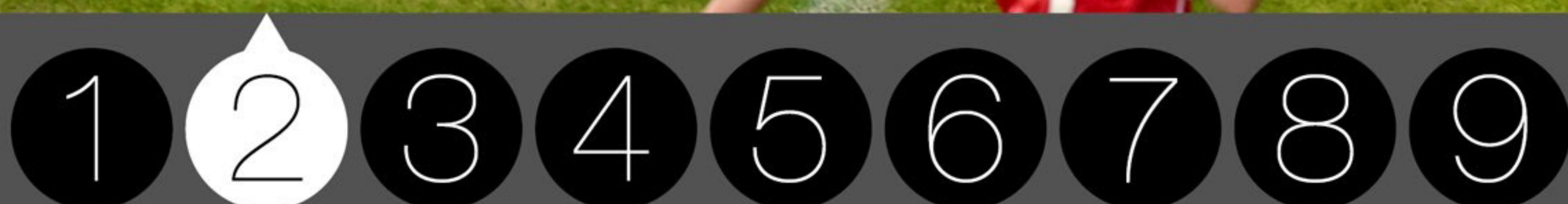

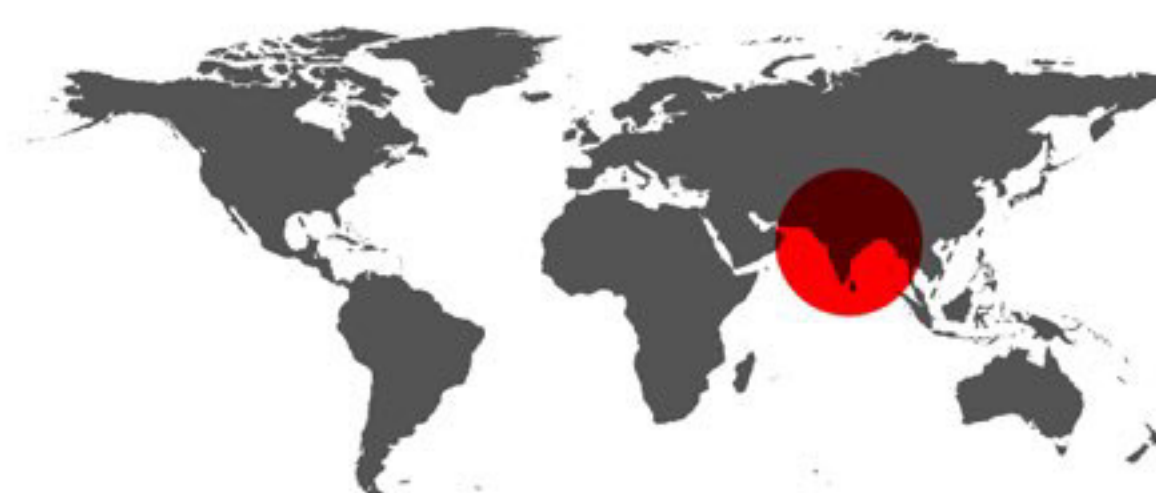

Paul Rudd plays Scott Lang, the master thief who turns into a microscopic hero with great strength and ability to command swarms of insects; Michael Douglas is Hank Pym, who is the creator of the Ant-Man technology and thus Lang's mentor; and Evangeline Lilly plays Hope van Dyne, the love interest and presumed relation of The Wasp. Lang and Dr. Pym try to protect the secret behind the amazing Ant-Man suit from new waves of rising threats. The two of them must overcome some serious obstacles, and

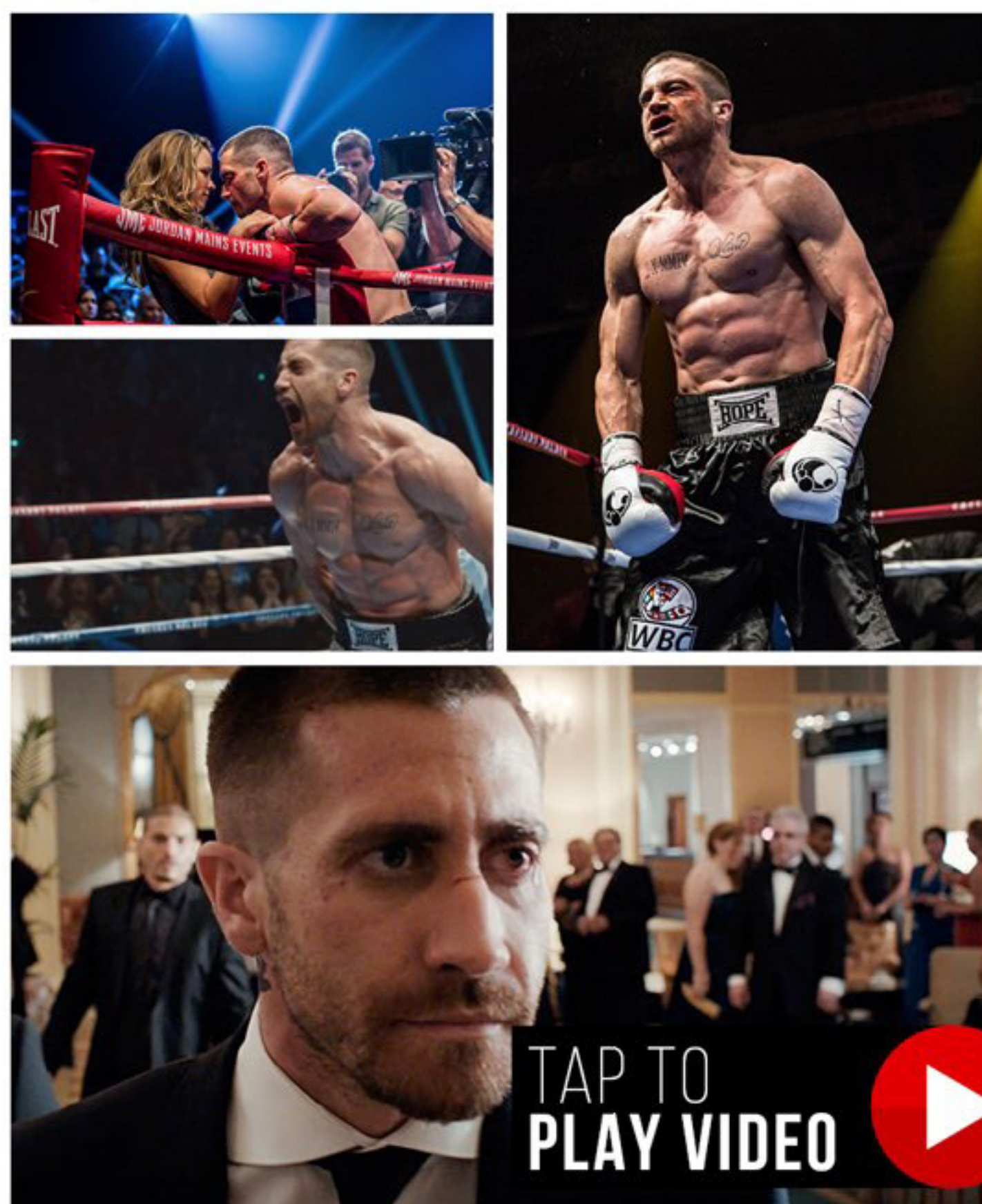
A philosophy professor at a small college, played by Joaquin Phoenix, finds himself having not only a writer's block, but an existential crisis as well. He is brilliant, but burned-out, and he cannot seem to find his path back to the way things were before for him. After creating an avalanche of gossip on campus, becoming involved with a teacher, Rita (Parker Posey), and Jill, a student played by Emma Stone, he discovers a new purpose in life. He suddenly turns his life around and sees the world

through a much more positive perspective. Woody Allen again places Emma Stone as a love interest of an intellectual man who is twice her age. Much like Colin Firth in *Magic in the Moonlight*, Joaquin Phoenix seems a wonderfully weird match for young Stone. The movie itself is twisted and delightful, with a perfect murder and the farce around it. Witty, ironic and enjoyable, we recommend this movie without reservations.

Southpaw tells the story of Billy 'The Great' Hope, played by Jake Gyllenhaal. He is Light Heavyweight Boxing Champion of the World at the height of his fame, with a fancy house and a loving wife and daughter (Oona Laurence). However, his beautiful wife Maureen (Rachel McAdams) begs him to quit boxing despite the lavish lifestyle. A tragedy happens – Maureen is accidentally killed, and his world completely falls apart. Soon enough, child protection services take away his daughter due to

his destructive behavior, and all he has left is to go back to boxing with the help of a trainer from a run-down local gym, Titus "Tick" Wills (Forest Whitaker). All that to get his life and daughter back. Battling with inner demons, struggling with redemption, winning back the trust of the loved ones...the story is somewhat familiar, but we give it a shot as it comes from the acclaimed director Antoine Fuqua (Training Day) and screenwriters Kurt Sutter (Sons of Anarchy) and Richard Wenk (The Mechanic).

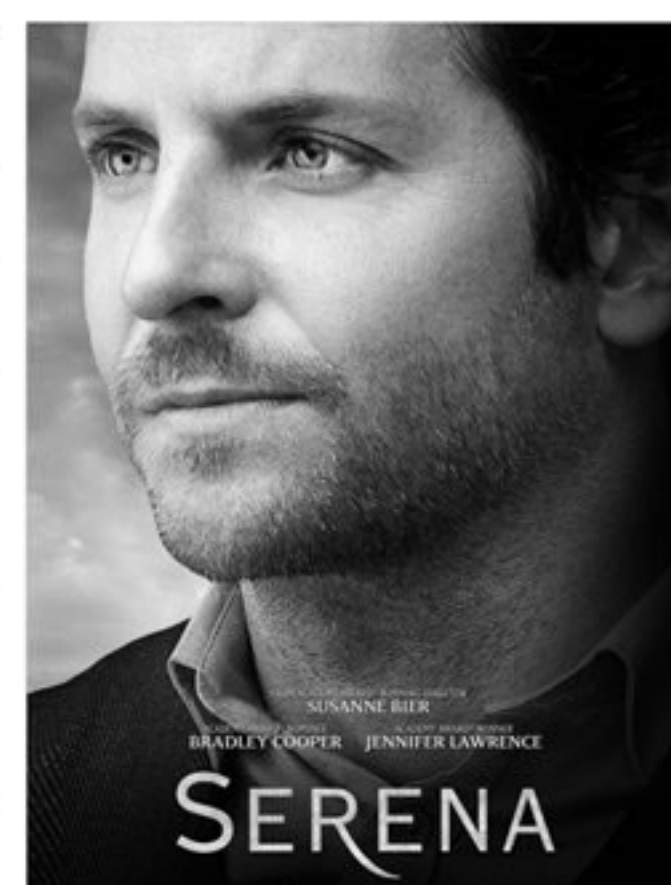
Then he gave us **Limitless**, **Silver Linings Playbook**, **American Hustle** and **American Sniper**, and showed that he is more than capable of portraying complex and emotionally demanding roles. It is actually a kind of a phenomenon just how famous his role in **The Hangover** franchise has made him: when we see a popular film or a TV show from the late 90s or early 00s, and notice Bradley Cooper, we all go No way! That was him?! Bradley Cooper was born in Philadelphia, where he lived next to a movie theatre. Having graduated from

Germantown Academy, Cooper attended Georgetown University, where he graduated with honors and earned a BA in English. In 2000, he received an MFA in acting from Actors Studio Drama School at the prestigious The New School. During this time, he worked at the Philadelphia Daily News and, for a while, as a doorman in Morgan's Hotel in New York. At Georgetown, he learned French and then traveled to France, where he spent six months as an exchange student. His first (TV) debut was in an episode of **Sex and the City**, in 1999, while his first-ever big screen performance came out in

2001, in **Wet Hot American Summer**, where he played a gay camp counselor, who is trying to organize a talent show on the last day of camp. Interestingly enough, on July 31 this year, the cult comedy film is coming back in the form of a TV series: Netflix is bringing us the 8-episode show with all of the characters from the original film, including Bradley Cooper, David Hyde Pierce, Ken Marino, Christopher Meloni, Janeane Garofalo, Paul Rudd and Elizabeth Banks. For the next three years, Cooper played the role of the best friend/super spy next to Jennifer Garner in **Alias**.





H He also filmed a thriller movie **Changing Lanes** with Ben Affleck and Samuel L. Jackson, as well as several TV movies. We also saw him in **Wedding Crashers** next to Owen Wilson, Vince Vaughn and Christopher Walken, while in **Failure to Launch** he played next to Matthew McConaughey and Zooey Deschanel. In 2005, Cooper cooked up an excellent performance in Fox's sitcom **Kitchen Confidential**, based on a book written by chef and renowned food critic, Anthony Bourdain. Cooper played in

the lead, as an executive chef who makes a comeback to the culinary world and gathers a team of chefs to run a restaurant in New York. Even though the sitcom was brilliantly written and the cast consisted of such names as Nicholas Brendon, John Francis Daley, John Cho, Frank Langella, as well as the beautiful Bonnie Somerville and Jaime King, the show was cancelled after the first season. The actor appeared in the popular show **Nip/Tuck**, and then went on to film **Yes Man**, **The Rocker**, **He's Just Not That into You** and **All about Steve**, while he also did some theatre work.



However, it was the role of Phil Wenneck that got the actor true recognition. The film **The Hangover** is the story of four friends who are about to spend a bachelor party in Las Vegas. The men wake up with a severe hangover and a highly unusual guests in their room (a tiger, a chicken and a baby), while their friend who is supposed to get married soon is nowhere to be found. The plot of the film is actually based on the film's executive producer's story (Chris Bender's friend disappeared and found himself with a large bill after going to a strip club). After shooting the film in Nevada for 15 days, Bradley Cooper, Ed Helms and Zach Galifianakis formed a real friendship. The writers of the script claim that they wanted

to write the worst possible scenario for the morning after a bachelor party – and to a great commercial success! The comedy grossed over \$460 million worldwide and became the highest-grossing R-rated comedy ever in the US. That same year, Cooper proudly attended the Razzie Award, together with his co-star, Sandra Bullock, to accept the award for their roles in **All about Steve**. For his next role, the actor had to undergo a strict dieting and exercising regime to prepare for the role in **The A Team**. He was also part of the cast of **Valentine's Day** which grossed about \$215 million around the world. The following years proved nothing but successful for Cooper. In 2011, he starred next to Robert De Niro in **Limitless**, a thought-provoking thriller that centers



on the appearance of a smart drug that allows you to access 100% of your brain – with some side-effects, of course. Soon came **The Hangover Part II**, earning \$580 million in box offices around the globe, and Cooper's international success brought him the *International Man of the Year* award, and that same year, **People** magazine named Cooper *Sexiest Man Alive*. In **Silver Linings Playbook**, Cooper teamed up with De Niro once again, and their roles got them each an Oscar nomination. Cooper filmed two drama films, **The Place beyond the**

Pines and **The Words**, but it was a comedy, **American Hustle**, that got him his next Oscar nomination. After finishing **The Hangover** trilogy, Cooper lent his voice to a grumpy animated character Rocket Raccoon in the Marvel Studios' **Guardians of the Galaxy**. America's sweetheart, popular actress Jennifer Lawrence joked about having a work marriage with Cooper, as they have filmed the total of four films together so far (**Silver Linings Playbook**, **American Hustle**, **Serena** and **Joy**). Earlier this year, we saw Cooper on the red carpet again,

this time with two Oscar nominations – one for Best Picture and the other for Best Actor, making him the 10th person who has earned acting nominations three years in a row. Cooper also made an outstanding performance in the Broadway revival of the **Elephant Man** for which he received a Tony Award nomination for *Best Actor in a Play*. Later this year, there will be more of this brilliant actor to see; in July, he will appear in all of the 8 episodes of **Wet Hot American Summer** on Netflix, and the film **Aloha**, next to Emma Stone, Rachel McAdams, Bill Murray and John Krasinski. Cooper has also agreed to take part in the CBS show **Limitless** as much as his busy schedule will allow him. Honestly, we may not have noticed him in his pre-fame roles, but we sure will be keeping a close eye on him and his future accomplishments.

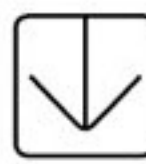

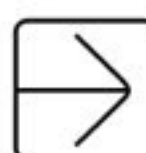

March to the Beat of Your Own Drum

TOM WAITS

Thomas Alan 'Tom' Waits is many things – singer-songwriter, composer, actor – all in all, an artist of a distinctive persona. His voice sounds like 'it was soaked in a vat of bourbon, left hanging in the smokehouse for a few months, and then taken outside and run over with a car'.





Waits never liked the 60s and its music, but this was when the very beginning of his career occurred

Waits, a self-taught piano player, once said that he found his love of music during his trips to Mexico on which his father, the Spanish teacher, often took him. As an admirer of Bob Dylan, Lord Buckley, Jack Kerouac, Louis Armstrong, Howlin' Wolf, and Charles Bukowski, it's no wonder that, combined with great talent, Waits developed his own peculiar expressive style of music. He took on many odd jobs when he was young – he worked as a club doorman, in a pizza restaurant, for the US Coastguard and as an ice cream truck driver. However, he never missed out the opportunities to perform, which ultimately lead him towards his star-

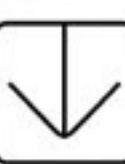

dom. Waits never really liked the 60s and its music, but this was when the very beginning of his career occurred. What came in the later decades was much more to his liking.

Since peculiar music requires peculiar instruments, hardware stores were where he often found and still finds items which he transforms into percussion instruments. One of his oddest instruments was a debris dumpster,

which he turned into *Strata Dumpster* (a.k.a. Dumpstalele). The sound this instrument made was what he described as 'train-like and

huge, like trash day with a purpose'. Other unusual instruments he likes to use include calliope (or steam piano) and a bow-played, water-filled, tubular creation known as the *waterphone*.

Nevertheless, his favorite is *Chamberlain Music Master 600*, which is an early analog synthesizer with samples of everything from galloping horses to owls hooting. Someone once said his favorite sound was of bacon frying in a pan. Waits is one of those rare people who can scat convincingly, while his lyrics often depict grotesque, distorted, unnatural, and many times seedy characters and places. Each of his albums, even the ones that are deemed less good, is certainly worth owning, or, at least, worth listening to. He is the type of artist who excessively enjoys giving free rein to his visions and who follows any sudden desire

or capricious idea. That is why he has dozens of perfect songs, not only featured on his LPs, but on more soundtracks than he can remember as well. In the recent years, while in his sixth decade of life, he has been no less restless than when he was young. In *The Book of Eli* (2010), opposite Denzel Washington, Waits played the role of 'The Engineer'. In early 2011, he completed a set of 23 poems with the title *Seeds on Hard Ground*, inspired by Michael O'Brien's book *Hard Ground* and his portraits of the homeless. He got into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in March 2011 with his customary humor saying, 'They say I have no hits and that I'm difficult to work with... like it's a bad thing'. His last (seventeenth) music

album, *Bad as Me*, was released in October 2011, and the following year he appeared in *Seven Psychopaths*, next to *Colin Farrell*, *Woody Harrelson*, *Sam Rockwell* and *Christopher Walken* among others. In 2013, he recorded the song *Shenandoah* with *Keith Richards* and joined *The Rolling Stones* on stage. That same year, his songs *Hold On* and *I Don't Wanna Grow Up* were sung in *The Walking Dead* series. And in June 2014, his song *Come on Up to the House* from his album *Mule Variations* was used in *Orange Is the New Black*. Waits' most recent appearance was this May, when he sang *Take One Last Look*, on one of the final broadcasts of *Late Show with David Letterman*.

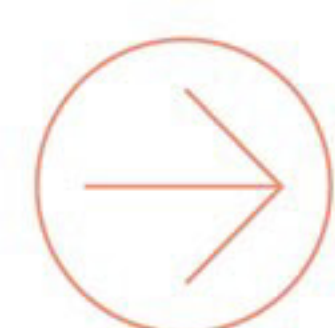
SWIMMING

Do you want an idea of what cliff diving is? You've heard about the height, the speed and the impact but can't imagine the real dimensions of this rapidly-progressing sport? Picture the following: stand on a balcony on the eighth floor and look down – 88.5ft, that's the height. Accelerate your car from 0-53mph in three seconds – unless you're steering a sports car, you won't be quick enough. The force on impact is enormous and stops you within one second. You have

to be stronger than the water; otherwise, rather than you breaking the water, it'll break you. Cliff diving is a beautiful sport, which is both pure and intense. For the athletes, cliff diving is the higher version of regular Olympic diving where the maximum height is 33ft. The technique, the dives, the preparation and basic skills are all the same. The two main differences are the feet-first entries and the height. Cliff divers almost triple it and dive off a 88.5ft high platform.



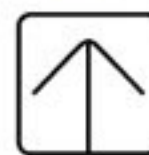
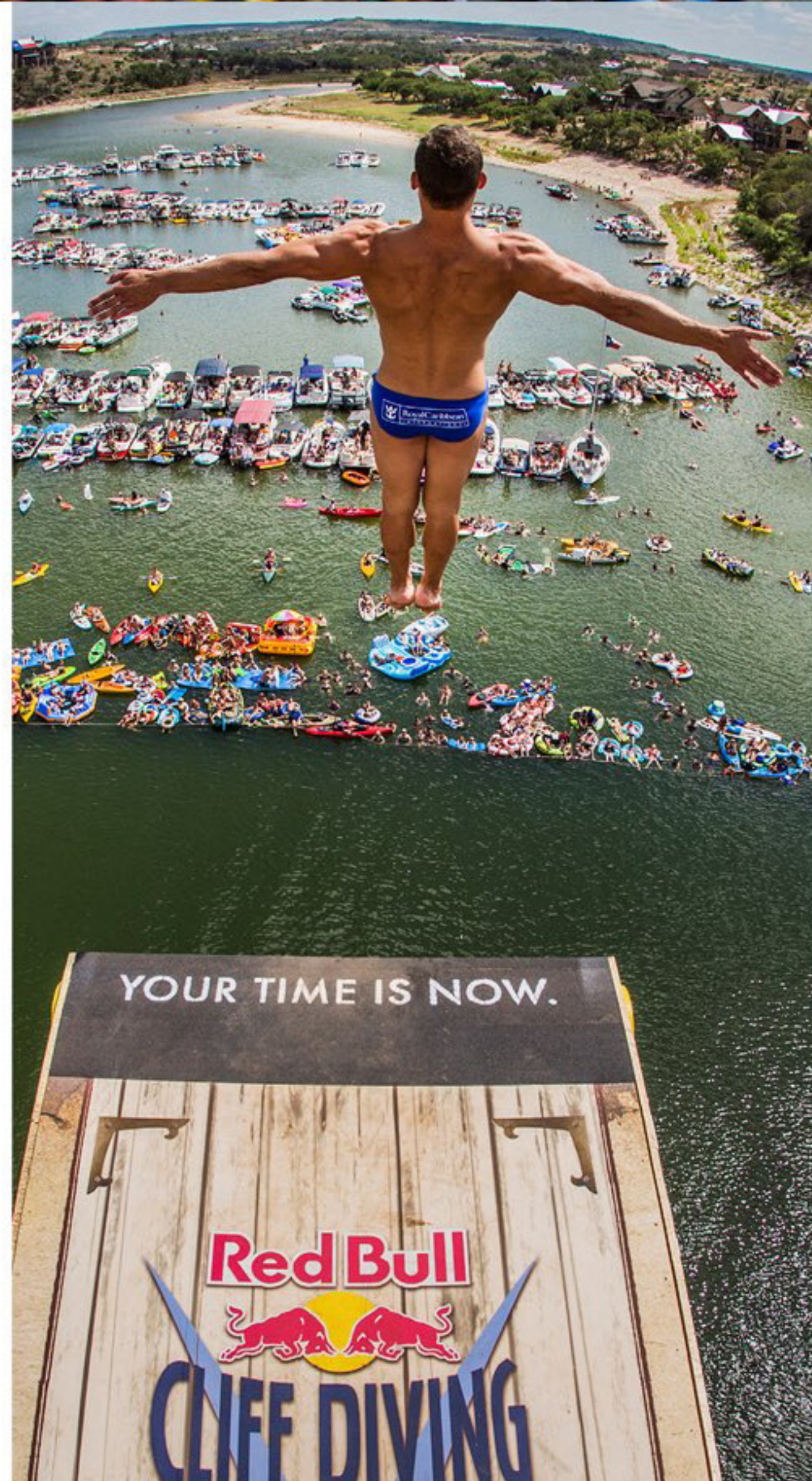

This allows you to fit a lot more flips and a lot more twists into a single dive, but the principles remain the same. It is the height that means divers really have to show control in order to dive successfully, and with the progression of diving, they need this much room to execute all the maneuvers in the air in the harder dives. “I was happy diving from the 3ft springboard as a kid and I’m just happy that I can continue diving now. At the end of the day it’s pretty extreme what we’re doing, but at the same time it’s still diving and just keeping that passion for what you love,” explains Steven LoBue, who finished third overall

in the 2014 Red Bull Cliff Diving World Series. In cliff diving the judging criteria are the same as in Olympic diving: the judges look at the take-off, they look at the execution in the air and the entry. “As we jump from the platform the judges look for a nice take-off. They want to see a strong push, a strong jump when you do a dive. Once you’re in the air you have to do these exact maneuvers that you roll down. They’re looking for exactly those things, you cannot improvise, you cannot freestyle, you cannot change it in the air,” describes Colombia’s Orlando Duque, the owner of 12 world titles in this sport,

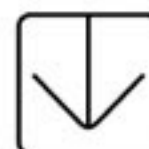


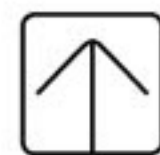
“they are looking exactly for that one dive! And also they look for clean lines, nice arms, nice legs, good position in the air and finally water entry – no splash! They want to see clean entries, a nice sound and the combination of that gives you 10 points!” And those 10 points don’t come by relaxing in the air. It all starts with a great take-off, because once you’re in the air, it’s very difficult to change something. All the rotational speed for the somersaults and twists comes from the jump off the platform. What happens in the air exactly is hard to explain. “It’s sort of a blur. I try to think about it all the time, but your body just goes on “autopilot”. I’ve been diving for 21/22 years now and I’ve been into high diving since 2011; so all those movements are just engrained and the second you leave the platform, your body just kind of takes over and knows what to do,” says American Steve LoBue, “Definitely on the easier dives, when you take off, you’re going to really feel that wind in the hair and you are really going to feel the acceleration, you can hear the acceleration and that’s

what’s a little bit scary.” From 0-53mph in less than three seconds – that’s speed in its purest form. A regular family car would not be able to catch up with the free-fall of a cliff diver! Within the blink of an eye, the feet of the divers touch the water and it’s the moment when the enormous force of entry impacts on the body. You need to rip the entry and you still need to stay strong under the water, as a good entry doesn’t always save you from injuries during the deceleration process. According to the divers, water acts in mysterious ways and the body can be moved into unexpected positions, so it’s something you must always respect. Besides the actual performance of a dive, what also comes into play is the mental aspect, which is one of the biggest challenges of cliff diving. “It’s one of the only sports where you can’t really train every day from 88.5 feet and so you really have to train your brain to imagine exactly how it would feel to train from those heights,” explains four-time World Series champion Gary Hunt. Mind and body have to be really connected,

that is the only way of ensuring that everything is going to work the way it should.

Having mastered gravity for three seconds, you resurface from the water surrounded by air bubbles and experience a feeling that's indescribable. "It's such a rush, it is a lot of fun, you feel the blood pumping, you feel like you're alive again!" – that's how Orlando Duque, a third-place

finisher in the season-opener in Cartagena, Colombia, describes it. Russia's Artem Silchenko, the 2013 World Series champion, has an almost poetic approach to it: "In our lives we have a lot of rules and on the platform I have my own rules. I can do what I've prepared myself to do, how I want to do it and nobody can tell me anything. It's freedom; it's beautiful!"

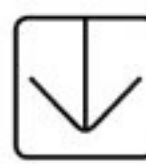

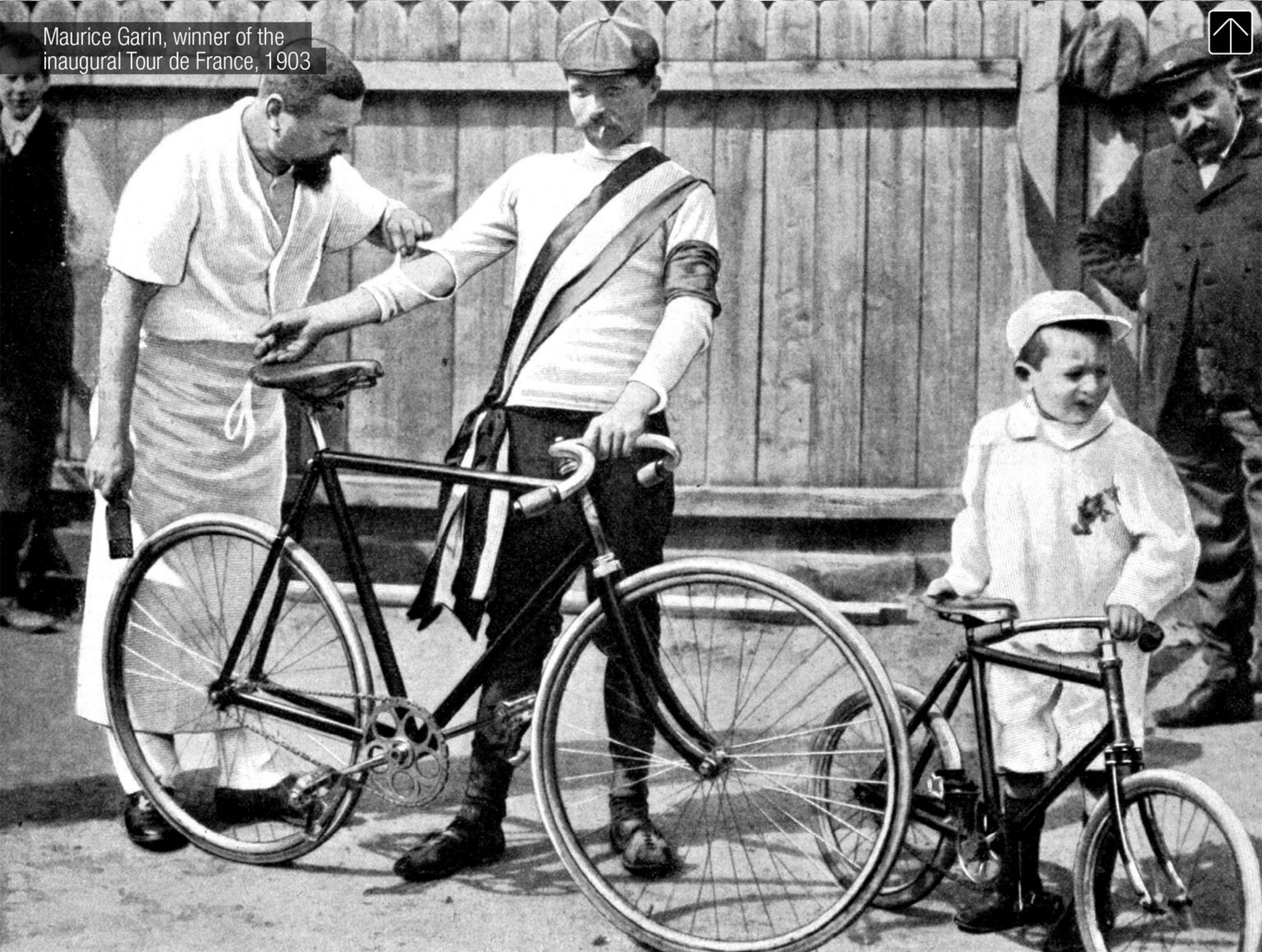

THE FIRST GREAT HERO OF THE TOUR WAS **PHILIPPE THYS**, AND HE WAS THE CHAMPION THREE TIMES.

The story of the most popular cycling race in the world does not begin in 1903, the year when the first one was held, but in 1902. That year, a young journalist from *L'Auto*, who passionately kept track of the rise of the new sport, suggested the race to be held for the purposes of promoting the magazine. The idea was to use this marketing

trick in order to push the competition, *Le Vélo* magazine, out of the picture. The race was also a means of making way in the circulation wars, and it turned out to be a prestigious cycling review. In 112 years, there have been 102 races (during the World Wars the races were put on hold). The name of the first race was **six-day** race, and the prizes were as high as 20,000 francs.



That race started from the *Café au Reveil Matin*, in *Montgeron*, one of the suburbs in *Paris*, and the participants had to ride through *Lyon, Marseille, Toulouse, Bordeaux* and *Nantes*, with the finish line being in *Paris*. It lasted 19 days, with six stages and it was over 1500 miles long. As many as 60 cyclists participated, only some of which were from Western Europe, and the winner was *Maurice Garin*.


The next *Tour* brings the first problems and controversies. The winner and another three participants were disqualified due to their use of 'inadequate help'. This may be regarded as the first real doping scandal. Although the organizers met with many challenges, the *Tour* grew – the 8th race climbed the *Pyrenees*, and a year later it reached the *Alps*. Many improvements were also introduced – in 1919, the *yellow jersey*, and in 1933, a special prize for mountain stages. At the beginning of the century, *Tour* became so big, it rode hand in hand with the greatness of the Olympic Games. The first great hero of the *Tour* was *Philippe Thys*, and he was the champion three times. The winners of the race were considered heroes and idols in their homelands. The organizers and creators of the race insisted on individual competing, and only a small number of races offered team competing. Cyclist themselves had to fix their bikes, which were without gears, while changing them was

forbidden. During the 30s, the tradition of competing upon application was neglected and first regional teams were established. After having finished the stage for the day, many of the participants performed tricks in front of hotels in order to advertise them. Riding using the chronometer was introduced in 1934. In the 60s, one of the last changes was made and it was the setting up of an introductory race, the so-called *prologue*.

National teams emerged, some of them big, some with not so many members. Sponsors were unsatisfied, and the 60s rules regarding teams were reinstated. Anti-doping actions were taken during that decade as well. Unlike many other sport disciplines where women go side by side with men, in cycling that never happened. Namely, races for women were organized only a couple of times in the 80s and that was it.

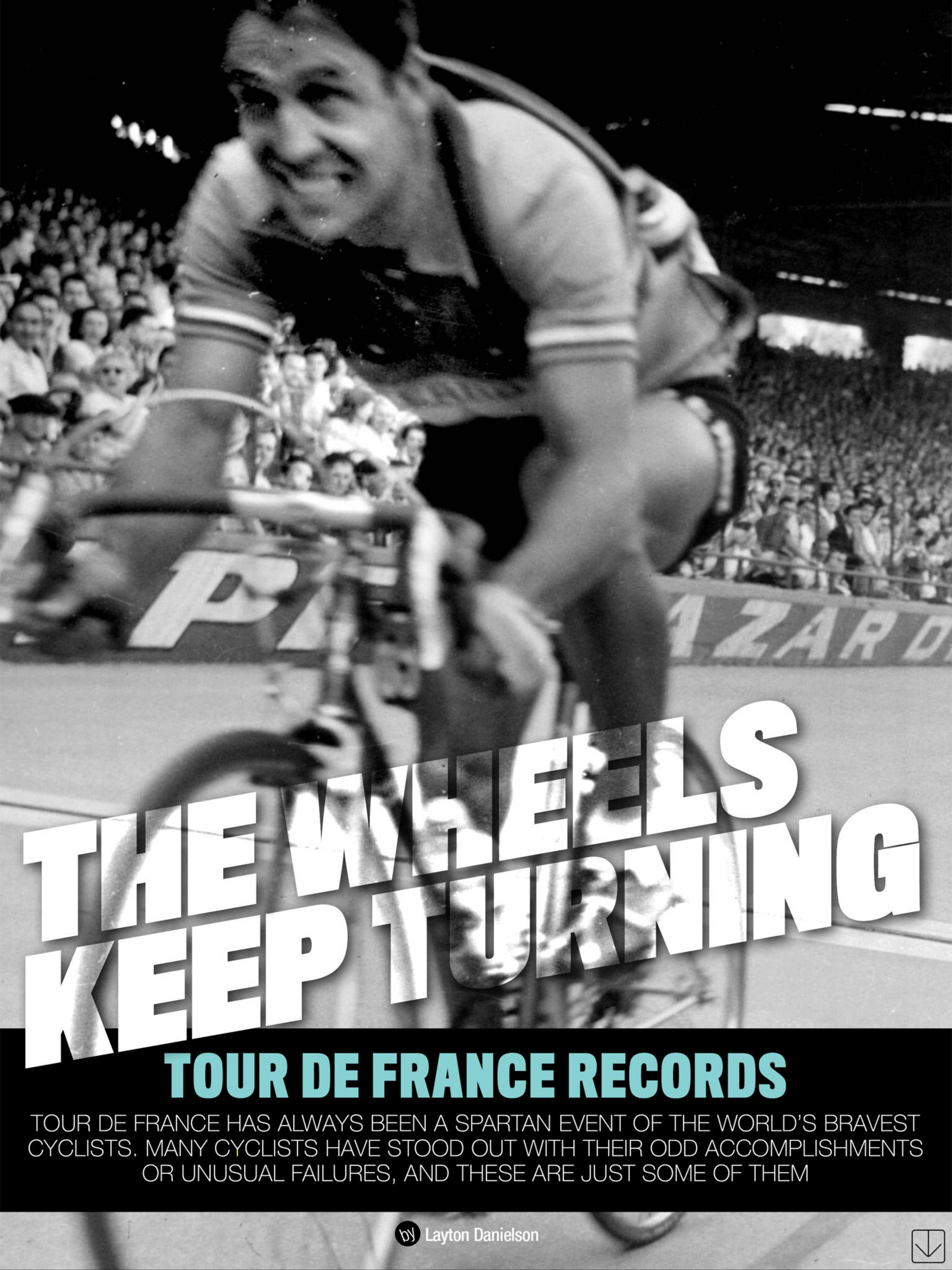

In 1926, the first tragedy on trek happened. The winner of that (and the previous) race, **Ottavio Bottecchia**, was murdered by a peasant, who allegedly claimed being stolen some produce. Another version tells the story of a hate crime – where he was killed by an antifascist, and the third where **Bottecchia** was violently murdered while committing adultery. The titles went to winners from only 13 countries. The most winners came from France which has twice the score of the second-placed country. **Jacques Anquetil** was the first five-time winner. Next to him, **Eddy Merckx**, **Bernard Hinault** and **Miguel**

Indurain won the *Tour* five times. The greatest scandal of the *Tour* is linked to the man who won the most trophies, **Lance Armstrong**. The champion of seven times was proclaimed guilty of using forbidden substances, and in 2012, he was stripped from all seven medals. From the 70s onward, the number of spectators has been in constant rise, so the race now has over 100 million spectators every year from every corner of the world. *Tour de France* is a kind of sport spectacle that should deserve all the attention only because of its tradition. Just consider the Spartan type of stages and the almost Promethean efforts of the cyclists, and you get the real sport for real men.

invited the artist Ornamental Conifer and the surfboard shaper Mason Dyer of *Dyer Brand* to design the **BMW Concept Path 22** together. Based on their scrambler interpretation, they wanted to create a kind of projection of the particular blend of people and cultures to be found at *Wheels & Waves*. And they found the perfect partners to do just this. The name *Path 22* refers to one of the insider secrets among Europe's surf spots. This particular stretch of beach is inaccessible to cars, located on the Atlantic coast of southern France, half an hour's walk through one of Europe's biggest pine forests. The path leading to this spot bears the number 22.

• THE MOTORCYCLE – THE EXPRESSION OF FREEDOM

The BMW Concept Path 22 symbolizes freedom – freedom of thought and its expression. The *Concept Path 22* is based on the **BMW R nineT**, which is the epitome of a custom bike. It is actually designed to be modified – customized according to individual preferences. At the heart of the **BMW Concept Path 22**, there is a powerful two-cylinder boxer engine with cardan drive – as is typical of **BMW**. The single-sided swing arm makes the five-spoke rear wheel visible, again a familiar **BMW** feature. The remainder of the bike is equally genuine and down-to-earth. The classic circular headlamp, the fuel tank and a short seat ensure clear, agile proportions. The body finishes visually above the rear hub, thereby promising versatile handling. Typical scrambler features such as studded tires, a large front wheel, slightly extended sprint travel and a raised exhaust mean the bike moves effortlessly

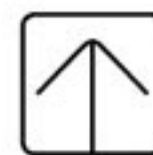




over gravel and sand. These elements also create a striking appearance, instantly suggesting the kind of experience the **BMW Concept Path 22** is able to offer.

- **RIDING FUN IN ITS MOST ORIGINAL FORM**

The **BMW Concept Path 22** is stripped down to the essentials. In addition to the rustic elements such as the studded tires and the protective grid in front of the headlamp, there are also high-end details such as the stitched leather seat, the handles with leather inserts and the typical scrambler-style *Akrapovic* tailpipes in high-quality stainless steel that add a touch of exclusive flair. High performance parts by *Öhlins* and *Gilles Tooling*, clever solutions such as direction indicators integrated in the handlebar ends, the *MotoGadget* instrument panel and the contrast-cut milled parts created by Roland Sands Design further emphasize the bike's quality detail. The milled aluminum wheels – likewise contrast-cut – were produced exclusively by **BMW Motorrad**, rounding off the motorcycle's minimalist appearance in top-class style.

The headlamp pan, fuel tank and mudguards of the **BMW Concept Path 22** bear the artwork of Ornamental Conifer, alias Nico Sclater. He has been part of the Wheels & Waves movement for a long time and is co-founder of the scene's graphic identity. The mischievous style of his typography is typically combined with profound and pithy puns. He not only created the concept bike's special paint finish but also painted a number of exclusive **BMW** leather jackets for the *Concept Path 22* team – each one a unique specimen.

• RIDING THE WAVES – BOARDS BY DYER BRAND

A particular highlight of the **BMW Concept Path 22** is the surfboard holder on the right-hand side. Specially developed by **BMW** Motorrad, it is as reduced, functional and high-quality as the bike itself. Made solely of machined aluminum and leather, it is highly variable and can be adapted to different board sizes. When not required it can be folded down to disappear into the bike's silhouette or else simply dismounted. The boards to suit the holder were made by no less than leading shaper Mason Dyer himself of Dyer Brand in San Diego. Dyer has made two custom boards exclusively for the **BMW Concept Path 22**: a longboard (9'4) and a shortboard (6'8).

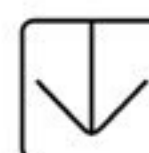

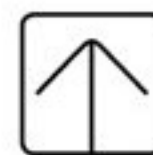

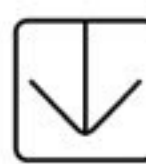


Throughout his career, he performed some large roles that reflected the moral and ethical values of the time, but also coincided with his worldview. Combining strong masculinity with strong and always attractive facial features, he was able to display a wide range of various characters, known for their gentle brutality.

His acting boom concurs with a number of political and ideological, sociological, but also cultural definitions of the world. The variety of roles that Peck carried out only contributed to the establishment of values in the society after the WWII. The huge material, and spiritual destruction caused by the war, forced the post-war generation of artists to take on the role of playwrights and organizers of a new and democratic world. Peck, with his grand appearance, manliness, constancy and moderation,

was one of the pioneers in creating post-Nazi freedom. One of the important traits Peck owned was his moral force and scruples, which only few people in the movie industry possessed.



His behavior off camera strengthened the image of a real man. He was a faithful husband, a non-fanatic Catholic, a humanitarian, a gallant with striking and noble posture. Thanks to such an image, he succeeded in depicting the common man with whom people connected and identified. He often chose roles in accordance with his beliefs, and thus played a journalist who exposes anti-Semitism, or a lawyer who defends a wrongfully accused African-American.


The easiness with which he portrayed characters was amazing. With face features which never go out of style and which perfectly fit into any persona, together with an old-fashioned gentleman's allure, he appeared authentic in a variety of roles. He remained recognizable by a mysterious smile and eyes that could seduce as much as they could intimidate.

Despite the power of Hollywood to gloss over the many secrets and shortcomings of society, Peck's appearance managed to bring the authenticity of the common man in the modern world. His roles have become a paradigm of common sense as opposed to racism and anti-Semitism.

As a free artistic spirit, to the astonishment of many, he accepted the

A role of the infamous Nazi, Josef Mengele, in the movie **The Boys from Brazil** (1978). Masterfully playing a Nazi psychopath, he stood shoulder to shoulder with *Sir Laurence Olivier*. The choice of this role had only confirmed his talent and clear views of the world.

He was a great charmer, even when he left his wife for a 16 years younger Frenchwoman. To his ex-wife he left a luxury villa, a million dollars and custody of their boys. To the Association against Cancer he donated 50 million dollars. After the assassination of *Martin Luther King Jr.*, as the President of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts he moved the Academy Award ceremony.

He opposed the Vietnam War and sided with the American youth who were protesting, saying they do their civic duty by refusing recruitment. Such decision only confirms the depth of his views on the world and perseverance in the uniqueness and individuality.

The movies he was in are an example of how a male beauty can come from a firm moral stand, and not only from a pretty face and brawny body. He was the last true Hollywood knight. He appeared in a range of roles – from sailor to gunman, priest to journalist, lawyer to the Nazi criminal. In each role he proved a lavish gift, but his appearance marked not only a period of time, but also a time of masculinity and morality.

A Although many facts about one of the most underrated and misunderstood American writers remain unclear, his name slowly arises from the shadow of fabricated anonymity. Critics unskillfully try to warp his legacy. In many analyses there often appeared a thesis of chaos, unscrupulousness, and savagery, that is, the anarchy in the artistic, sexual, political, and psychological sense. The elitist eye failed to recognize the thread of a non-

egocentric rebelliousness that is inherent in Kerouac's testimonies.

Jack Kerouac defined generational values with his work. He found them diving into, only seemingly, most provisory and most obscure details of everyday life. About the injustice and cruelty of biological and social life of lost individuals he wrote in simple language, inspired by the magnificence of a downfall.

As a child of Canadian Francophone immigrants, he constantly invented stories. English was his second language.

As part of the post-war generation that opposed the materialistic and conventional culture, he managed to create a linguistic and stylistic revolution that was searching for a more spiritual self-realization.

The most renowned *beatnik*, he lived only 47 years. His life was filled with adventures, love, exploration and violence. He used to disengage the world, and not analyze it. He never found peace. Hidden deep from the mainstream, he started a hippie idea. Beatniks were precursors of the hippie army that would enter historical scene with all the power of hatred with which the conservatives showered it.

Sentences rich with energy and non-conformism are the essence of his writing. In their search for satisfying the moment, Kerouac's characters go through drug, alcohol and sex induced visions. The plot is full of movement and everything is pervaded by a sense of displacement. Sometimes this movement is only

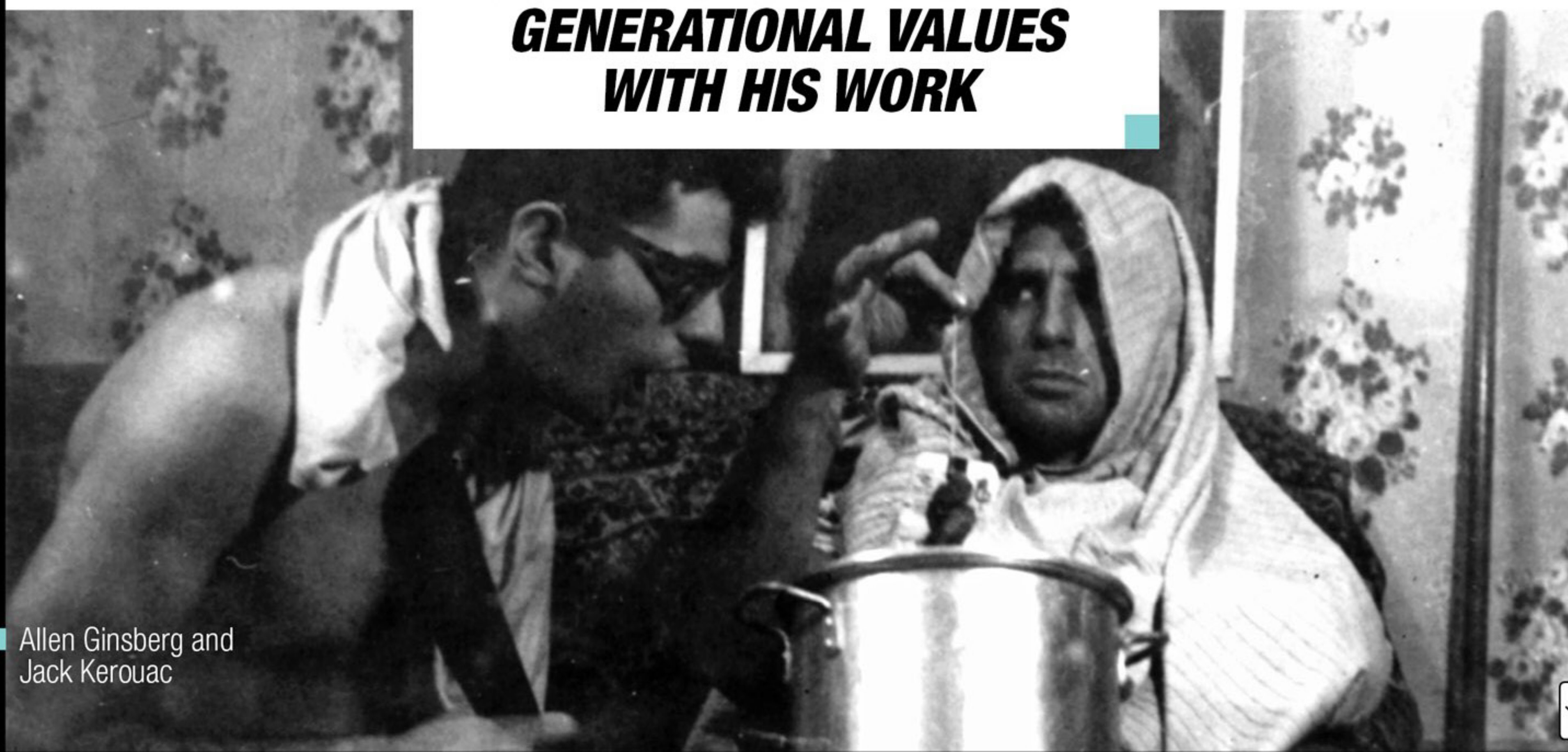
a simulacrum of the carousel.

In his stories, he intimately narrates about his friends whom he proudly names his comrades. With him at the helm, the whole beat generation was proclaimed juvenile, infantile, decadent and delinquent. Unable to defend his views, he remained frustrated, but despite everything, all of them together managed to represent their ideas proclaiming freedom of speech.


Although the creator of the whole concept and the name, Kerouac remained unknown while Ginsberg and Burroughs imposed as underground celebrities. It wasn't until years later that he became famous. Always in pursuit of his restless spirit, he fed his inner demons with alcohol, drugs and countless sexual experiences.

He was conflicted by his dual personality. He was hated by the conservatives for his free life and, in their opinion, unreasonable choices. Extreme leftists did not understand his Catholicism

and hostility toward communism. In this gap with clearly defined attitudes, we can see the power of his personality. He was a liberal, but certainly not a voyeur; a spiritual being, but not a mindless fanatic. Although he became a spokesman of the generation, he never liked this position because he saw himself as a writer, not an arbitrator on duty. The world was supposed live for itself, and he would be there to catch its contours while rushing drugged at a neck-breaking speed to the moment of satisfaction.

Jack Kerouac is an author of the average and proportionally the most wanted and best-selling book in the United States, which is even today, nearly 60 years since the release, sold in annual circulation of hundreds of thousands of copies. ***On the Road*** is the second most commonly stolen book from the American libraries, right behind the ***Bible***.

Creating a crisp and modern expression, he managed to stay in the epicenter of the literary rhythm, despite the whims of time and trends.

The first version of this novel was heavily censored. It went through editorial correction and mutilation. Characters' names and many explicit scenes were removed. Only 50 years after the publication of the first edition, or a false version as we can easily call it, the real, wild, uncontrolled and exciting book finally got published. The original manuscript was written in one breath during the course of three weeks, on a kitchen table and under strong coffee

and sedative influence. It was written nervously, without new paragraphs and wrapped in 36-meter-long tape. Kerouac wrote it wildly, angrily, not caring about the form. He managed to imprint all the important impressions, which make this novel not only a testament of the USA, but also a worthy and authentic literary version of the whole state. This novel is the USA. Bob Dylan, Hunter S. Thompson and Tom Waits are just some who were influenced by the novel.

Even though he led a turbulent life, death found him in front of a TV. Scraping, living with his mother and third wife in a pensioner-like manner, he died from liver failure. Self-destructive tempo of an inspired writer finally caught up on him in 1969. Although out of sight, he never found his peace. His anger continues to live on through each republication of his poems and novels.
