





Sharri Jones-Guest Editor



ronx, NY native Kerry Washington graduated from The Spence School in 1994 and George Washington University theater program in 1998. Washington began her career in independent projects, such as Our Song (2000), and Lift (2002) as well as Save the Last Dance (2001), for which she received a Teen Choice Award for Best Breakout Performance. Besides booking day-player roles in popular TV series, she was recognized for her talent in 2004 when she starred in four great films which include, Against The Ropes, Sidney Lumet's Strip search, Spike Lee's She Hate Me, and Ray. She also won an award for Outstanding Actress in a Motion Picture for Ray at the NAACP Image Awards. She had another great year in 2005 when she appeared in Mr. and Mrs. Smith starring Brad Pitt and Angelina Jolie, Fantastic Four, and Wait. That same year Washington was awarded Americans for the Arts Young Artist award for incredible accomplishments and exemplary leadership.

In 2006, the stakes got higher for Washington when she starred along with Forest Whitaker in the Last King of Scotland. She was nominated for Outstanding Supporting Actress in a Motion Picture at the NAACP Image Awards in 2007. Washington starred in the Wayans brothers film Lil Man (2006). In addition, she received recognition for I Think I Love My Wife (2007), opposite Chris Rock, Fantastic Four sequel Rise of the Silver Surfer (2007), Miracle at St. Anna (2007), Lakeview Terrace (2008), starring opposite Patrick Wilson



and Samuel L. Jackson. 2008 was a great year for Washington who received the Women's Project Women of Achievement Award, the GWU Alumni Association's Recent Alumni Achievement Award, and the Congressional Black Caucus Foundation Phoenix Award, for her commitment to social advocacy.

In 2009, Washington received the U.S. Conference of Mayors Artist-Citizen Award for public leader-ship in the arts. She also made her Broadway debut in David Mamet's play Race. When asked about her experience appearing in her first Broadway show she states, "I grew up in New York, so I fell in love with acting on a stage, not in front of a camera. Theater has always been very important to me, and I had been looking for the right project to do as my Broadway debut. I'd been looking for a while, and when this came along, it was a no-brainer. I really, really wanted it, and it seemed like a good way to come back home, so to speak, to New York and the stage." (Movieline, 2009) Washington starred in Howard Zinn's documentary The People Speak, along with Matt Damon, Josh Brolin and Sean Penn, which premiered on the History Channel. Other 2009 projects included the voice of Princess Shuri in the animated series Black Panther, Life Is Hot in Cracktown, and Mother and Child, which also stars Annette Bening and Naomi Watts.

Washington's beauty can also be found outside the big screen as a spokesperson for L'Oreal Paris and as a brand ambassador for Movado. In November 2009, she was appointed by President Barack Obama to the President's Committee on the Arts and Humanities. In addition, she is also an active member of the V-Counsel, which is a group of advisors to V-Day, an organization whose aim is to end violence against women and girls. Washington also serves on the board of Voices of a People's History, which is a non-profit arts and education group that uses live performance and educational programs to illuminate the primary source material that inspired the book, Voices of a People's History of the United States.

This year be sure to catch Washington's stellar performance with Anthony Mackie in *Night Catches Us*, which premiered earlier this year at Sundance and the American Black Film festival. Washington is set to star in *The Details* (2010), *A Thousand Words* (2011) opposite Eddie Murphy, and Tyler Perry's *For Colored Girls Who Have Considered Suicide When The Rainbow is Enuf* (2011)■



ANTHONY MACKIE

HOLLYWOOD INTERVIEW



nthony Mackie was born and raised in New Orleans. After the death of his mother, during his teens, he was encouraged to direct his energies to an after-school theater program. He soon realized his love for acting, and after graduating from the New Orleans School of Creative Arts, and North Carolina School of Arts was convinced to train at Juilliard. During his Juilliard years, he earned his first critical accolades for his portrayal as rapper Tupac Shakur in the play *Up Against The Wind* (2001). He followed up with another great performance in the New York production of *Talk* which earned him an Obie award. Mackie was also Don Cheadle's understudy in the play *TopDog/UnderDog*. These performances won Mackie recognition in Hollywood, which led to his feature film debut in *8 Mile* as the main antagonist, Papa Doc, to Eminem's character. He booked many other day-player and supporting roles in films, such as *Crossing* (2003),

Hollywood Homicide (2003). Law and Order: Criminal Intent (2003), Brother to Brother, which is about the lives of a young art student and a homeless man. His performance earned him an Independent Spirit Award nomination (2004). In addition, Mackie starred in The Manchurian Candidate (2004) before receiving his first lead role in Spike Lee's She Hate Me. That film was followed by another lead role in Spike Lee's Sucker Free City. When asked about his breakthrough roles in two of Spike Lee's films, Mackie responded, "I was flabbergasted. Everybody knows when you've got a role in a Spike Lee movie, you're gonna blow up. But I happen to be the only person who's had the lead in two Spike Lee movies nobody saw. It was a humbling experience."

Mackie's career began to take off, when he booked Haven (2004), Sucker Free City (2004), Million Dollar Baby (2004), Freedomland (2006), Crossover (2006), We Are Marshall (2006), Ascension Day, where he portrayed Nat Turner. He also had a significant role in the 2008 action thriller Eagle Eye starring Billy Bob Thornton, Rosario Dawson, and Shia LaBeouf. Mackie was cast to play Tupac Shakur, yet again, in the 2009 film Notorious about the life of famed rapper Notorious B.I.G. Additionally, he was scheduled to follow up with Desert Flower (2009), alongside Ethiopian supermodel Liya Kebede, and the romantic drama that takes place in the 1976 Black Panther movement Night Catches Us (2010) with his She Hate Me cast mate, Kerry Washington.

Mackie's most recent accomplishment was his stellar performance in Kathryn Bigelow's Oscar award-winning drama, *The Hurt Locker*, which won Mackie a Black Reel award for best supporting actor, a Gotham award for best ensemble cast, and a Washington D.C. Film Critics Award for best ensemble cast, followed by a plethora of other nominations.

His upcoming projects in production include: The Adjustment Bureau (2010), Bolden (2010), Real Steel, and Babylon (2011), rumored do be in the pre-production stage, Jessie Owens.



Idris Elba has had one remarkable journey, and we had the pleasure of following his career from small day player roles in UK shows to his journey to the states. He struggled to survive in New York while he Deejayed downtown to make ends meet. In addition, he performed in Shakespeare off-Broadway performances until his 2002 breakthrough hit TV series The Wire. This was followed by his onscreen debut in the 2005 Rainforest Films' The Gospel. His latest Rainforest Films project is Takers.

dris Elba was born in Hackney, East London, to a Ghanaian mother and a Sierra Leonean father. In his teen years he began to Deejay and eventually set up his own company. With the help of a Prince Trust Grant, he was accepted into the National Youth Music Theatre. He had his mind set on studying acting at an early age, thanks to encouragement from one of his drama teachers. After booking small guest star-ring roles in the British TV series 2Point4 Children (1994) and Space Precinct (1994), Elba was recognized for his first supporting role in 1995 in the award-winning UK comedy series Absolutely Fabulous, as well as the TV drama Bramwell. Elba was on a roll, the following year he began booking consecutive guest starring and recurring roles in many popular British TV series, such as Ruth Rendell Mysteries, The Governor, Silent Witness, Insiders, Family Affairs, UltraVIolet, and the BBC crime thriller Dangerfield, among a others.

During an HBO interview, Elba 🥇 stated, "It is rare for producers in \(\ceps\) the UK to take a chance on unknown actors, especially since § there is a small Black audience in a England, which for economic reasons, would result in insufficient financial return because of ratings." He knew that he would consistently be pigeonholed in supporting roles and felt he # would always be typecast as the friend, best crook detective. According to a recent (continued on page 166)

Her most recent project Takers, starring Paul Walker, Idris Elba, Hayden Christensen, Michael Ealy, Matt Dillon, Jay Hernandez, Chris Brown, and (TI)Tip Harris. Takers was the opening night premiere at the 2010 American Black Film Festival.

Zoe Saldana was born in New Jersey and raised in Queens, New York. During her early years her family moved back to Dominican Republic where Zoe began training at the prestigious ECOS Espacio de Danza Dance Academy. After moving back to the states, as a teenager she began performing dance and picked up a talent agent along the way. This resulted in Saldana's film debut in the dance drama Center Stage (2000), where she was also able to showcase her ballet dance background.

Shortly after Zoe began appearing in such films as Get Over It (2000) with Kristen Dunst, Snipes (2001) with Nelly, and Crossroads (2002) playing the best friend of Britney Spears and Taryn Manning's characters. She received great recognition in 2002 when she played the lead and love interest alongside Nick Cannon in Drumline,

which she was nominated for an MTV award for best kiss. Zoe's career really began to take off and has been consistently non stop ever since, it's as if she has commanded the attention of a leading lady over night. Zoe has also appeared in Guess Who (2005) alongside Ashton Kutcher inspired by the 1967 film Guess Who's Coming to Dinner. She was nominated both for teen choice award for breakout female performance and black movie award for outstanding supporting actress in Guess Who. As well as the remake of the hit musical, *Fame* (2009), which is an updated version of the 1980 musical centered on the students of the New York

Academy of Performing Arts. Pennie was recgnized for his outstanding performance in a supporting role in his Academy Award nominatd film *Half Nelson* (2006) about an inner-city junior high school teacher with a drug habit who forms an unlikely friendship with one of his students after she discovers his secret.

Pennie was born and raised in Brooklyn, New York. Collins spent most of his child-hood years in numerous foster homes and then decided to move out on his own at age 15. Pennie was an ordinary kid who wanted get away from the Brooklyn projects where drugs and violence prevailed. Pennie began singing, acting and dancing and soon realized that he can use his talent to get out of the projects. Collins' knew he was talented and was determined to make sure that the major players in the industry knew it to.

Collins was in the business only six months before landing his first role on the hit CBS daytime drama As The World Turns, as Sean, After two months Pennie landed a guest-star role in NBC's Law & Order (2004). Pennie has had many recurring and dayplayer roles in other tv series, which include CBS' Without A Trace (2005) and CSI: Miami (2008).

In addition to acting, Collins is an accomplished dancer and has appeared in videos for P' Diddy's "Show Me Your Soul" for the Bad Boys 2 soundtrack and Beyonce's "Get Me". Pennie's image on the big screen caught the attention of Ford Model Management, who signed Collins immeiatley. Soon after, he was chosen to be apart of the "cK One" fragrance campaign for Calvin Klein.

When Collins is not consumed in the world of film he likes to workout and play street football and boxing. What most people wouldn't guess about Pennie is that he loves collecting sneakers and currently has over 200 pairs.

Collins is excited about his new 2010 projects, Stomp The Yard 2: Homecoming alongside Pooch Hall, on dvd this fall. He also has a recurring role in the new TNT drama series, Hawthorne starring Jada Pinkett Smith.

ainly reserved for desperate housewives and senior citizens who have the time to watch them, soap operas are filled with complicated plots, twisted cliffhangers and unending treachery. Despite the excitement and scandal, the (obvious) secret to catching and keeping the interest of viewers far and wide—you included—is to keep beautiful, charming women, such as One Life to Live's Tika Sumpter, on camera.

Sumpter, best known for playing OLTL's Layla Williamson, has been blowing away viewers with her onscreen presence on the show since 2005. While she's enjoying sweet success, it wasn't too long ago that Sumpter was struggling just to get by. "I barely had furniture in my apartment and was struggling to make ends meet, but I was busting my butt to do what I had to for my career every day," Sumpter recalls. Moving out at the tender age of 17, Sumpter remembers handling auditions between classes at Marymount College during the day and waitressing at trendy East Village café, Life, during the evening. She'd head home to an apartment nested within a drug-infested neighborhood between breaks.

Most bosses avoid letting go of their best employees. Ironically, it was Steven Lewis, founder of Life and Sumpter's boss, who jumpstarted her career by submitting her credentials to a boutique modeling agency. Sumpter believes her persistence and passion influenced Lewis' desire to assist her."He saw talent, and my desire and passion to fight for what I wanted. I fought for him to hire me. I was superyoung when I was working at that club. To work at a club of that stature at such a young age...there has to be some sort of grit and passion to succeed," Tika asserts. "[Working at Life] lit a fire under me. I'd see a lot of my heroes and people I look up to there. I mean, Janet [Jackson], Mariah Carey, Angie Harmon—up close and personal. It drove me more and he observed that."

In addition to her pivotal role on One Life to Live, Sumpter has successfully branded herself as a valuable commercial asset and voiceover artist. Never one to lock herself into one profile, Sumpter's image and likeness has been featured in major advertising campaigns for Liz Claiborne's Curve, computer giant Hewlett Packard and Cascade

On a philanthropic note, Sumpter is















Sumpter says, "Learning the step routines were her biggest challenge throughout filming. It was a challenge at first, but after a while, I just had fun with it and got it down pretty well!" She will also play the role of Jamie in the romantic comedy What's Your Number?, starring Anna Farris (Lost in Translation) and Chris Evans (Fantastic Four). Though this sounds cheesy a la Sex and the City, Sumpter reveals the film's female characters engage in more honest dialogue about sexual needs and desires in a manner most films shy away from.

Nevertheless, Sumpter continues to work hard and stay focused. "This much I know is true: I've had so many challenges on this journey—and still do. Ultimately, all of my challenges and crazy experiences make up my character. At the end of the day, I'm gonna win, no matter what, and I know this because I've gotten through all those and many other struggles. I know I'm a fighter for sure."





After making Tommy Davidson gravel in Booty Call and setting the boys straight in The Wood, Tamala is doctoring it up on ABC's new show Castle. All work and no play is not her motto, she lives life to the fullest and always gives a helping hand to the youth when possible.

BLACK MEN: The infamous Tamala Jones, how are you, what's going on?

TAMALA JONES: I'm good, trying to keep busy. I coproduced an independent movie called 35 and Ticking with Kim Whitley, Russ Parr, Kevin Hart, Nicole Ari Parker, Meagan Goode, Keith Robinson, from Dream Girls, and Wendy Raquel Robinson. Everybody was in this movie and it was such a great experience. That was [all] during my downtime from my TV show Castle that I do on ABC. But now we're back and we're shooting our third season.

BM: What made you gravitate towards the entertainment industry?

TJ: I was a character and I still am. When I was a little girl, I was always imitating family members, or something that I saw on television. I remember my aunt was pregnant and she was walking around spitting in a tis-

sue. So I went and put something in my shirt like I was pregnant and was walking around the house spitting in a tissue. They were like 'This girl is crazy.' I was dressing up like different people. It was so bad my mom was like 'I gotta put you in a workshop.' She put me in a workshop and the teacher loved me. The next weekend, a talent agent came there, and she told me to go take pictures. My first gig was an IBM commercial. I booked it and I've just been going ever since.

BM: What are your thoughts on getting into the business now—harder or easier?

TJ: Honestly, it was a lot easier back when I did it because we were just coming out of the '80s and people were worldly, open and more receptive to differences and nationalities. I feel like racism in the business is really active now. When I started out it wasn't like that. It was really based on your skill and if you were good, you got the job. For people trying to break in the business now, it's really based on whom you know and what you look like, versus your skill. It's not based on the intensity.

BM: Even though you have made your mark in the industry, do you feel that you still have to go the extra mile to prove yourself against the newbies with no talent?

TJ: Yeah. When that started, 'Let's go with this color or I don't want them to be too ethnic', I was like, "That's pretty cold but I can play that game too." So I called my (continued on page 166)







enough to briefly get an interview with Conwell as she discusses, among other things, her spiritual evolution, growing to embrace her sensuality and beauty as a woman, and her love for charitable giving and helping others smile.

BLACK MEN: Tell us about your role as Fallon. How does she reflect you as a person?

ANGELL CONWELL: Fallon is a young woman finding success as a news reporter. She's intelligent, caring, spiritual, loyal to her friends and family, and very passionate about love. I relate to her quiet independence and the fact that she's a peacemaker. I'm very much the peacemaker in my life, the one who's always like, "Can't we all just get along?" I've had my moments, but for the most part, I don't do drama—unless I'm doing it like I'm doing it for TV! (Laughs) At the same time, Fallon is a lot more conservative and spiritual than most of my past roles. Quite uptight, which is a quality I don't possess, but she's still fun to play. I love Fallon and love this role.

BM: Does theater frighten you? After all, you're required to give your all each and every night.

AC: First and foremost, I hold tremendous trust in Him, so I don't fear much. Fear is not natural, nor is it good for the body. So I do my best to challenge anything that causes me to feel afraid. I normally gravitate towards [the fear] so I can explore and give myself the opportunity to face it. The only way to it is through it! Now, theater definitely requires an enormous amount of energy. We're still rehearsing right now and I definitely feel myself using a lot of fuel, but I love a good healthy challenge—that's what keeps me alive and kicking! I never want to get complacent or regret anything. I'm learning the best way to avoid having regrets is to completely get in there and go for it. "Ain't nothin' to it but to do it!" That way, I can avoid all the "wouldacoulda-shoulda's" later in life.

BM: Are you comfortable with the experience overall? Will it improve your delivery for Hollywood?

AC: I certainly hope so. Theater is where I began. I explored it in South Carolina as a child. My first play was August Wilson's Fences. It's where I came to a definite conclusion that I was going to be an actress. As far as Hollywood, I'm not certain how anyone will look on it. You never know what mood folks will be in. (laughs) I just love work. I love what I do; I'm blessed and very fortunate to be a working actress.

BM: What are the craziest misconceptions about you? I'm sure being curvy, pretty and obviously carrying yourself with respect comes with a lot of r e s p o n s i b i l i t y .

AC: Sexiness. It seems as though when a





woman exudes any type of sex appeal, folks tend to think that it's all she's about. This is totally false. Personally, I don't find myself sexy. I'm clumsy as all outdoors. But, some very classy women raised me, and as I mature, I feel as though I'm becoming more and more like them. I'm proud of that. At one point, not too long ago, I was steering clear of doing "sexy" photo shoots because I felt folks wouldn't take me "seriously" as an actress. Then I thought about it...As hard as I work out, push myself to the limit [and give] blood, sweat and tears...I better do a damn sexy shoot. I work too hard! I just want people to understand that a woman may be sexy but that doesn't mean she's not serious. I don't take life too seriously, but I'm serious about life and certainly serious about my business.

BM: How has the entertainment business changed over time for you as you've progressed?

AC: Everyone seems to be stepping it up a few notches when it comes to creating opportunities for Black people, which is wonderful. We're realizing that if we don't clear a path for ourselves, the path may never be cleared, or we'll be waiting for a long time. It's not worth the wait when we're highly qualified and highly capable of making it happen ourselves, so I'm very proud of our growth.

BM: What are your secrets to all-around natural beauty and poise, especially when you're feeling crazy rough inside?

AC: Thank you for the compliment! Well, I certainly keep our Creator first in my life. I lean not on my own understanding. I know this gift of life is not all about "me." It's about giving back, finding and following my cause, and giving love. Keeping these truths in mind on a daily





basis allows me to remain confident and excited about life. I read more often than most folks are aware of and take the time to take care of myself, which is also important because when I do that, it keeps me level and focused on the path to being the best me I can possibly be

BM: Genuine answers and truer words never before spoken! How did you learn how to embrace, love and revel in your feminine sensuality?

AC: Thankfully, I've never been afraid to love. But what I have been afraid of is getting hurt, which can totally cause a person to hold back. But I've come to a point in my life where I know that giving your all leaves you with no regrets. I love everything about being a woman except PMS and bad hair days! (Laughs) However, it's taken me a while to become comfortable in my skin and fully embrace my sensuality. I developed at a very early age and because of that, I was different. My shape was a topic of conversation. I was very uncomfortable with it for a long while. Finally, at the age of 27, I'm closer than I've ever been. I still have a ways to go, but I appreciate what God has given me. I love the skin I'm in and learning to more with each passing day. BM: Did you enjoy your shoot with Black Men this time around?

AC: The shoot was a blast! I'm excited to be embracing my 20 sexy years! Some call your later 20s the dark side of the 20s, but I call it 20-sexy. Contrary to what many of us have been conditioned to believe, it's an enjoyable experience. I did a shot in a gorgeous Herve Leger dress. I felt quite fancy and feminine, if I may say so myself. pon our lunch meeting in Manhattan's West Village, Wendy McKenzie is a bit intimidating. She wears bangs and stands well over six feet tall in sandals, her statuesque figure dwarfing mine. Though her modeling days are behind her, the London-born, Jamaica-bred casting director has seen her profile grow due to her work on the \$40 million-grossing Biggie Smalls biopic Notorious.

McKenzie's roots in Trelawny, Jamaica—the home parish of Biggie's mother Voletta Wallace—helped her win the job, as did her experience working with Big while he was alive. She'd auditioned him for the 1995 film *New Jersey Drive*—although the part somehow went to Heavy D. [*Notorious* producer] Wayne Barrow asked what I was looking for, and I said, "I'm not looking for someone who's 6'5" and overweight just like Biggie, I'm looking for someone with his swagger and charm." In Jamal Woolard she found her man, and also helped cast the film's Lil' Kim, Naturi Naughton. During the audition, McKenzie encouraged Naughton to draw from the pain she felt after parting ways with her former R&B trio 3LW.

McKenzie also works with runway models and acting hopefuls, and has put together countless commercials, MTV promos and music videos over the years. "I call my company In The Wink Of An Eye because I can get things done like that," she says. (See inthewinkofaneye.biz for more information.) Her resume also includes casting for an Aretha Franklin video, "A Rose Is Still a Rose," Wyclef Jean's "We Trying to Stay Alive" and the live-action production of Snoop Dogg's Murder Was the Case at the 1994 MTV Music Awards. McKenzie credits her success to keeping her ear to the streets. Sure enough, by the time lunch is over, she has given her card to our waitress. You guessed it—the server is an aspiring actress.

With a potent combination of talent, beauty and wisdom beyond her years, the Kent, Ohio native has grabbed Hollywood by the throat in just a few short years. Armed with desire and trained in theater appreciation and Shakespeare, Gilbert moved to LA in 2004, and after only five months, she aced her first real audition. She subsequently booked the SOAPnet show I Wanna Be a Soap Star where she finished as runner-up during the premiere season. This success led to several appearances on popular daytime soaps, Days of Our Lives and General Hospital and numerous independent films, such as Mary Mary, The Broken Hearts Club, and The Welcoming. She worked with some of the entertainment industry's biggest names, including Spike Lee, Mariah Carey, and hip-hop artists Nelly and Snoop Dogg.

Since her successful inception into what she cynically refers to as "The Land of Oz," Maya has definitely noticed that roadblocks to opportunity still exist for ethnic actresses in Hollywood. She cites

that strife in race relations and media stereotypes still prevail and result in scarce work for ethnic talent. She experienced this mindset firsthand at a recent audition when she was told by casting that they were seeking someone a little more "waspy" or more bluntly "white." Such statements are indeed evidence that certain American institutions have yet to adjust to the more eclectic society that it has become. And, even though women are becoming more of a force, Gilbert is quick to point out that the industry is still very much controlled by men.

Her perspective on the current condition is conveyed by her comparison of today's Hollywood to her favorite film The Wizard of Oz. She states, "Oz (Hollywood) is controlled by The Wizard (Media) who manipulates the sheep. This lasts until he is revealed. The Wizard, much like the media, is able to manipulate his followers because he understands that most of the answers they seek are already within them. It simply takes the proper circumstances to bring the qualities out." The Hollywood media such as TMZ and the paparazzi act very much in the same fashion by revealing truths about individuals and celebrities that are often suppressed or denied by that person to the public. As a result, the media is able to have influence in the lives of many until self awareness is reached and accepted.

Maya counters these influences by staying grounded and focused on her goals. She understands, accepts and embraces the reality that her journey as an actress is lifelong and that there will be highs and lows along the way that you must persevere. She works hard to convey the honesty of the human experience through each of the roles that she books. Her goal isn't centered on instant fame by way of entertainment rags, reality shows, or sex tapes. She strives to be the overall talent, the actress, writer and producer with longevity. She pulls inspiration to accomplish those goals from those that have provided strong blueprints for success, such as Meryl Streep, Ruby Dee, Johnny Depp and Steven Spielberg.

With upcoming film projects in the works, such as Forgiveness, Subject 15 and the straight to DVD film The Perfect Man alongside Elise Neal, her dedication to being a strong, viable, versatile force for years to come is indeed in full swing. To define and understand her, you must simply "undefine" her. She's discovered the answers that the Wizard has known all along.

HOLLYWOOD INTERVIEW



orking in the entertainment industry is tough. Success isn't easy to come by. An aspiring actor can easily attend hundreds of casting calls in which he's just another eager face before he lands a role. Then, when he makes it, he still has to fight the deceptive demons that come with the industry-false delusions of grandeur that he's made it, snakes in the grass waiting to take advantage of his naiveté, and, of course, those who will do anything to pull him off his path.

Christian Keyes refuses to fall prey to such deceptions. A Detroit native, Keyes is a singer and actor whose extraordinary talent has led Tyler Perry to say, that he is one of the "most consistent male actors" he's worked with. Despite such praise, this levelheaded brotha remains as hardworking, grounded and driven as the day he entered the entertainment industry. Keyes maintains his tenacious focus by remembering who truly takes care of him at the end of the day.

"I don't walk around with a Bible, but I know where my blessings come from. I know it's God who opens doors for me, [and] I'm humble and appreciative," asserts Keyes, adding that he tries to be an example with his walk as opposed to showing off his knowledge of Bible scriptures.

Keyes has an established record for excellent performances as both an actor and singer. He toured as a cast member in Tyler Perry's

What's Done in the Dark, a stage play whose DVD release has sold more than 500,000 copies to date. Keyes is also known for playing Sonny in Madea Goes to Jail, which has sold over 1 million copies. Keves has also modeled for book covers and worked in commercial advertising campaigns.

Never one to be typecast, Keyes explores his talent by selecting different roles which challenge him and drive his development, stating that it's important for him to know "whether or not I can honestly bring them to life" before he commits himself to it.

"I want to bring justice to the role as far as what the writer and the director wants. I don't want a character that's too easy and I don't want to be typecast. I want to make myself work. You do your best work when you're uncomfortable and step outside of that comfort zone." He names the pretentious Stylz, his character in Dysfunctional Friends, as an example of a challenging script. "I tried to make him likeable as opposed to difficult. It took a lot of work but was one of the most fun roles I've played. I'm very proud of it."


BM: What makes you such a talented actor?



an Antonio, TX beauty Sharri Jones began her pursuit in entertainment through local pageants. After being crowned *Miss Bexar* (Bear) *County*, she began to pursue print, commercial and runway work. During her freshman year in high school, before getting bored with modeling, Jones landed campaigns with EyeMasters, Sprint, Saks Fifth Avenue and international runway shows such as Roberto Cavalli.

Although she was accepted into San Antonio College to study theater and law at the age of 16, on her 18th birthday her mother moved her to New York to pursue acting. With no regrets of her incomplete collegiate career, Jones began training at acting studios, such as TVI, Stella Adler Conservatory, Weist-Barron Studios and Black Nexxus under the tutelage of Susan Batson. She also trained with Jordan Bayne and is now working with Tony Greco. Jones will also be training at Lee Strasberg Institute in the fall/winter and at the Ivana Chubbuck Studio. Jones says, "My goal is to learn different coach's methods who have taught only the best, such as Phillip Seymour Hoffman, Taraji Henson, Angelina Jolie, and Nicole Kidman. If nothing else, I want to see if they are the right coach for me. I have come to realize that a really good acting coach for someone else may not be a good acting coach for me. I plan to eventually stick with a select few, and Tony Greco is definitely one of them." (She smiles).

After freelancing with a few boutique agencies, Jones noticed that though her look was in demand, she found herself competing for slots for the same look. She joined TSD Agency, an image-consulting firm that worked with the likes of Alicia Keys, Kelly Rowland and Vivica Fox.

Confident of her new designer image, Jones began inserting herself back into the casting network market, and booking independent roles, such as Natalia in *Still A Teen*, directed by Melvin James, *Cool Kids* directed by award-winning director/actress Rosalyn Coleman of Redwall Productions, *Blackmail* with award-winning independent film director Suraj Das, director Larry Rosen's latest zombie film entitled *Forever Yours* and *The Club* directed by Michael Pinckney.

While engrossed in the studies of film and stage, Jones' curriculum includes an AA in legal studies and a BA in Forensic chemistry as Law is her second passion in addition to entertainment. Besides an Oscar, passing the LSAT is a goal for this rising star.

A self-proclaimed bona fide scream queen, Jones has been getting a lot of horror flick callbacks. However, some of her goals include working with companies such as Rainforest Films and Tri destined Films.

BLACK MEN: You're tall, you're beautiful, you're fit, smart, well versed, funny, and have great ethics and social/professional qualities, why hasn't the industry given you your well-deserved break?

SHARRI JONES: As we know some actors get their break before others, for various reasons. However, I have no problems paying my dues and working my way up the ladder. I love indie films and have really been digging into those types of projects a little more, and branding myself at the same time. That's just the thing; people look at tall and beautiful first. Now don't get me wrong it's nice to look attractive and it's pleasing to know that's how most people view me. But I have more to bring to the table, there's more depth to me; I consider myself strong enough to also carry those roles that may not require one to get by on just looks, which is sometimes the case.

BM: With all the training, the hot new image and the editorial support, what do you think is the next step in furthering your career?

SJ: I am prepping for the 2011 release of four of my projects. Until then I am in the studio training constantly. I am going to take the route that any other smart actress would take. I am going to brand and market myself more than anything as soon as all these projects hit. I never believe that training should

cease or slow down when you start booking, I want to be a better actor than the day before every time I step into the studio.

BM: Of any successful Actress, which would you model your career after?

SJ: I know it sounds like a cliché to say Halle Berry but let me tell you it goes beyond being beautiful. She is a great actress who took risks; risks are important. When I saw her in *Jungle Fever* I was like, "wow!" I admire her, it's easy to have people gasp about how pretty you are on camera, it's another thing to play a crackhead and people gasp at your talent.

BM: What do you feel holds you back?

SJ: I wouldn't say anything is holding me back, I just think that when it's your time it's your time. I am waiting on the right person to notice me, and I believe it's right around the corner.


BM: How have you overcome inhibitions? Do you have any inhibitions now?

SJ: I ran away from roles that made me uncomfortable and scared, and trust me, that was a lot of roles. According to my acting coach, Tony Greco, it's not okay to be afraid. I have embraced those fears and sometimes my work is better than something that makes me comfortable. Also, while training with Susan Batson, she gave me any eye-opener and she is really intimidating at that, so I know walking through her door my inhibitions better be out the window. I think she scares the inhibitions out of me. (laughs)

BM: How have acting coaches, such as Squeaky Moore and Wendy McKenzie Inspired you?

SJ: These are two fantastic coaches. Squeaky Moore is a talented actress with an MFA in theater and she is that one person who practically books any and everything she auditions for. I wanted to know how she does it. She has been that one coach I can call or skype the day of an audition or callback to help me break down roles. She encourages me to push for roles that are not the most comfortable. Without her I would not have begun to scratch the surface in most of these projects. Wendy McKenzie is a casting director for Wink of an Eye, and as an acting coach she is very cut and dry. She tells you like it is. When I had a really major callback for a film in Atlanta, Wendy prepared me for that, and she is one who will not waste your time and cut around corners. If you suck she

She's in business with two powerful men, Jamie Foxx and Donald Trump, and has a resume that many women would love to claim as their own. After working on shows like The Price is Right, Extra, Access Hollywood, Celebrity Apprentice, and Deal or No Deal, Claudia Jordan's curves and beautiful face have been her business card for the past ten years. Now it's time to brand her name.

BLACK MEN: When someone says, "Who is Claudia Jordan?" and their response is "She's the girl from *Deal or No Deal*," how does that make you feel, especially when you have so many layers?

CLAUDIA JORDAN: I understand why they say that; it was a huge show, but I feel of all the things I've done, not to diminish that, it's certainly on the lower end to me as far as talent is concerned. I was a reporter at the Million Man March. I was one of the few Black girls that cohosted the Miss Universe pageant. It kind of bothers me sometimes, like, "Oh, that's the model" or "You did videos." I did videos years ago, but I do understand that some of the things I've done that, to me, are more meaningful, maybe people just didn't know. I worked for Fox Sports, co-hosted a show with Carmen Elecktra called Living Large, Extra, Access Hollywood—A lot of stuff. I guess that means I just have more work to do in the business.

BM: What's really interesting about you is that you have Oscar winner Jamie Foxx on your left

and real estate mogul Donald Trump on your right. How does it feel to also have Donald Trump on your team?

CJ: It's crazy. It's a good look to be associated with Donald Trump. Some people don't like Donald Trump but you can't deny the man's success. He's a billionaire; he knows what he's doing. There's a show he wants to do with me and I feel flattered that he wants to be in business with me because I want to be in business with him. I always thought Donald Trump was like the richest man in America growing up as a kid. Now it's like he's my personal friend. It's a legitimate business, real friendship and if he rides for you and he believes in you, he will have your back. I want to be in business with successful people that are doing way better than myself. That's the only way to make you better. It's crazy, like you said, I have Jamie on the left and Donald on the right. I feel very blessed that these people have respect for me, and they are from different genres and different parts of the entertainment business. I feel pride in my upbringing and in always being myself.

CJ: It's liberating but it's also definitely conflicting when it comes to it. I'm not going to lie to you. I struggle with it all the time because I am a smartass by nature and I come from a family of comedians, they're hilarious. My grandmother tells dirty jokes; my uncles and cousins are funny. The Foxxhole is kind of how my family is; they go in on each other and I think it's hilarious. But then part of me likes the classy, no cussin', lady, the pageant girl—I'm con-

flicted. Part of me wants to have that clean, wholesome, marketable, daytime TV persona. But then I also feel that I have an edge. If only I could find something in the middle.


BM: What's the next big thing for Claudia Jordan?

CJ: I've been talking with a production company [Bright Ideas] in Atlanta. [We are working on a sitcom. I don't do a lot of acting because I don't think I'm good at it [laughs] to be honest with you. it down and talk with actor/comedian Brandon T. Jackson for ten to fifteen minutes and you quickly learn that the stand-up comedian and now highly requested actor is all about action. With rave reviews for his roles in recent box office hits, such as Roll Bounce (2006), Tropic Thunder (2008) and Percy Jackson and The Olympians: The Lightning Thief (2010), the Detroit native is using his humor, suburban guile, carefree approach and inner city swag to usher in the next generation of young Black superstars. Currently, his immense talent can be witnessed alongside Bow Wow in the Erick White directed summertime hit *Lottery Ticket*. And, if that's not enough to convince you that Mr. Jackson is a star, wait until he unleashes another facet of his comic genius next to his mentor and comedic legend Martin Lawrence in the next installment of the Big Momma's House franchise, Big Momma's House 3-Like Father, Like Son. It was only fitting that Black Men sit down with one of today's brightest young stars in Hotlanta to talk about the love for his profession, the upbringing that helped shape him, his father and Barack.

Black Men: How do you feel about the current position of African Americans comedic actors in today's Hollywood?

Brandon T. Jackson: Right now, Black comedy is lost. It's very redundant.

My goal is to change that and set a new tone for the next generation. It's tough though because everyone is trying to use the same formula.

BM: What are some roles that you would like to see more

comedic actors portray? BTJ: Hmm...as a Black comedian or as a man? It's two fold. Major culture

can do crossover or just cool, let's just have a good time on film type projects. Black films have to evolve outside of the hood. This is one thing I love about Tyler Perry productions. His settings aren't in the hood. He takes the audience to different places. We need to provide this same type of setting to the younger generation. I love Lottery Ticket because it shows us coming out of the hood. Hood movies are not good right now with a Black president in office. We need to show more sophisticated problems among the younger generation.

BM: Besides comedy, what is the key quality you bring to each role that you play?

BTJ: I always have a heart. My characters are never just funny. You always get a back story. For instance, with my character Benny in Lottery Ticket, there were things in the script that I wrote and wanted to portray because we couldn't have a movie set in the hood without heart. That's the special element behind Lottery Ticket. It has heart and layers. You know what the characters are feeling. You can see what the average nineteen year old is thinking. Benny and even I do not want to be in the hood. It's been overplayed in sitcoms like The Jeffersons and every movie it seems. Benny is a hustler, not a drug dealer. He's the type of person that can do anything to get a dime. He's smart and is seeking a way to escape the hood. It's not an escape to never come back. Benny is seeking a way to get out, return and give back. Besides Magic Johnson, you don't see many of us sharing our success by openly giving back to the community. We need to see more examples of this. Definitely make sure that you go see the film. There's a great dramatic scene that sums up all that I've just said.

BM: What surprises should fans of the Big Momma's House franchise look for in Big Momma's House 3-Like Father, Like Son? How was your experience working alongside Martin Lawrence?

BTJ: Big Momma's House 3 has a love story. I was blessed and allowed to have a love story in this film with the beautiful actress Jessica Lucas who Black Men has previously shot. I always dreamed of having a romantic situation on film and in a very cool way, I was able to do so in the film by portraying a girl. Just imagine if you were able to find out all of your lady's secrets by being a woman. You sit there and listen as a woman and then emerge from the costume all knowing and apologetic. My character does this for the love. The film is a great insight into what a person will do for love. Martin Lawrence is an amazing mentor—very smart and progressive. Current day comics are in their positions today in large part because of Martin and Will Smith because they defined their own brand of comedy.

BM: Per your recent appearance in Italian Vogue, you definitely have a flair for fashion. What are some key fashion "must haves" for you that define your personal style and personality?

BTJ: I like sophisticated, high class things. Not cocky sophistication to where I look down or think I'm better than anyone. I simply like cool things that exude a certain ambiance. My tastes stems from my back-ground. I grew up in a Jewish neighborhood. My father was a pastor and public figure in the hood where his church was located. So, when we go to church, we're in the hood. But, when I go home, I'm around my white friends. So, I have a duality. I have to balance both worlds equally. That's why all of my girlfriends are mixed. I like both. That's why I love Barack.

BM: In Ebony's March 2010 Issue, you stated that "there ain't nothing like a Black woman." What qualities in a Black woman are you seeking?

BTJ: White women are cool, but there is just something about a Black woman. My mom is Black. If you were a Jewish man you would probably want a Jewish woman. It's a motherly thing. Now, White girls act very logically. They always try to think things through. Let's figure out why. Black women are more like "No, it's not going down like that!" So, if you mix both, you get the "not going down like that" with the logical. That's why Barack is so cool. He has that White swag, but he's still Black. He has a balance of both. Even in my own movies, life always comes back into play. Each woman that I've been involved with in a movie has been mixed.

The two years following, Ross began booking more consistently with Gardens of the Night, Shelly Fisher, Linewatch, Black Water Transit, According to Greta, Life is Hot in Cracktown, and The Family Tree, which premiered at the 2010 Seattle International Film Festival.

Ross is persistent in making acting seem like second nature with all the projects he has lined up between 2010 and 2011. Jessey Terrero's Brooklyn to Manhattan (2010), Mooz-Lum (2010) with Danny Glover and Nia Long, Four to the Floor with Naturi Naughton, 96 minutes (2011) starring Brittany Snow. He is rumored to be in Strife, Broken Doll, The Suspect of St. Marks Place, Upstate, and Prep School.



Rutina Wesley

as Vegas born actress, Rutina Wesley studied performing and visual arts at the Las Vegas Academy of International Studies. She received a BFA in theater at the University of Evansville, and then later graduated from Julliard's four-year acting program in New York. Rutina is not only a triple threat but is known in Hollywood as defying the odds of being thin, like most actresses. She takes pride in having a great muscular physique. According to her latest Fitness Magazine interview, she states that her fit frame is not just for her character in True Blood but it contributes to her healthy lifestyle. She says she works out about every other day.

Wesley began her career in theater with a New York Times, critically-acclaimed, Broadway performance of The Vertical Hour. After transitioning into film she landed a guest-starring role in Numb3rs, as well as a leading role in How She Move, which received nominations for grand jury prize and audience award at 2007's Sundance Festival. Lucas was then recognized as a series regular in the popular Canadian teen drama Edgemont in 2001, as well as ABC series, Life As We Know It in 2005, alongside Missy Peregrym & Kelly Osbourne. Although the show was cancelled during the first season, Lucas went on to film quest TV spots in projects such as CSI, 90210, and The L Word. Lucas has proven to be a real scream queen in past horror flicks, such as Amusement, The Covenant, and Cloverfield. Lucas' most notable credits came in 2009 as the sexy, yet wholesome, schoolteacher in the latest installment of Melrose Place. She is now set to star in a new comedy series, Friends with Benefits airing on NBC. Also, look for her latest film being released in early 2011, playing opposite Martin Lawrence as the love interest of Brandon T. Jackson in Big Mommas: Like Father Like Son.



Michael B. Jordan

ewark, NJ native, Michael B. Jordan is currently one of the hottest leading young actors on television. He started acting at a young age appearing in day player roles on The Sopranos and The Cosby Show in 1999 before landing a role in Hardball. Jordan received critical acclaim for his role of Wallace in the HBO hit series The Wire. In 2003 he became the youngest Black actor to have a contracted role in ABC's All My Children, in the role of Reggie, which won him three NAACP image award nominations for Outstanding Actor in a Daytime Drama Series (2005-2007), and a 2005 soap digest award nomination for favorite teen. After his lead role in the 2007 film Blackout, starring Zoe Saldana and Melvin Van Peebles, he hit a dry spell. He made a triumphant return in NBC's Friday Night Lights. When asked how he got the role in FNL he says, "I auditioned with Peter Berg, doing some improv, which is a big part of FNL. Peter told me to talk shit to him so I am in the audition room cursing, and he just kept pushing me and asking for more. I literally ran up to him and semi-tackled him out of his chair. I figured I either got the job or I am going to be escorted to jail when I get out of the audition room. Needless to say, I got the job."Jordan made his feature film debut in Pastor Brown. He will be appearing in Redtails (2011).



Jurnee Smollett

ew Yorker, Jurnee Smollett started off her career as a child actress appearing in such shows as Full House, Hanging With Mr. Cooper, and The Cosby Show. You may remember her as the adorable Eve Batiste in Eve's Bayou. She won the Broadcast Film Critics Choice Award for best child performance, and an image award in addition to three young artist awards. After a short break, she made a comeback with Roll Bounce, Gridiron Gang and The Great Debaters. The movie, directed by Denzel Washington and produced by Oprah Winfrey, won her an image award for best actress in a motion picture. Her latest project is Peter Berg's hit TV show Friday Night Lights on NBC, in which she plays Jess Merriweather.

Smollett is also on the Board of Directors of Artists for a New South Africa, along with Samuel L Jackson, President Nelson Mandela, Alfre Woodard, CCH Pounder, Carlos Santana and others. This organization combats and provides assistance for victims of HIV/AIDS in Africa.

hannon Kane

hannon Kane was born and raised in Kalamazoo, Michigan. During her early years she attended an Education for the Arts Program that resulted in her receiving a full dance scholarship to Western Michigan University. Shannon started her career doing print modeling with Elite Agency Chicago. On graduation she relocated to Los Angeles to study acting and appeared in guest starring roles in Entourage, Young and the Restless and CSI, all while working as a DJ for extra income. Shannon is also known for her recurring role as Natalia on the popular daytime soap All My Children. Kane recently received the Breakthrough Actress Award from the 2010 Capri International FIIm Festival for her performance in Brooklyn's Finest, co-starring Richard Gere and Don Cheadle. She recently wrapped production on SWAT: Fire Fight, which is set for a 2011 release and stars Giancarlo Esposito and Gabriel Macht.

Shannon starts shooting Tyler Perry's Madea's Big Happy Family this fall where she plays a young mother and wife too wrapped up in her career because of a secret.

ith a resume like his, it's hard to believe that Jeff Friday has the time to be the consummate family man. But the CEO of Film Life and founder of the American Black Film Festival is half man half amazing. It has been 14 years since the father of four changed the face of Hollywood by creating the annual international film festival that draws film industry elite from around the world. The American Black Film Festival has played host to the likes of Halle Berry, Spike Lee, Denzel Washington, and this year Lee Daniels. Friday was the man of the moment being honored with the Career Achievement Award.

However, the ABFF is more than a place where film industry professionals and film enthusiasts alike convene under the Palm trees of Miami Beach to party to the signature sounds of DJ Driis [Idris Elba]. Yes, it is all of those things too, but most of all, it is a platform for films made for us by us. Jeff Friday is the man behind the vision, and he's got his eyes set on a Hollywood takeover. We caught up with Friday to talk the future of Black Hollywood, why Idris Elba is the leader of the pack of leading men, and the American Black Film Festival year one to 14.

BLACK MEN MAGAZINE: How do you manage family life with film life?

JEFF FRIDAY: I had a lot of practice. I started the family really young. I've got four children, two, four, eighteen and twenty-three. I've been doing it since I was in my late teens or early twenties. But, of course, family always comes first. I don't get a lot of sleep. I probably sleep about four hours a night. Yeah, so I got 20 hours to run.

BM: What were you doing prior to starting the ABFF?

JF: I had my own company but at the time we started the festival, I was the president of Uniworld, an African-American advertising agency, probably the

longest running one. Uniworld had been around a long time before I got there, and I had my own marketing consultation company prior to that. I was also the brand manager for Bristol Meyers and Hennessey Cognac. Uniworld wanted to launch a film division, so Byron Lewis created this subsidiary of Uniworld called Uniworld Film, and I ran that company. The very first project we got was a film called Amistad produced by DreamWorks.

BM: What inspired you to create the American Black Film Festival?

I was the president of the film division of Uniworld. Back in 1997 Jessie Jackson called for a boycott of the Oscars. He called my boss, Byron Lewis, and a bunch of other professional leaders because he said that the Oscars excluded Black people. This was before Denzel and Halle got their Oscars. There was a long drought prior to that. Byron [Lewis] invited me to lunch. We invited Warren Cutler, one half of the Cutler brothers. We were all talking about the Jessie Jackson thing—this is like January '97. He asked me what I thought. I had been in film a long time. I went to Sundance and the Cannes film festival. I said I thought that was kind of purposeless because the Oscars are a relatively kind of open minded arch first organization. If we were going to boycott anybody, we should be boycotting the studios because the studios make the movies, not the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. If we really want to do something, we should create our own Sundance. Most of the really good stories come from the independent films and if we really wanted to change the game, we should do one for Black people. That's essentially how it started, from that conversation. He said, "all right, let's do it." We decided over lunch, very serendipitously we were going to do a Black film festival. That was in January '97 and we decided to do the first one June of that same year. We planned the first one, in three and one-half months. It's funny, the less you know the better off you are. Now it takes up to a year to do it when the first time it took us three and half months.

BM: How did you do it? Did you just call up Halle Berry, Robert Townsend and Bill Duke?


JF: Once we decided to do it, he said, "What does it take to do a film festival? I said, "It's going to take a whole lot of money because we are not going to get any sponsors the first time, so we need some celebrities." There were a few people I knew pretty well. We called Robert [Townsend] and Halle [Berry] and Debbie [Allen]. Spike Lee and John Singleton, started coming the second year. There was no Internet in '97, so to be honest, I don't know how we even got the word out. I had this amazing mailing list that I had used for different things I had done for private parties. The second year we honored Denzel Washington. Denzel Washington came and that's when it really hit because Access Hollywood came and Entertainment Tonight came down.

BM: You had the chance to see a lot of careers blossom. Two of them are Rob Hardy and Will Packer of Rainforest Films. Packer's two films *Stomp The Yard* 2 and *Takers* both premiered at the festival this year. What is it like to see their growth?

JF: Will Packer and Rob Hardy came to the second [festival]. I remember they were real green. They called me up, with this film called *Trois* and the submission deadline had passed or was approaching. Will called me up and asked if they could have two more days. They ran out of money, and I was like, "No, the rules are the rules. If I extend it to you, I have to extend it for everybody." This might have been a week before the deadline. He just called me and wore me down, which is real hard to do. They called me up again, three times and begged. He told me the whole story. He eventually got the film in. We gave him a couple of extra days. I don't like to say that, but I did and he came, and his film played well. They did *Trois 2* a couple of years later. They released it and it did really well theatrically. We introduced him to the people at Screen Gems and basically that's the story. You know they've become kind of poster boys for the festival. Believe it or not, we still get questions from media, the general market media, asking why is there a need for a Black film festival. I just laugh. I don't get defensive about it. I tell them to go to rainforestfilm.com. Those guys are very talented; I didn't make them talented. Their mother made them talented, but we gave them a platform for showcasing who they were and what they could do. Without the ABFF, I don't know if those movies would make it. The whole trick is to give people a chance. This year to open with *Takers*, their film, the whole thing for me really did come full circle. Those are the rewarding parts.

BM: Idris Elba served as Festival Ambassador this year. Why did you choose him?

JF: We choose one ambassador every year and we try to select people who are not only popular but people that have an appreciation for what we are doing. The fact that Idris was there before he got well known makes him the best ambassador we've ever had by far.



Will Packer & Rob Hardy Power Packed

or those that avidly follow the institution of entertainment so often referred to as Hollywood, then you should be highly aware of the seismic shift that is taking place with location and production of some of your more prominent black films, TV shows and programming over recent years. Black Hollywood is definitely alive, but not within the confines of Starstruck Town. Today, black entertainments finest and most sought after brands such as Tyler Perry Studios and BET have relocated to the new mecca Atlanta, GA...a city that's always been rich in black history, prosperity and entertainment. It is here where the next generation of African American filmmakers and the story of Black America will be told for years to come.

Leading the way are the power team of Will Packer (Producer) and Rob Hardy (Director) of Rainforest Films. The two friends and Florida A&M alum founded Rainforest Films in 1994 and quickly began blazing significant trails for inde-

pendent black filmmakers and talent with their first film Chocolate City, a relatively successful film that earned them a small distribution deal. After Chocolate City, the duo made the decision to relocate to Atlanta to pursue their vision of making films that would appeal to black audiences who had yet to see genre films starring people like themselves. It was here that they would make their first huge impact with their first theatrical release Trois starring Gary Dourdan and Kenya Moore. Trois would go on to gross over \$1.2 million dollars and became the fastest million dollar grossing film distributed by African American's, thus establishing Packer and Hardy as future stars on the rise. Needless to say, they have continued to set trends consistent with their brand name.

Just as the world's rainforest presents us with complex, diverse and scintillating forms of life, Will and Rob have managed to infuse the same feelings and visualization into their presentations of the black experience. Via films such as Motives, The Gospel, Stomp the Yard (1&2), This Christmas, Obsessed and Takers (released in August), Rainforest has managed to bring forth the beauty, love, passion, determination, action, sincerity, love for family and God that permeates black communities across America. It was Black Men's privilege to converse with these storytellers regarding their journey and what they see for the future of black entertainment.

On the current position of black filmmaking...

Black filmmaking is vastly different today than say five years ago. Every studio seemed to be into making black films at that time. It's not like that anymore. Now, only a handful of studios focus on black films. But, it is a lot easier today for black filmmakers to break in as opposed to years ago when it was more so about filmmakers Spike Lee, John Singleton and The Hudlin Brothers.

On the respect Rainforest has gained from the diversity displayed in their films such as Trois, Stomp the Yard, etc. The fact that we produce all different types of films is 'our' advantage because people see us as filmmakers that can produce all types of films and not just black films. Our movies tend to focus on universal themes such as love, action, horror, mystery, erotic thrillers and comedy. We want to present it all so that our young filmmakers and audience can see themselves on the screen, relate and enjoy it.

Did you see Atlanta's potential as a filmmaking mecca fourteen years ago when you relocated here?

Not to the level that we have currently witnessed. The potential of the city was definitely there due to the selection offered through its strong black community.

How does Stomp the Yard 2: Homecoming differ from the first film?

Homecoming will showcase a lot of aspects you witness at black college homecoming event such as stepping, dancing etc. You'll also see the dynamics of the conflicts between true students and locals within the community. The world is the same in regards to city, location but different in regards to characters and storyline. We pulled a lot of our own college experiences in Tallahassee into the Stomp the Yard films such as a student's first time on campus, issues with females and conflicts with other guys.

You collaborated with Grand Hustle's Jason Geter and T.I. on your new film Takers. What about the film excited you and why was the opportunity to produce it so attractive?

Takers is the first time that Rainforest has had the opportunity of producing an action film. This was also the first time we've had an opportunity to create an entirely diverse cast. So, the same perspective that you would see with films such as The Italian Job or Heat, we now have, but with a bit more versatility. We have the cool and hip side via T.I., Michael Ealy and Chris Brown combined with people that audiences are already used to seeing such as Idris Elba, Zoe Saldana, Matt Dillon Hayden Christensen and Paul Walker.

What do you look for in actors/actresses when you're seeking to cast roles?

We're looking for people that lose themselves in the role and become the character rather than being themselves and trying to act.

On the key to the future of black filmmaking...

Black filmmakers need to continually focus on telling stories. Be as creative as possible no matter if you have a lot of money or studio. In turn, black audiences should go see black films and support instead of buying bootlegs.

will tell you that you suck. She is intimidating and yet the sweetest person. I was used to her bringing me to tears, but when I did my last private lesson with her she just nodded her head and said, "great." I was like, "Huh, are you sure." I thought I did well, but I needed her approval and was surprised that I got It. What I learned is that acting coaches aren't there to nurture you, they are there to teach you. You may not always have things your way but be assured you will be

BM: I noticed you have been credited for freelancing for a few magazines on the side. Is there some learning advantage to experiencing that side of the industry?

SJ: Well I freelance doing wardrobe and I am also a journal-ist. We all have that side job, and I refuse to waitress again for as long as I live, (laughs) The advantage is being around actors, musicians and directors on a daily basis on my job. They don't know anything about me until I meet them at an audition or on a set but by then I have already had the initial

meeting.

BM: Your mother seems to have played a major role in your career, and I hear she is involved in music as a hobby and is really good.

SJ: My mom put her music career on hold to get me around the world, especially as a minor. I couldn't really go to any auditions alone and she would even sleep in her car while I was on set sometimes for ten hours. She continued to show me what a go-getter really is. Now that I'm all grown up, she is back in the game and taking the Memphis Blues Circuit at large. She was actually nominated at this year's Memphis Blues awards, under the name Mz Pantheress. Her music is

funky and soulful. BM: Dating in the industry, your thoughts?

SJ: I don't see an issue with dating in the industry as long as it is kept to a minimum. I prefer to date in the industry because I have someone who can relate to my everyday stresses of training and being on set all day. I need someone to understand that I am going to have to leave town some-times, and it may be for a day or for a few weeks. Also that I am going to have to change our plans if I get a last minute callback or audition. It's just much easier.

BM: The downside of multiple dating is the negative label given to some women, but what upsides have you witnessed in watching others do it?

in watching others do it?

SJ: Well yeah, the labeling depends on where you are in the industry. Certain women who hop around from guy to guy celebrities are labeled groupies. The upsides are that some people have gotten upgraded, like Amber Rose. It shows if you date the right person your status and value goes up, and it does help many people in their careers whether they admit it or not. I have dated someone in the industry for years and my opportunities did change based on his name and his con-tacts. It should never be the reason you date someone even if the opportunities come with the package.

BM: What is your goal to reach by 2012

SJ: I hope to be working on multiple projects and be a bit more grounded in the industry. I also plan to take my abilities to the ultimate heights.

We have had some major people, but his spirit, how he com-municated what the film festival did for him made him the best person. I think the fact that he came as an unknown actor first really made it all sort of make sense. He felt a different kind of appreciation for it.

BM: What's your advice for aspiring Black actors, produce and directors?

JF: My advice would be two things. For aspiring people would say information is power. You have to be as informed as you can if you want to be successful. There are a lot of film fakers—people who just bought a camera and equipment and don't have any experience. Then there is Spike Lee and John Singleton who went to film school. I know everybody can't afford to go to film school, but I think your goal should be to go to film school. If you want to be a doctor, you don't just pick up the medicine bag; and if you want to be a professional anything, athlete, you know you got to put in work [shooting] free throws. You've got to also be a networker because this business depends on influence. It's about who you know.

interview with Essence, Elba stated that there wasn't much room to grow as an actor in London, not only due to typecasting, but also because of his Cockney accent. This ignited his determination to relocate to New York in hopes of having the opportunity to grow as an actor. He stated that he strug-gled his first few years in New York and stayed at the YMCA. Also, he thought he would be successful in a year, but after three years he was still broke and got a real eye opener. (Essence, 2010) To supplement his income while living in New York, Elba Deejayed under the name "DJ Big Driis" at nightclubs in the East Village and Alphabet city. Elba earned acclamation for his performance as Achilles in

the Off-Broadway production of the Shakespeare classic Troilus and Cressida. Additionally, in 2001 he landed a day-player role in an episode of Law and Order, which later resulted in his next breakthrough in the award-winning HBO TV series The Wire. Elba was cast as Russell "Stringer" Bell the drug-dealing kingpin who aspired to be a high-powered businessman. After three successful seasons on the show (2002-2004), along with an image award nomination, Elba was officially 'on the map.' After gaining recognition in guest starring roles in popular US TV series Girfriends, and CSI Miami, he was finally ready to make his transition into film. Success came in 2005 in Sometimes In April and The Gospel

For the HBO award-winning and Emmy-nominated made for-TV film, Sometimes In April, Elba received nominations at the Black Reel Awards for Best TV actor, the Image Awards for outstanding actor in a TV movie and the NAMIC Vision Awards for his stellar portrayal of Augustin Muganza, a Hutu captain during the Rwandan genocides in 1994. According to SuperiorPics in a 2009 interview, Elba said that during considerations and castings for the role of Augustin, there were many A-list actors being considered. However, the producers preferred someone of African descent, and Elba's relationship with HBO, from his past show The Wire, and his African roots made him a considerable candidate along with the novice actors in favor. Needless to say, after being brought in during the last round of auditions, he booked the role and the rest is history. That same year Elba became a part of the Rainforest Films family with his role as the Southern Baptist minister, Reverend Frank, in *The Gospel* alongside Boris Kodjoe, Nona Gaye, Clifton Powell and Keshia Knight Pulliam. Later, roles have consistently come his way, and have failed to cease. Some projects includes: Tyler Perny's Daddy's Little Girls (2007), The Reaping (2007), 28 Weeks Later (2007), American Gangster (2007) (nominated for a Screen Actors Guild Award for outstanding performance by a cast in a motion picture). This Christmas (2007), Prom Night (2008), RocknRolla (2008), The Unborn (2009), Obsessed (2009) (received an image award nomination for outstanding actor in a motion picture, shared with Denzel Washington, Russell Crowe, Chiwetel Ejiofor and Josh Brolin), Award winning comedic series The Office (2009), The Losers (2010), and the 2010 UK crime drama

The journey has yet to end for Elba whose latest film Takers

is one that you surely don't want to miss. Elba plays Gordon Jennings, a member of a notorious group of criminals (also co-stars Paul Walker, T.I., Chris Brown, Hayden Christensen, Matt Dillon, Jay Hernandez, Zoe Saldana and Michael Ealy) who baffle police by pulling off a number of perfectly executed bank robberies while leaving no traces behind until a hard-ened detective interferes.

Elba is preparing for his 2011 release of Thor based on the Marvel Comic of the same name about a god who is cast down to earth to live among humans as punishment and defends the earth against villains. Elba plays the role of Heimdell, a Nordic God.■

managers and agents. I was like, "send me out for every ethmanagers and agents. I was like, "send me out for every ethi-nicity, I don't care what color this is written for, I want to go in for it." The worst thing they can say is "no," and that's how I got Lanie. It was written for a White actress and my people called the casting person and said, "Tamala really wants to come in, just give her a shot." I showed up early in the morn-ing this control of the control o ing. I didn't have but two lines to say but it was all about my skill. You do have to step your game up.

BM: What does a day in the life of Tamala involve?

TJ: The days I don't have anything to do, I try to get myself involved with different charities. One of them that I do is called Girl Prep. It focuses on self-esteem awareness and building young girls up. After we break from the show, I try to get involved with any movie that I can as I did with 35 and Ticking when we went on our hiatus—and it was great.

BM: How do you hold down your love life with such a busy schedule?

TJ: My love life, you know what, I kind of put it on the back burner. I date, go out, and I've met some really nice gentlenen but the problem is not them, it's me. I have so much that I want to accomplish in my life. To have a relationship and to try to do that at the same time becomes real challenging—especially with the things I'm doing now, such as getting on planes and leaving. crowd. BM: What's the biggest misconception most people have



BMM: Have you ever gotten to that point of thinking "I should choose a new career this isn't working"?


