Christopher Jonathan James Nolan is one of those moviemakers whose true and

unique talent for storytelling immediately transforms the movie into a mega-hit. Having discovered the love for filmmaking, Nolan mastered English literature at the London University College where he made several short films such as **Tarantula**, **Larceny and Doodlebug**, before his first longer film debut. In 1998, young Nolan wrote, directed, filmed and edited a neo-noir thriller drama *Following* which became known as one of the most notable

Following, the out of sequence story of a young obsessive writer who follows the life of London's criminal underground that ultimately draws him into it, gained enough recognition to help Nolan fund his next project, *Memento*. The exciting editing style and the intriguing storyline of a man without short-term memory trying to uncover the murderer of his wife, brought the aspiring director a Golden Globe and two Oscar nominations. The director then moved on from the nonlinear narrative pattern and directed the psychological thriller remake **Insomnia** with AI Pacino and Robin

Christofer Nolan's **Movie Trademarks**

The acclaimed director is well known for his complex, thought-provoking and cerebral, usually nonlinear storylines but also for his collaboration with a few of the Hollywood's crème de la crème. Here's a quick look at the Nolan's most memorable filmmaking trademarks.

HIS MOVIES USUALLY BEGIN WITH A FLASHBACK OR A SCENE FROM THE MIDDLE OR END OF THE MOVIE.

IN THE DIALOGUE SCENES, THE ACTORS ARE FRAMED IN WIDE CLOSE-UP WHILE THE BACK-GROUND IS BLURRED OUT. debacle *Batman and Robin.* However, no one would have ever thought that the product would reach such heights. The director went back to the basics - or rather, back to the comic books, pulling his trademark move, focusing on the story of a man behind the mask while making the film visually entertaining. Christian Bale, Michael Caine, Gary Oldman, Liam Neeson and Katie Holmes's extraordinary performances only helped the movie earn over \$350 million dollars worldwide. Re-teaming with Bale and Caine, he created his next box-office success **The Prestige**, after which he returned to the Batman franchise. **The Dark Night** surpassed any other superhero movie ever made in the history of cinema. Dark, brooding, visually and technically astounding, it kept the entire world at the edge of its seat. However, the movie will also be remembered for the death of Heath Ledger, who played the character of

 \bigcirc

Joker in the film, and the death of a cameraman Conway Wickliffe during the shooting of the film. The Dark Knight got 133 wins - two of which were posthumously awarded to Heath Ledger - and 105 nominations. Two years later there was **Inception**, an action sci-fi movie starring Leonardo DiCaprio, Joseph Gordon-Levitt and Tom Hardy, among others. Its unusual and complex storyline was commended by the critics while its technical and visual achievements were awarded four Academy Awards.

Apart from being delicious and pleasing to our taste buds, it has proved to

be a rather significant part of certain cultures and their cuisines, as

well as their traditions and customs.

History or Mystery of Beer

It is said that beer is as old as the civilization itself, and archeologists believe that it has been quenching people's thirst since the early Neolithic age. The reason why no nation claims that they have invented beer is probably because all of them have. This is highly probable

because alcoholic fermentation is a natural process for anything that contains sugar, and sugar is easily obtained through cornstarch. There is some proof of barely beer coming from Iran and that the beverage has spread across Europe through Celtic and Germanic tribes. At that time, around 3000 BC, beer was not what it is today. It was a strange brewage of everything and anything – fruits, honey, plants, spices and narcotic herbs. However, in 1516, William IV, Duke of Bavaria, adopted the Purity Law (in force even today), which allowed water, hops and barley-malt as the only ingredients of beer.

Brewing Process

MALTED BARELY is mixed with HOT WATER to make an oatmeal-like MASH

MASH is drained off and the sweet liquid that remains is called WORT If we dig deeper into brewing, the procedure is not as simple as it might seem. This is why so many breweries have been fighting for supremacy ever since brewing houses and companies have come into being.

- Beer mostly consists of *WATER*, and the type and its softness can hugely affect the taste of beer.
- Although barley *MALT* should be the major source of starch, wheat/rice/oats/rye/corn/sorghum may

HOPS are boiled with the WORT to add aroma, flavor, and bitterness

YEAST is mixed with the HOPPED WORT and left to ferment

The YEAST converts sugar to ETHANOL (the alcohol part that makes you dizzy after a couple of liters) and CARBON-DIOXIDE (the beloved bubbles of beer) also be used.

• *HOPS* are essential to the bitterness of beer and contribute to floral, citrus, and herbal aromas and flavors of the beer.

• **YEAST** is essential for fermentation, it metabolizes the sugars extracted from grains, produces alcohol and carbon dioxide and this is how wort is turned into beer.





Types And Styles Of Beer



Beers are either ALES or LAGERS, and this may sound confusing because you have probably heard about a thousand names for beer or beer-like beverages. Some of those are simply synonymous terms for beer or its subtypes and varieties.

Although *ALE* is often what we call beer in general, it is actually a type of beer made from top-fermenting yeast. The strong taste of ale is a result of fast and warm fermentation, and can often be complex with certain pleasant acidity and bitterness to it. Ales are generally darker in color and should be served at a temperature of around 50°F. There is a wide variety of ales and each ale is color and taste specific, which means it quits different testes and feed shoises.

means it suits different tastes and food choices.



PALE ALE is the lightest of the ales, as the name suggests. This is one of the most popular beer styles around the world. A fruity beer with a dry and bitter aftertaste best goes with spicy, smoky or aromatic flavors and blue cheese. Pale Ale is often served in pints and some of the best known brands are **Sierra Nevada Pale Ale** (American), **Bass Pale Ale** (English), **Orval Trappist Ale** (Belgian) and





Duvel (strong Belgian).

BEER DRINKING GUIDE



LAGERS are made with bottom-fermenting yeast and are smoother and lighter due to colder fermentation. They undergo primary fermentation under around 50°F and are left to age at around 35°F. Lagers are generally lighter in color than ales and are best when served at 45°F. Lagers are as versatile as ales, but as they are lighter and crispier they are also easier to pair with different kinds of food.





AMERICAN LAGER owes its crisp dry finish to the well-balanced portions of hops and malt. The gassy and watery beverage is best when served cold. Pints of the American lager contrast perfectly with Tai, Mexican and other spicy cuisines, but complement mild cheese such as Brie. **Budwiser** is probably the most popular lager, along with **Bud Light** (light Lager).

The first and maybe the only word of Italian you will ever learn is pizza, and, yes, it is definitely, beside 12 more on Easter. These pizzas were, in fact, more similar to what we today call focaccia, crispy cooked dough with spices and raisins or olives, which was at that time especially popular in Naples. Tomato or tomato sauce was not added to pizza until the 16th century, after it was discovered that it wasn't poisonous. Around that time, it became the food of the poor, as it did not require any utensils to be eaten. In the 1830s, the first pizzerias opened in Naples, where *pizzas were made in ovens lined with the lava from the Vesuvius volcano.* Since then, pizzas have been made in numerous ways,

pasta, *the most popular specialty of Italian cuisine*. The term itself dates back to 997 AD and a Latin text from the southern Italian town of Gaeta about certain 12 pizzas a tenant was supposed to give to the bishop on Christmas, and shapes and styles, and likewise sold and distributed. From stone to oven and microwave baked, half-frozen to take-outs, thick-crusted chilies to vegetarian and sweet pizzas, *anything you can imagine can be made into and called a pizza*.





the top sellers of fast food franchises and restaurants, it is most certainly not the unhealthiest type of food. At least not always! To be honest, many of the world's renowned pizza chains actually do sell crappy mixtures of GMO meats, fatty artificial cheeses and additivefilled dough, but not every pizza is unhealthy. The preparation method and the type of ingredients can hugely affect its nutritive value and how unhealthy it is. Even though pizza toppings mostly depend on the traditional properties of certain cuisines, the key to heathy pizza is healthy

ingredients, which often

means a bit more money,

and a lot more deliciousness.





Avoid white wheat or pre-frozen crusts – these would be the worst choices for pizza base. Instead, use whole-wheat dough or home-made whole-wheat tortillas. Other alternatives for flatbread dough can be rice, cauliflower, mushrooms, zucchini or squash-based dough, which are healthy and *change up the boring bready part of pizza*.









THE SAUCE-

Never use store-bought sauces in cans and cartons, not to mention ketchup. *Mash fresh tomatoes yourself or just put slices of tomato over the dough*. Pesto and other garlic based spreads are easy to make at home and are always healthier than those that are bought. Carrot, mushroom or olive spreads are very healthy and rich with vitamins, proteins and natural oils, and the same goes for hummus. *Spices are of great importance to these sauces*, and can turn any of them to exotic bases or spicy foundations.





THE TOPPING.

The first step towards healthy topping is going easy on it – *do not try to hide your sauce or the crust with the topping*. Swap pork with chicken, turkey, or any other lean meat. Tofu, beans, eggs and nuts are great protein sources and, *as far as vegetables go, just try to think outside the box* – kale, chard, asparagus, broccoli, zucchini, squash (and fruit for that matter). Yummy alternatives to melted cheese like mozzarella and cottage, goat and feta, parmesan and gorgonzola, will do the trick as long as they are fresh and sparse.




Most popular types of pizza are, or at least should be, made following authentic Italian pizza recipes. Therefore, *Pizza* Napoletana, also called Margherita, usually consists of dough covered with tomatoes and mozzarella cheese; *Pizza Romana* is similar, but has anchovies and oil. *Pizza Viennese* is spiced up with German sausage and *Capricciosa* with mushrooms, artichokes, cooked ham and olives. *Quattro Formaggi* is beside mozzarella, topped with stracchino, fontina and gorgonzola, while *Siciliana* is a thick crusted and rectangular Napoletana with extra onions, anchovies, herbs, and strong cheese. From 2002, Italy even has a bill on traditional pizzas, which

bacon, ham and pineapple



allows pizza to be called traditional only when prepared in a particular way with particular ingredients.

Having left Italy, pizza was exposed to other traditions and cooking customs, and has in different countries picked up other amazing ingredients and condiments, thus becoming a universal dish. Scotland is where they deep-fry their pizzas, the UK loves sweetcorn as a topping, and Mexico is the home of *Pizza* Mexicana (with various kinds of peppers, chilies, avocado, and other foods loved by the Mexican people). Pickled ginger, minced mutton and tofu are very popular toppings in India; tabasco sauce, squid, mayonnaise, potato and bacon are well-loved in Japan; Brazilians like green peas on their pizza; *Russians enjoy a* combination of sardines, tuna, mackerel, *salmon and onions*; and the French care for bacon, onion and fresh cream, which they call the *Flambée*. Many nations that generally enjoy and regularly eat seafood have developed pizza specialties topped with shrimps, prawns and different kinds of fish with sauces and veggies that complement such food. The most famous seafood pizza is probably *Marinara*. However, Americans are for sure the biggest lovers of pizza as they eat up to 3 billion pizza pies a year. Their love for the Italian specialty is so immense that there are around 60,000 pizzerias around the USA. Some of the most popular styles in the US are California-style (chicken pizza with peanut sauce, bean sprouts, and carrots), Chicago-style (thin-crusted stuffed pizza), Hawaiian (with bacon or ham and pineapple), New York-style (with thin

INGREDIENTS MANE PREPARATION

***** Crust

300g strong bread flour 1 tsp instant yeast 1 tsp salt 200ml warm water 1 tbsp olive oil, plus extra for drizzling

***** Tomato sauce

100ml mashed tomatoes or thick tomato juice 1 tsp dried or handful fresh basil 1 garlic clove, crushed

Crust:

Put the flour into a large bowl, and then stir in the yeast and salt. Make a well, pour in 200ml warm water and the olive oil and bring together with a wooden spoon until you have a soft, fairly wet dough. Turn onto a lightly floured surface and knead for 5 min until smooth. Cover with a tea towel and set aside.



* Topping 125g ball mozzarella, sliced handful grated or shaved parmesan handful cherry tomatoes halved handful basil leaves (optional)

Mix the mashed tomatoes/tomato juice, basil and crushed garlic together, then season to taste. Leave to stand at room temperature while you get on with shaping the base.

or thick tomato juice 1 tsp dried or handful fresh basil 1 garlic clove, crushed

***** Topping

125g ball mozzarella, sliced handful grated or shaved parmesan handful cherry tomatoes halved handful basil leaves (optional)



and set aside.

Sauce:

Mix the mashed tomatoes/tomato juice, basil and crushed garlic together, then season to taste. Leave to stand at room temperature while you get on with shaping the base.

Roll out the dough:

On a floured surface, roll out the dough into 2 large rounds, using a rolling pin. The dough needs to be very thin, as it will rise in the oven. Lift the rounds onto two floured baking sheets.

Top and bake:

Heat oven to 240°C/fan 220°C/gas 8. Put a baking tray in the oven on the top shelf. Smooth sauce over bases, scatter with cheese and tomatoes, drizzle with olive oil and season. Put one pizza, still on its baking sheet, on top of the hot tray. Bake for 8-10 min or until crisp. Serve with a little more olive oil, and basil leaves if using. Repeat for remaining pizza.

Mick Fanning introduced himself to the world during the ASP World Championship Tour in 2002, finishing among the top five in his first season. However, a major injury, a complete hamstring tear, influenced his further advancement as one of the greatest surfers of today. In 2007, Fanning triumphantly returned to the spotlight after a complicated surgery and a demanding 6-month rehab, when he won the ASP World Championship. Unfortunately, he suffered another serious injury in 2008, but came back only a year later after an intense recovery. With the help of strong will and persistence, Mick returned to reclaim his ASP throne and climaxed at the Pipe Masters, one of the most prestigious surfing events. The past three years have also been very important for Fanning. In 2012, he participated in various acknowledged events such as the Rip Curl Pro, Billabong Pro Teahupoo, Volcom Fiji Pro and others, thus securing the image of one of the most inspiring sportsmen among surfers. The following year was also very successful for Mr. Fanning. In 2013, he somehow managed to get a number of significant podium finishes. Having taken his 3rd World Championship title, Fanning has became one of the most victorious surfers in the world. The year brought him a role in a movie called *Missing* (by filmmaker Taylor Steele), a 21 day long surfing journey around the world with his friends and colleagues Jordy Smith, John John Florence, Tom Curren, and Matt Wilkinson. We can't wait to see what the future brings for this young climbing legend.

THE GIANT OF MOULE

LONG BEFORE HE WAS EVEN BORN!





Toulouse-Lautrec was a **man who physically resembled a circus actor**, but was actually a chronicler of a prolific epoch, an equal contemporary of the greatest minds, a **bohemian painting philosopher**, a silent human rights activist, a pureblood aristocrat, a visionary, a caricaturist of a twisted reality, a conceiver of marketing and design, a great man of a great name and of even greater

significance for French art and the whole world of art in general. His friends called him "the soul of Montmartre", but he proved with his brush that he was a giant among his peers.

Henri Marie Raymond de Toulouse-Lautrec-Monfa was born in 1864 in

Albi, France. As the first son of a count and a countess, **he was brought up in wealth and abundance.** Unfortunately, these circumstances had cost him a lot since he had to suffer the consequences of inbreeding in his family. **His parents were first cousins** who did not want to stain their family's blood with the impure plebeian blood. At the ages of 13 and 14 he had broken first his right and then his left leg, which were unable to heal well due to the incest caused genetic mutations.

The consequences of this particular mutation were never clear enough, but had certainly caused his bones to become weak and brittle. This problem is today often referred to as the Toulouse-Lautrec syndrome. After puberty, **Toulouse was left with a fully developed torso**, **head and upper extremities but short and undeveloped legs**. Nevertheless, Toulouse was fortunate enough to become such an amazing man, as opposed to his younger brother who died of inbreeding consequences at the age of one.





Due to his physical weakness and sensitivity, Toulouse had spent a lot of time secluded from his peers. The isolation and the incapacity which he was endowed with, aside from the title and the aristocratic 'pure' blood, had led him to start the adventure of getting to know the world. Everything he had encountered both as a young man and as an adult was noted in his paintings, lithographs and nouveau illustrations. Sadly, most of what he had encountered were the instances of poverty,

prostitution, disease, decadence and the vice of Paris.

During his short life, Lautrec had created over 700 paintings, more than 300 posters and prints and around 5000 drawings. All of these serve as a type of diary or a scrapbook of a period at the end of the 19th century. His models came from different backgrounds but he would never make any difference between a passer-by in the street, a prostitute in a corset, an officer on a horse or a world-class writer. For him all of this was art, a raw, simple and beautiful kind of art – sleeping, looking through the window, dancing, getting dressed or undressed, parading, and altogether living. These people lived on his canvas and outside of it, and Lautrec's hand had forever captured them in one particular vivid moment and made them eternal as heralds of an era. Lautrec used to sit in a café and sketch the lively, rushed and confused contemporary life which was going on around him, only to go back to his atelier and turn all of the sketches into rich and bright colors, flickering movements and clear lines, thus giving the paintings a certain kind of clarity which people could not see without him. He was well aware of the sickly, tumulus, theatrical and melodramatic world, which had consequently brought him to a fine line which separated expressionism and impressionism. His clear lines and the richness of colors were the shades of his sensations, suffering and joy of an ordinary man. The fluidity of the skirts of the dancers of Moulin Rouge, the pale bodies of prostitutes, the bearded gentlemen in top hats and smart suits, the tortured and beaten ragged alcoholics, the bohemians, vagabonds and beggars – all this was Paris as an inspiration and not something he wanted to stay blind to.

Toulouse was never just a great painter. He was a pioneer of design and graphic. He had recognized the potential of lithography and managed to use this medium to the fullest and even develop it outside the recognizable boarders. **He had created a substantial number** of posters and prints which embellished Paris. That way his art served the ordinary men and the world as well and he could give back to the common world what the world had given to him. One of the stars of his posters, aside from numerous dancers, cabaret singers and musicians, was the exotic and explo-

sive dancer of the Moulin Rouge, Jane Avril (La Mélinite).

Lautrec's paintings are often said to have an odd perspective, as if the viewer was looking up towards the scene. This is the artist's signature, which connects him to the viewer outside of his space and time. The clear lines which are often repetitive and make figures and silhouettes resemble one another are a symbol of the universal human need to feel as if they belonged there. **The chunks of color which oppose one another on the canvas, but become real to the viewer are one of the basic elements of Lautrec's technique.** The greatness of this little man can be seen not only in his work but also in the fact that he recognized the talent of Van Gogh. **He had seen the potential of Van Gogh as the painter of this era long before Gogh became a high valued artist.** Moreover, he used to spend time around other poets, painters, writers and philosophers who gathered round Montmartre, and would draw caricatures of them, placing himself among the great French caricaturists.

Before his death he had spent some time in an asylum, a psychiatric resort, where he painted a number of carnival and circus scenes, as if he wanted to round up his opus with the joyful and picturesque details of his time to oppose the destruction of our civilization which was to happen a couple of decades after his death.





Beaten by his genetics, venereal diseases and bohemian life, and unable to carry his grownup body on his not fully grown legs, **he decided to end his life with alcohol at the age of 37.** His last words were **"Vieil imbécile!"**, which meant "Old fool!", referring to his father who had been preparing him for great deeds but had previously destroyed him. Finally, all that he possessed he had

gained by himself, fighting against family, class and moral shackles, against nature and society, but mostly against himself, with his brush and in front of his canvas.
