BLACK MEN: Tell us a bit about your company, Angel Brinks Fashion Leggings, and how it got started. Angel Brinks: Growing up in Hollywood, I was involved in the performing arts. Growing up in performing arts, that's mainly what they do like body suits and leggings, span-dex and sequins—all of the flashy stuff that they wear onstage. I decided to take this material and put my design on it. I started wearing them out and everybody would be like "Where'd you get that?" I would be like, "Oh, I made it!" Everyone wanted me to make them a pair, so I started doing them for people and then it became a huge business. and I started selling them online. Then the customers started asking, "How do we match this?" So, I extended the leggings into body suits, and the girls loved that, and it just took off over

Aside from leggings and body suits, do you design any other pieces?

Yes, I do. I actually have rompers. I have dresses. I have exclusive sets. Those are kind of difficult to describe. I call them "exclusive" because they can be like briefs with high-waist sets. I also do the body suits that you recently saw on Beyonce when she performed at the Super Bowl. It is still considered a body suit regardless of whether it has legs or not because it's still a one piece.

Are these pieces custom fitted?

Yes; and that's what makes my company different from all the rest. With the body suits if it's off anywhere, like in the pelvic area or on the shoulder, it can throw off the entire body suit. So, 90 percent of the items ordered from me are custom for the customers. And it's not just celebrities; it's everybody. Us as women,







we are custom made. We no longer come in one-size-fitsall. As far as designs go, celebrities sometimes will ask to have the pieces designed a little different. "I don't want my back to show." Or "I want to wear a brα." They'll give me α bit of direction on what they want it to look like, and I'll bring it to life for them. How would it work for  $\alpha$

Well, I have a tutorial video online where I explain how to properly measure yourself because if it's a body suit, it has to fit like a glove. I offer them at no charge to submit their measurements. I have a lot of items that are ready to go, but I also keep a lot of material around for custom orders. We make everything handmade. All of the industrial factory machines we also have. There's a lot that goes into it. It's not as easy as it seems. It can be very easy or it can be very difficult. I choose to make it difficult, but that's what they love about me. Whatever they want, they get. Where do you hope to see Angel Brinks Fashion Leggings a year from now? Honestly, everything is going so fast right now that it's just unbelievable. I've had so many different offers for so many different things, and it all started from the love that I have for clothing. I can't even imagine where it could go. The sky's the limit. I would love to get into perfumes, maybe a kids' line, maybe a men's line, and shoes. You just never know what offer will come your way. I recently launched a lingerie collection. I'm running up against big companies like Victoria Secret and Frederick's of Hollywood. That's just what


















#### At your level in modeling, what is the standard annual income you believe yourself and the others like you bring in?

her first job in retail. Through all of her ventures, the experience of working in a store stuck, and made complete business sense as her entrepreneurial spirit developed.

"I want to leave the creative stuff to the people that were born to do that, and the things that I see that are eccentric enough, I'll pick and choose different items to be in the boutique," Jamilah says. "I bring a lot of creative designers in, and they put their pieces on the site. I have a lot of connections in the [entertainment] industry to wear the different pieces, so it all falls into place."

Jamilah is always aspiring to grow, but quiet as kept, she already owns an accounting firm and a grocery store. It's no small feat to juggle these businesses, but Rouse asserts that motherhood is still the most difficult job she takes on each day.

"When you run a business, you make a business plan for it and you have projections and you want to meet those different quotas," she explains. "But with motherhood, I tell ya, there is no such thing as a business plan.

Motherhood is totally unpredictable, especially when you're dealing with different personalities. Most of the time it's fine - you watch your children grow into the good people you want them to be, but you can't put a five year plan on humans!"

As her own children grow up, Rouse sees the importance of setting a good example in life. So, what is her advice for someone wanting to follow in her footsteps?

"I don't want you to do what I do," she asserts. "I want you to do what's good for you, because you only see what I do, but until you know exactly who I am, you don't know everything that I do. Figure out what you like... what's your passion? What's your niche? Enhance that, and be creative with your product, be more creative in your marketing, and that will take you a long way. I always say it's hard to be everybody else, because we're all created original. Be yourself, and people will love you for it. I promise."




