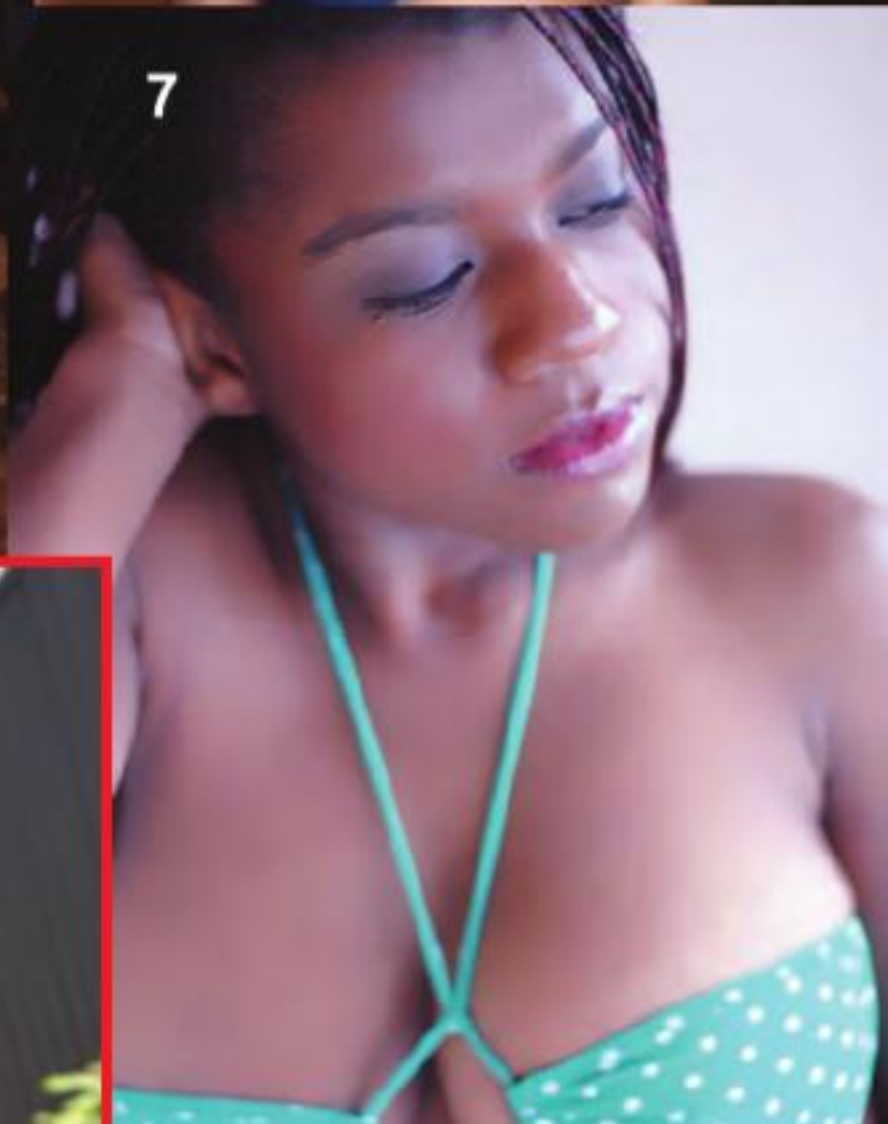
Are you finding face book better or worse than, My Space, OMP, Model Mayhem or some of the other networking models web sites?
