

Edward Thomas Hardy was born in 1977, in Hammersmith, London into a family of artists. Growing up, Hardy rebelled against the suburban mentality and strict boarding school rules. An alcohol abuse problem dominated his teenage years, got him expelled from private schools, and often led him to jail for disorderly conduct. Hardy went so far to face criminal charges for car theft and gun possession during those years. He escaped doing hard time, he later said, only because his friend in crime turned out to be the son of a British diplomat. When he turned 19, his distinguishing physique landed him a win in a supermodel search competition on the show "The Big Breakfast", which started a short modeling career. However, he decided to shift his focus to acting, so he enrolled in Richmond College for the Performing Arts. Troublesome Hardy wound up getting expelled again for skipping classes. He also studied Method acting at Drama Centre in London. He never stopped living on impulse, though: his acting studies got cut short after winning a part in Tom Hanks and Steven Spielberg's ambitious "Band of Brothers," the HBO miniseries on the U.S. Army company during their journeys in WWII. The next big break got him world wide recognition in Ridley Scott's "Black Hawk Down" in 2001, and the military "theme" in his career went on as he played the lead in the French Foreign Legion drama "An English Legionnaire" the following year. His acting career took off and he starred alongside Gael Garcia in "Dot the !" and played the role of Jean-Luc Picard's clone in "Star Trek Nemesis". In 2003 he appeared in a thriller "LD 50 Lethal Dose" but also discovered theatre, which earned him the "London Evening Standard Theatre"

On the other hand, the rising star's private life was a mess to say the least. From the age of 13, the actor battled both alcohol and drug addiction and ultimately had to juggle his work and his addiction. "I didn't want anyone to know I was out of control, but I couldn't hide it," he said. "Eventually, the body gives up. I was completely kaput.

I was lucky I didn't get hepatitis or AIDS." It was in 2003 that Hardy hit rock bottom: after wallowing in crack and cocaine, he woke up one morning lying on a street in a puddle of his own blood and vomit. The troubled Hardy decided to finally seek help and go into rehab. He decided to substitute his addiction with his work. The actor admits that "...there is still a gorilla in underpants" inside him and that playing a specific kind of roles helps him get rid of the restless energy he carries within.

In 2008 another world-wide hit found him; he starred in Guy Ritchie's "RocknRolla", where he played a gay gangster. This began a series of hardy roles in which he gave texture and depth to nasty and mean characters: the offensive Bill Sikes in a BBC retread of "Oliver Twist" and a real-life notoriously violent British convict Charles Bronson in a movie "Bronson," which landed him the "British Independent Film" award for best actor.

While preparing for the role, Hardy actually met with Charles Bronson himself and in the interviews that followed their meeting, Hardy admitted that it was hard to understand the state of mind of a man who has been in solitary confinement, in maximum security, for 34 years, but that he ultimately managed to find a connection. "I'm from East Sheen, I went to public school where I learned Latin at the age of nine, and certain expectations were made of me to go to St Paul's, Oxbridge maybe, and all that kind of thing. And I failed systematically to meet the mark – who I am and what I should have been are too very different things. But I began to realize that for Charlie it's exactly the same," the actor confessed.



In order to prepare for the role, he had to gain 42 pounds. This was quite a challenge especially since he had to change his weight three times in 2007: first he lost 28 pounds for "Stuart: A Life Backwards", then he put on 42 pounds for a role in a movie that got cancelled. "I was a mess after 'Bronson'. I got really fat. I was a real road crash. So my personal trainer friend Pnut had the problem of getting the rust off me. By the time I went to Pittsburgh to film my next role in "Warrior" I had two hours of boxing, two hours of muay thai, two hours of jiu jitsu, two hours of choreography and two hours of weight lifting a day, every day for eight weeks. I don't know how people do that every day," the actor admits. But all his sacrifice was not for nothing: his role in Bronson caught the attention of Hollywood's studios, and magazine "Variety" included him in 2009 on its list of "Top 10 Actors to Watch". He starred in the Oscar nominated "Tinker, Tailor, Soldier, Spy" and "Warrior" in 2011, and in the years that followed, Christopher Nolan cast him in "Inception" and "The Dark Knight Rises". His portrayal of the Bane character is probably his most memorable role, not just because of how he looked but because of the physical scenes that he had to do in the film while wearing a heavy and restricting costume and a metal mask. "Bane's fighting style is brutal and military," he explains. "It's more military in many ways. MMA [Mixed Martial Arts] is very athletic. It's an athlete's sport.

And you've got your Krav Maga and whatnot from Bourne, the Bourne world. Very tight movement, very contained but aimed to kill. And maim. Then you've got the Keysi lot that Batman does I sup-

pose, which is a lot of elbow business. But Bane is brutal. It's not about fighting. It's about just carnage with Bane." It's interesting that playing Bane made Tom Hardy the only actor to play a villain in both a Batman film and in a Star Trek film. At the moment, the actor is really busy; he's working on the movie "Legend", where he plays the roles of the identical twin gangsters, and had recently finished filming the lead in "Mad Max: Fury Road". Mel Gibson who?!

Hollywood stars who battle addiction

David Hasselhoff struggled with alcoholism since the early 70s, and Robert Downey Jr. tried drugs at the age of six. Kirsten Dunst, Drew Barrymore and Lindsay Lohan are known for notoriously checking in and out of rehab. Heath Ledger, Brittany Murphy and Philip Hoffman lost the battle with addiction. The celebrity status that these stars enjoy makes it that much easier to get hold of the drugs and alcohol at any time, anywhere. While doing a concert performance, Whitney Houston used to have her "pusher man" come to her from the audience to the stage, as a fan, and ask her for an autograph. He would hand her a paper and pen filled with an illegal drug



that she would keep after signing the autograph. The latest rage in Hollywood are the prescription drugs such as diet pills and pain killers. Angelina Jolie and Mellanie Griffith are some of the stars that use them.

But ultimately, no one can hold the candle to the infamous Charlie Sheen. Rumor has it that he is used to spending nearly 2000 \$ a day on drugs, not to mention his other addiction of a more intimate nature.



Oregon 1963. Randle
Patrick McMurphy is
sentenced to a fairly
short prison term.
However, he decides to
declare himself insane

in order to be transferred to a mental institution where he is going to serve his term free of prison harassment and labor. Nurse Ratched Fletcher runs the ward of the mental institution where McMurphy is transferred. She managed to intimidate all of other patients and now they are her subordinates and the institutionalized behavior, since they are all believed to be insane. The big question is just how sane any of the patients in the ward actually are. McMurphy's best friends in the ward are Billy Bibbit, a suicidal infantile man who stutters all the time, and Chef Bromden, a 6'5" tall schizophrenic Native American who is deaf and does not speak. Though considered a bit slow because of his "deficit", Chef is appreciated

for his masculinity and size. McMurphy is fully aware of Ratched's manipulation and is determined to antagonize her and undermine her authority as much as possible. When at a counseling session, McMurphy's proposition for the patients to watch a football game is not accepted, he tries to lift the ward's marble water-treatment control panel and throw it through the window so he can watch the game at a bar. Of course, he does not succeed.

After a fight over Ratched's cigarette rationing, McMurphy, Bromden and Cheswick, also McMurphy's friend, are sent to a detention area where they are going to be treated with electro convulsive therapy. While McMurphy and Bromden wait for their turn on the bench, McMurphy finds out that Bromden can actually talk and that he has been faking his condition the whole time. Fed up with Ratched's oppressive methods of control, McMurphy decides to throw a Christmas party.


He calls his girlfriend, Candy, who brings alcohol and a girlfriend. This is the last night in the ward for McMurphy and Bromden. Later in the evening, when the two plan to finally leave, Billy and Candy flirt, so McMurphy encourages him to have sex with her. However, along with the rest of the patients, he falls asleep.

Nurse Ratched arrives in the morning to discover the patients' asleep hung over. Clearly upset and angry, she manages to control herself, commanding the orderlies to lock the open window, and fetch missing Billy. She angrily demands him to tell her which one of the patients allowed him to have sex with Candy. Billy, his stutter noticeably gone, tells her that McMurphy did it and that other patients encouraged him. When Ratched threatens to tell his mother, citing her long-time friendship with her, Billy's stutter suddenly reappears. He breaks into tears and is dragged away by the orderlies.

Being left alone for a moment, Billy

commits suicide. When McMurphy sees what Ratched did to his friend, he angrily grabs her by the throat strangling her until she is near death. She survives but McMurphy is knocked unconscious by one of the orderlies.


One night McMurphy is quietly put to his bed. When Bromden sees him unresponsive, and with two scars on his forehead, he suffocates his vegetable-like friend with a pillow, lifts the hydrotherapy fountain that McMurphy was unable to move before and, hurling it through the closed window, escapes to Canada.



Themes explored in the movie are universal moral dilemmas. How do we conform to others? Is it a right thing to do? Do we even have a choice or do we agree to disagree? The relationship between the individual and society in general is dominant and portrayed in McMurphy's and Nurse Ratched's characters.

But let us start from the beginning.
Everything about

Everything about McMurphy screams freedom: his attitude, his bohemian actions,

the way he dresses. Even his tufted hair. The ward is a perfect representation of microcosm: Nurse Ratched as governing laws, her hairstyle signalizing the presence of a deity (in this case it is the Devil since her buns look like horns), various patients that are sculpted into obedient citizens, orderlies representing officials that implement oppressive methods, etc. The white color is present throughout, but here it is not to be mistaken as the symbol of purity and virginity. It stands for patients' blindness, domination of the nurse, brainwashing and control of individualism.

Nurse Ratched represents the oppressive force of society and authority; even though she is just a nurse, she is in complete control of the ward. The forces of manipulation she uses are psychological intimidation, physical abuse, pills and electro convulsive therapy. All of these symbolize the way society makes outcasts conform to its laws. They are either intimidated into obedience or numbed into acceptance to the point where they become just a plant like creatures.

The theme of rejection of sexuality is also very evident. Ratched becomes a castrator of the patients' sexuality. This is best shown in Billy's case: he is 31-year-old virgin who stutters all the

time. His condition is largely induced by sexual restriction. His mother, along with nurse Ratched, treats him like an infantile and thus he is not given a chance to develop sexually. Through the sexual intercourse with Candy he briefly regains his manhood and confidence, but is quickly driven back to his previ-

ous state. Unable to deal with the fact that he "did wrong", he commits suicide. The act itself can be interpreted as a liberating motive. Billy, being unable to accept the tyranny of nurse Ratched anymore, decides to kill himself in order not to allow the society to break him even further. It is implied throughout the movie that a healthy sexual expression is a key concept of sanity, and that repression of sexuality leads directly to insanity. What is lacking inside the hospital walls is a natural expression of sexual desire.



That way, not only the patients' lives are destroyed, but also their humanity. Sexual expression is considered dangerous and insane.

But the big question is what is insane? Who are the lunatics? We witness reasonable and logical actions of the patients that are immediately defined as insane. At the same time, the governing rules of the ward are plausible, even though a man is tortured and beaten if he asks a simple question. The sane actions of men are contrasted with the insane actions of the institution. What is also very important to emphasize is that having control of your actions does not automatically make you sane. This is evident when, at one point, nurse Ratched loses control and reacts almost as crazy as the patients themselves. McMurphy actually stands for a martyr, a Christ-like figure who accepts the punishment for the sake of his friends.

His role is to show them just how much they are not insane, but frustrated and limited. One day he takes them to a fishing trip. He states that now they are not lunatics, but mighty fishermen. Their role has changed. Inside the hospital's walls their place on the social ladder is where lunatics are, but once they go outside, their freedom is emphasized. The trip itself is not a representation of a possible way of escape, but a celebration of freedom. McMurphy is wrong, however, that the worst thing they could do to him is to return him to the institution. This is a mistake that in the end costs him his life. However, his death is not to be mistaken with the triumph of repression over the individuality. When Chef suffocates McMurphy, he actually saves his friend. Nurse Ratched was starting to control his body but Chef made it possible for McMurphy to liberate his soul. First they conquer your body and then the mind. So, euthanasia in the movie is a noble deed.

If there is no other way out, by separating the soul from the body, one can become free.

Nurse Ratched, on the other hand, is the complete opposite of McMurphy: if he is a Christlike figure, than she is the Antichrist. She represents authority, conformity, repression, evil and death. By constantly reminding the patients of their problems, by numbing them with pills, by electroconvulsive therapy, manipulation and physical abuse, she manages to completely control them and break their spirits. Her voice is carefully modulated as she wants to have complete control of everything. Her hat is impeccably white, as it represents her power over the patients and the entire ward. She is aware of the fact that McMurphy jeopardizes her position: he spits out the pills, violates the orders, makes other patients rebel against her, dirties her hat and in the end merely strangles her to death. She is cautious with him and her methods must be radical if she wants to preserve status quo.

When she cheats him into violence, Ratched justifies the lobotomy as she believes that in McMurphy's head is the source of all his problems. Furthermore, she believes that this is the source of all his power, so she must destroy it in order to be in complete control of the ward. By the end of the movie, however, her authority is as damaged as her neck in its brace as the patients play McMurphy's games, tell stories about him, speak in his language and adopt his nicknames. Even though he is as big as a mountain, Chef Bromden at the beginning of the movie represents a caricature of a human being. His defence against Ratchad's authority is complete withdrawal: he does not speak to anyone and pretends to be deaf. He believes he is too small and a complete coward to change things he does not believe to be right. But that changes completely. When McMurphy and Bromden become best friends, he slowly regains his awareness and courage. By responding to McMurphy's behavior and energy, he starts to reengage in life.

There just might be a way out and rebel



lion might be a better option than withdrawal. When McMurphy is lobotomized, Chef becomes strong enough to fight against the cor-

ruption of the ruling system. He frees McMurphy's soul by killing him and rips off the water treatment control panel, breaks the window and escapes to Canada. McMurphy's life force was too strong and effective, so for him withdrawal was no longer an option.

Billy Bibbit is as timid, shy and submissive as a person can get. He is a voluntary patient in the ward and he can go out the minute he wishes, but he chooses not to because he is not ready for the outside world. With a controlling mother and a manipulative, restricting nurse, he rejected his sexual appetite and urges, and now he is infantile. He is intimidated to that extent that he stutters all the time. His personality changes dramatically when McMurphy comes to the ward. McMurphy explains to him that there is nothing wrong in expressing sexuality and that he should enjoy his appetite for girls. By the time the patients throw a party, he becomes strong enough to act upon his desires. After the sexual intercourse with Candy, Billy is a new human being. His stutter is gone, his behavior is more confident; his walk is more self assured. Then again, when Ratched finds him, using the calmness of her voice and a threat to call his mother, Billy begins to stutter. He was submissive again. But the life

force of McMurphy was strong enough, so he did not want to go back to the infantile, castrated state of mind. He chose to commit suicide rather than to continue to live under the commanding hand of Ratched. His suicide is also important as a subconscious independent decision.

Call it whatever you want: McMurphy, the life force, rebellion, urges, instincts, etc. One thing is for sure: the individual starts a war against the corrupted society. Breaking free from everything that is limiting, repressive, manipulative and controlling is the ultimate goal. If you are careful enough and if you pay close attention to everything that surrounds you, it is possible to find different choices that will set you free. Death and suicide are not, however, actual ones. They stand for the death of a limited, submissive human being. Expression of nondestructive, healthy, creative, individual, productive characteristics is freedom, so be sure to kill everything inside you that limits your potentials. And remember: next time life gives you lemons, you are obliged to find a way to make a strawberry milkshake.



On January 5, 1969, in Canton, Ohio, Brian Hugh Wagner was born. He had a tough childhood: he was allegedly molested by a neighbor, he went to a strict Christian school, his parents were very demanding etc. In this period, while all socializing agents were trying to limit his personality, his fascination with rock music began, especially with Ozzy Ozborne, David Bowie, and Nine Inch Nails. Many people believed that there were some kind of evil, demonic, hidden messages in rock and Brian wanted

to see what the fuss was about. His answer was: rebellion. After a brief career as a journalist, in 1989, Brian formed a band and developed a new persona called Marilyn Manson. The name was not a coincidence. In the 60s, two of the most popularized figures in America were Marilyn Monroe, an iconic movie star, and Charles Manson, one of the most notorious serial killers. He believed that the dichotomy between the two, of positive and negative, represented what he wanted to achieve and what he was all about. Consequently, Marilyn Manson was born.

He frequently exposed his private parts and simulated sexual acts with other band members

In 1994, with the help of Trent Razor of Nine Inch Nails, the MM band released their first album "Portrait of American Family" and got the privilege of going on tour with NNN. Marilyn Manson wasted no time there. He secured his status as the Christian nightmare: he frequently exposed his private parts and simulated sexual acts with other band members.

This was quite shocking, so he was arrested after a show in Florida. He even got the attention of infamous Anton LaVey, one of the founders of the Satanic Church, who made Marilyn Manson a "reverend".

The controversy that was constantly developing around him, and the cover for Euritmics' Sweet Dreams, pushed his 1995 album Smells like Children to number 31. His next album Antichrist Superstar was a brutally aggressive concept album that depicted a nihilistic rock god. With it, Marilyn Manson became an (Antichrist) superstar. To his new nickname greatly contributed his next performance: he explicitly criticized the Catholic Church by ripping the pages out of a Bible. Many activist groups lobbied to ban the band's performances as rumors around his shows started. It was said that the performances contained animal sacrifices, bestiality and rape, as Marilyn Manson became one of the most demonized people of the 1990s.



In 1998, with the release of his next album, Mechanical Animals, Marilyn Manson adopted a new persona: now he was an androgynous alien-like creature Omega. His single "The Dope Show" was his first single to hit pop charts, but the tour that followed was cancelled as his music was blamed as a direct influence on the two teenage boys responsible for the Columbine High school Massacre in April 1999. He had to cancel several concert shows, and stated that allegations that his, or anyone else's music, was responsible for the killings is ridiculous. In 2000, he returned with the new album called Holy Wood (In the Shadow of the Valley of Death) telling the story of the future antichrist superstar's origin before his corruption.

The following years have been mild for Marilyn Manson. The MM edge has slightly worn off and the critics claimed



that Marilyn Manson was now going door to door trying to shock people. Even though critics did not appreciate his following albums that much, that does not mean that he has not created artistic, conceptual albums. In 2003, The Golden Age of Grotesque was heavily influenced by Weimar-era Berlin. In 2007, Eat Me, Drink Me heavily influenced by Russian Classics, especially Lolita. In 2009, The High End of Low was by many, his worst debut album than any of his previous studio albums. In 2012, Born Villain was heavily influenced by vampirism. Whatever the opinion, Marilyn Manson is one of the rare that has so many roles: parents use him to scare stubborn children, Christians use

him to demonize him, musicians use him as an inspiration, people listen to his music in order to find clever words combined with the hard sound of rock. We can only wait patiently for his next move. And it is guaranteed that will shock the hell out of us.

Facts about Marilyn Manson you probably did not know

He produced his own label for absinthe in 2007. It is called Mansinthe.

He collaborated with Lady GaGa and made a cover for

her song Love Game.

He is also a painter and had several exhibitions in Los Angles, Berlin and Paris.

He has a contact lance named after him: The Marilyn Manson look.

He appeared in various movies: Lost Highway, Party Monster, Rise, A Heart is Deceitful Above all Things, etc.


He started directing Phantasmagoria: The Visions of Lewis Carroll (where he also stars as the leading role). This project is still in the process of creation.







TO PERFECT WINE EXPERIENCE

How to taste wine properly –there are three steps that you need to do, in order to experience wine in the right way. The first is THE VISUAL EXPERIENCE. Pour the wine into the glass, make sure that the glass is more than a half empty (don't be pessimistic about it). This is important because the wine will not spill when you tilt and swirl the glass. Tilt the glass and look at the wine. Observe its color and clarity which are visible especially around the edges and when you hold the glass in front of a white background. The color of the wine reveals its age, whites become darker as they age, while red wines lose their vividness and their color becomes brownish. This is the right time to swirl the wine in the glass and observe the lines it leaves, for they reveal the viscosity of the wine. The slower the wine runs down the side of the glass, the more viscous it is, and probably more alcoholic. This does not have to be related directly to the quality of the wine, but viscosity generally indicates a more full-bodied wine. Swirling the wine is also important for our next step - SMELLING THE WINE. Detecting the wine's aromas is one of the most important steps in the proper wine experience. Swirling the glass allows a greater surface of wine to come in contact with air, thus releasing the right aromas. The right type of the glass will perfectly direct the aromas at your nose as you dip it into the glass. Finally, we've come to the last, third step, the most important one - TASTING THE WINE. If you have followed the previous two steps properly, this one is suppose to be the climax, the most enjoyable step and the perfect finish of a perfect wine experience. Sip the wine, but do not swallow it right away. Roll it in your mouth in order to hit all the taste buds and thus detect all its flavors. Try to introduce some air with the next sip you take and you will sense the difference in flavors. Enjoy your wine in good mood and company.



MANIC WINE GUIDE

TEMPERATURE

Serving temperature of wine can vary a lot, but the general rule is to serve white wines at the temperature of 7-11°C, red wines at 10-18°C, rose wines at 7-13°C, sparkling wines at 6-11°C, and dessert and fortified wines at 9-20°C (the range is here a bit wider since sweet and fortified wines have a great variety of flavors, some are best colder while the others do not need chilling).



The right choice of the wine glass allows you to enjoy your wine to the fullest. Every part of the glass has its role in the unique experience of wine. The foot of the wine glass makes your glass stable. The stem allows you to hold your glass without warming the wine. The bowl plays an important part

because its design allows you to enjoy each specific type of wine and capture its aromas in the right way. The rim should be thin and smooth, so that it doesn't hinder the wine as it flows out of the glass. As for the color, crystal clear glasses let you enjoy the beauty of the wine and its color, which is an important part of the overall wine experience.

Red wines should be served in larger glasses with fuller and rounder bowls with a large opening. This way you can dip your nose into the glass and savor the aromas. Also, this type of glass allows the greater surface of the wine to come in contact with the air, which is especially important for red wines and their complex flavors.

Glasses for white wine are usually smaller than those for red wine, with a bowl that is narrower. This way, the wine can keep the temperature low but still release its aromas.

Rose wines are generally consumed out of glasses with a short bowl and a slight taper, or those with a short bowl and a slightly flared lip. It is a common practice to use white wine glass for rose wines, and a perfectly legitimate as well, since rose wines and white wines are very similar in terms of fermentation.

Sparkling wines such as Champaign are served in a glass narrower than most wine glasses, which helps retain the carbonation of the wine and capture its flavor.


This type of wine is served in a smaller glass, suitable because of the sweetness and a higher percentage of alcohol in this type of wines.



WINE PRODUCING COUNTRIES IN THE WORLD

Countries that are considered the greatest wine producers in the world are Italy, France and Spain. They are followed by United States, Argentina, Australia and Chile. South Africa is on the eighth place while Germany and Portugal occupy the ninth and tenth place respectively. FRANCE is still considered the leading country when it comes the quality of wines. Some of the most known types of French wine include Bordeaux, Burgundy and Champaign which are also the regions in France where wine is produced, but there are many more. Lombardia, Toscana and Abruzzo are some of the wine producing regions of ITALY, which is, besides

France, considered to make some of the best wines in the world. Italy has two main types of grape varieties Bianco and Rosso, and some of the most common grape varieties in Italy include Moscato Blanc, Pinot Grigio, Trebbiano (whites) and Dolcetto, Montepulciano and Sangiovese (reds). Being the fifth largest wine producing country in the world, ARGENTINA has some phenomenal wines. Mendoza, San Juan & La Rioja and Patagonia are some of the greatest regions where wine is produced. Most common varieties of red wine produced in Argentina are Malbec, Bonarda and Cabernet Sauvignon, while commonly produced white wines include Pedro Gimenez, Torrontes Riojano and Chardonnay.



















NUTRIOUS CRAHEALTH RISK?


Some people develop allergies against egg whites and yolks, but these are more common in children. Cooked eggs are easier to digest and are less likely to have pathogenic bacteria, like Salmonella. In the recent years, doctors warn us against the cardiovascular risks of consuming eggs since they contain fat and cholesterol. Some studies even connect egg consumption and type 2 diabetes. However, moderate intake of eggs in your diet can do you no harm. Eggs are nutritious, protein rich food which supply us with all the essential amino acids and in the right ratio, at that. They have almost every vitamin and mineral that your body requires! One large egg can offer us just around 80 calories, 5 gr of fat, 6 gr of protein and all of the essential amino acids (pastured eggs usually have more of the Omega-3 amino acids than those from factory raised hens).



Then you must have either skipped breakfast or just grabbed a mouthful of whatever was lying around the kitchen. Including eggs in your morning eating routine will change how you feel significantly. Because of the high level of protein in them, eggs give you energy that lasts for a long



When the Route 66 was built, Hackberry became a popular tourist attraction. The clocks stopped for everything here, what with all the vintage gas pumps, rundown



Fréderic Fugen & Vincent Reffet are three-time world freefly champions with masses of experience in freeflying, base jumping and wingsuit flying. This year, on 31 May these two French skydivers, and members of the Soul Flyers, performed yet another awe-inspiring and unique exploit, which combined ultra-high altitude freeflying with mountain swooping.





7 Unforgettable Minutes

Fred Fugen (aged 34) and Vince Reffet (29) have **each jumped about 15,000 times, 10,000 times together,** and have competed as a pair internationally for seven years. Their achievements are already mind-blowing, but on April 19, 2014, they took their sport to an even higher level – by leaping off the top of the world's largest human construction: the Burj Kalifha Pinnacle in Dubai (828 metres). A tough act to follow... yet just a few weeks later the daring duo raised the bar with an even more complex exploit: a 33,000-foot jump from directly above the largest mountain in Europe.

On May 31st at 3 pm, they stepped out of a Beechcraft B200 King Air airplane at an altitude of exactly 10,052 m (33,000 feet), into the freezing air (-50°C) above Mont-Blanc, pushing the limits of what is physically possible without wearing a pressurised suit.

After 40 seconds of freefall pair acrobatics, falling at almost 400 km/h (250 mph), they reached 6,000 m (20,000 feet) and opened their canopies which are specially designed for mountain swooping (an extreme sport derived from freeflying, which involves skimming past the sides of mountains at speeds of more than 100 km/h (60 mph)). The pair got up close and personal to l'Arête de Peuterey (Italy), the longest mountain ridge in Europe, before swooping down to l'Aiguille Blanche and l'Aiguille Noire and landing safely at an altitude of 1,500 m in Courmayeur.



One And a Half Years of Preparation

These 7 minutes of pure adrenaline took a year and a half to prepare. The technical side of the jump required months of meticulous planning and intensive training (in Austria and Spain), and there were administrative hoops to jump through too - the jump height was at the cruise altitude of your average jet, so hours of negotiation were needed to obtain authorisation. Despite turbulence and changing weather conditions, due to the high levels of thermal activity at this time of day, the first attempt was successful.

To add to the complications, you need oxygen above 7,500 m to stop you passing out. A system was developed specially for the jump that did not restrict Fred and Vince's ability to perform their acrobatics, and which was lighter than the military equipment typically used for jumps from this altitude. They called in Ted Atkins, an engineer for the English company "Top Out". A parachutist himself, and a specialist in ascents of Everest, he worked closely with the guys right through the planning stage, and was there to make sure everything worked perfectly on the day of the jump.

Lifestyle and habits have an enormous importance, so it can be concluded that the healthier life is and the greater its quality, the lower the possibility of having this kind of a problem will be (unfortunately, this should not be taken for granted, because we have all witnessed that life is often governed by Murphy's laws). Smoking, the lack of some nutrients and vitamins in diet, medicaments, drugs, anemia, abuse of alcohol, stress, excessive exercise, steroids, tight underwear, different

influences from the environment – all these factors have their own mechanisms of function.

Some of them increase the temperature of the testicles, which interferes with their proper functioning, some of them lower the amount of testosterone, some shrink the testicles, and with some, the problem is that metabolizing in the organism creates substances harmful to the sensitive and safely guarded mechanisms of production of mature and good spermatozoids. Having in mind that these factors are consciously chosen or a consequence of the desire for a certain lifestyle, they can be changed, so the way to a solution for sterility is the way that begins by altering these variables. As testicles are glands and as they are a target tissue for the effects of different hormones, every hormonal imbalance is and can be a reason for sterility. Hyperprolactinemia, hyperthyroidism, congenital adrenal hyperplasia, hypogonadotropic hypogonadism, panhypopituitarism, these are all just fancy names for hormonal excesses, which mostly influence the 'brain (hypothalamus)-pituitary glandtesticles' axis or rather the testicles directly. The symptoms of these conditions are numerous, one of them being sterility, which, as everything else, can be solved by balancing the hormones levels, that is, by therapy directed at ensuring the normal functioning of the entire organism by returning the number of hormones to normal.

Tests for soothing the conscience and facing the problem eye to eye are much simpler for men and less invasive.

Varicocele (enlargement of the spermatic veins, which, by changing the climate in the testicles, creates inadequate condition for the proper

function), cryptorchismus, torsion, injury of the spermatic cord, infection, Kline-felter syndrome, retrograde ejaculation (the ejaculation is, due to the urethral sphincter directed at the urinal bladder not outside) are just a few, but at the same time the most common physical problems. The approaches to solving these problems are different (in conservative way or by surgery), and these are the approaches of handling sterility too. Erectile dysfunction, ejaculatory incompetence, premature ejaculation, depression...the list of the factors keeps growing.

Tests for soothing the conscience and facing the problem eye to eye are much simpler for men and less invasive. An intrusion of privacy is inevitable, as well as the feeling of embarrassment, but shortly put, be a man! It all starts with a good an-

amnesis, inevitable questions about sexual maturation, habits, lifestyle and an open conversation about sexual activities. Then it goes on to physical examination after which follows the true check of the potential – examination of the sperm. Both its quantity and quality are being evaluated. Spermatozoids are particularly observed and followed, their number (the smaller the number of arrows, the lower the possibility for one of them to hit the target), morphology (whether they are two-headed, tailless), mobility and a few more parameters used to estimate fertility. As an addition to this, hormone and genetic statuses are also being checked, as well as determining the titer of antisperm antibodies. The man should always be tested first. The treatment of sterility has been mentioned to an extent. Preventing, treating or just improving the condition of the body is a great step towards eliminating the possibility for sterility to occur. If there is no good response

to the previous therapy, as an ultimate

means of help, methods of enabling


the sperm and the egg to meet are being employed. Either in vitro or in vivo. Artificial insemination is not something to be afraid of, but a contemporary method of treatment.

In the end, we have seen how and why sterility occurs (for the majority of cases at least, for some, everything is still in the domain of idiopathic). It is often being said, recently even more often and by an increasing number of authors who point out, that the aging of a woman is a less terrifying factor of sterility, than it has been thought; that fertility does not decrease with years so drastically as it has been said earlier. We do not have to think about it, because women age, and so do their egg cells.

We all age, spermatozoids are produced on a daily basis and they need about hundred days to mature.

If this is so, it means that every day is a new opportunity to go into the battle against sterility, and to triumph, despite a great number of obstacles.



All this food has a preventive or even healing effect on the prostate: improving of the blood flow, anti-cancer and anti-bacterial effect, strengthening the local immunity mechanisms and removing the infection, repairing effect on the mucous membrane and balancing the effects of testosterone.

Lifestyle with the reduced consumption of alcohol, carbonated drinks and smoking, goes without saying, so we mention it just for the sake of formality.

At one point, the burden of prostate becomes so unbearable, but it can be relieved. Why not help our own bodies, if possible, to cope with this burden, if cannot deal with it otherwise.







"THE GREAT WAR" WILL BE REMEMBERED BY THE TRENCHES. THE FIERCEST FIGHTS TOOK PLACE IN THEM. IT WAS THE TIME IN WHICH NEW WAYS TO PUT METAL TO DEADLY USE WERE CONSTANTLY BEING DISCOVERED. BESIDES ALL THE CANNONS, TANKS, AND MACHINE GUNS USED BY MILLIONS OF SOLDIERS, ONLY FEW OF THEM HAD THE COURAGE TO GET INTO A METAL BIPLANE, TAKE OFF AND SOW DEATH. THE GREATEST OF THESE COURAGEOUS WARRIORS, AND A TRUE GENTLEMAN, WAS BARON MANFRED VON RICHTHOFEN.

Even before he was born, as the son of an aristocratic family whose roots reached back to the XVI century, Manfred was predestined for the army. Just like his father, he became a soldier, no objections. He first entered a plane only as an observer. His cavalry reconnaissance unit was disassembled, so he looked for a place in the aviation. After a few months on the eastern front, he was transferred to the new secret special unit for bombing England called "Mail Pigeon Detachment". The first plane he shot down shattered his illusions about heroism. Murders in the enemy line do not count.

As the new single seat Fokker fighter was easier to control and shoot from, Richthofen decided to become a pilot himself, and in just a few months, he became one. Having shot a few enemies down, which didn't count for they had been shot above the enemy lines, he got a chance in the squadron of his hero, the fighter pilot Oswald Boelcke. On September 17, 1916, he had his first shot-down. Thrilled and overwhelmed, he decided that the tradition of the pilot having beer mugs engraved after his first win should change. After every shotdown he ordered a two-inch-tall silver trophy from a Berlin jeweler. Each of these trophies had a few things engraved on them. The first is the serial number of the plane shot down as well as the model of the aircraft. This was followed by the number of the crew and finally by the date. "1 VICKERS 2 17.9.16." – an inscription from his first trophy. Every tenth one was twice as big as the others were, but although he had 80 shot-downs, he had only 60 trophies due to the scarcity of silver. Any other material for his trophy was out of the question. He also collected souvenirs from the planes he shot down, parts of the propellers, motors, machineguns, but most of all, serial numbers. He would send it all home to be exhibited there.

Wanting to daunt his enemies, pay tribute to the aviation hero Boelcke, and be recognized from the ground, he painted his plane in a flaming red color. Very soon, he started to strike terror into the hearts of his enemies, for, though he was a visible target, he became impossible to shoot down. He kept lining the murders up. That's why his enemies thought of different nicknames for him such as Le Petit Rouge, the Red Devil, the Red Falcon, Le Diable Rouge, the Jolly Red Baron, the Bloody Baron, and the Red Baron. The Germans called him der Rote Kampfflieger ("The Red Battle Flier"). April 1917, or, "Bloody April" - this is the month when Baron shot down 21 planes, thus breaking the record. He became a folk hero, national treasure and a propaganda puppet, worshipped in the whole of Empire. But soon all of the Empire's fears came true and the hero died on April 21st, 1918, as he was on his way to intercept a formation of planes from England. Among them flew a Canadian Second Lieutenant Wilfred ("Wop") May. Baron sensed that this was May's

first fight and started to follow him, thinking that he would shoot him


down easily as a soft target. Having entered the enemy's airspace, he

was shot down. The bullet that hit him killed him immediately and the










































The Blond

Platinum hair, beauty mark, skirt-blowing scene, Dior J'adore, Happy birthday dear Mr. President... More than 50 years after her death and Marilyn Monroe is still the essential part of our culture: **she is the prototype of everlasting glamour, the ideal of female beauty, the movie icon.** But who was she? Who is behind one of the most mentioned names in the movie industry, and in general?



On June 1, 1926, a girl named Norma Jeane was born. Since she never met her father and her mother was sent to an institution, Norma spent most of her childhood in foster homes. Due to her difficult upbringing and emotional problems throughout her life, as a result of her lack of stability in her childhood, Norma tried to replace the father figure by marrying certain James Dougherty in June 1942, when she was only 16 years old. Her marriage was not particularly unhappy, but Norma had bigger aspirations than just being Mrs. Dougherty.

In 1946, while she was working for a parachute factory, a new model was discovered. A photographer was photographing females working for the war effort and he immediately spotted Norma's immaculate beauty. Her face began to appear on numerous maga-

zine covers. Her rise to stardom had begun. That same year, Norma got a divorce, a new name, and a new career as an actress. She was now Marilyn Monroe. Her name represented the combination of names of one of the most famous stage performers of 1920s (Marilyn), and her mother's maiden name (Monroe).

Several years later she got her first leading role. At this period, she was a well known actress. She was also married to Joe DiMaggio, a baseball legend. But as he was too conservative for her beliefs, the two divorced. Marilyn also became a huge box office draw and was a real money maker for 20th Century Fox. However, she was a bit bored and dissatisfied with Los Angeles.

Miller even wrote a play and a script, called Misfits, with the role for Marilyn, which awarded her with a Golden Globe

In 1955, Marilyn moved to New York where she studied acting at the world's famous Acting Studio. She wanted to leave the glamour of her life in Hollywood and focus on improving her acting skills and abilities. In 1956, she



met Arthur Miller, a famous playwright. After a short relationship they got married. They seemed perfectly happy together and everybody thought that this was the love that would last forever. Miller even wrote a play and a script, called Misfits, with the role for Marilyn, which awarded her with a Golden Globe. At this time, Marilyn was obsessed with children and wanted to have one of her own. She and Miller tried to have children, however Marilyn had several miscarriages.

All of a sudden, they divorced in 1961. On her own and depressed, Marilyn frequently consumed alcohol and sleeping pills and was unable to perform. Her acting began to suffer. She was constantly late for the shooting and directors often criticized her "diva" behavior. In 1962, she sang a famous Happy Birthday song to John F. Kennedy at Madison Square Garden. Many believed that she was drunk during that

performance as well.

That same year, Marilyn was in the middle of her latest movie, ironically called "Something's Got to Give". Something did. On the night of August 5th, 1962, Marilyn Monroe was found dead in her hotel room. Her death was listed as a probable suicide, i.e. a probable death of sleeping pills overdose. Various rumors connected to her death started: an alleged affair with Kennedy family, mafia involvement, a cover up, murder, a conspiracy. Joe DiMaggio claimed her body and buried her at a private funeral. While they were married, Joe promised her to leave flowers at her grave every week if she was to die first. He kept his promise.

Whatever the truth might be behind the death of Marilyn Monroe, she was dead, at the age of 36. The world, in shock, began a search for answers that continues to this day. The answers that will never be found.


