How to Clean your catch



You caught it, you kept it...now let's clean it and eat it!

What you need:

- Work table
- A good fillet or fish-cleaning knife

- Container for the cleaned fish, zip-top bags work great

- 5. Repeat these steps on the other side of the fish.
- 6. Remove the fillets from the skin.

The Flag

On the evening of June 17, 2015 Dylann Roof walked into Emanuel African Methodist Episcopal Church in downtown Charleston, South Carolina where he sat in on a small prayer meeting for more than an hour before brandishing a firearm and fatally shooting nine people.

Sylvia Johnson told NBC News a survivor of the mass killing had told her Roof said he "had to" keep shooting, as another churchgoer attempted to talk him out of firing his weapon while he reloaded.

"He just said, 'I have to do it,' she said. 'You rape our women, and you're taking over our country, and you have to go,' she said."

Roof fled the church in his Hyundai sedan – with Confederate flag license plates...

The media went in two directions. Fox News said that it was an attack on Christianity while the rest of mainstream media attacked the Confederate flag.

It just so happens that one of the victims was a senator who had to walk into a building everyday that was topped by the Confederate flag.

While listening to the media coverage the Allen Iverson rant immediately came to mind -

"If I can't practice, I can't practice man. If I'm hurt, I'm hurt. I mean ... simple as that. It ain't about that... I mean it's... It's not about that... At all. You know what I'm saying I mean... But it's...it's easy ... to, to talk about... It's easy to sum it up when you're just talking about practice. We're sitting in here, and I'm supposed to be the franchise player, and we in here talking about practice. I mean, listen, we're talking about practice, not a game, not a game, not a game, we talking about practice. Not a game. Not, not ... Not the game that I go out there and die for and play every game like it's my last. Not the game, but we're talking about practice, man. I mean, how silly is that?"

To put that in perspective, there were nine people dead and while reloading the shooter claimed that "He had to" because African Americans were taking over the country and raping white women and we're talking about a flag? There are nine people dead that weren't armed, weren't out in the streets, they were killed while worshipping in church and we're talking about a flag?

And Fox News calling in an attack it an attack on faith, a line that was echoed by a number of republicans, was cruelly irresponsible.

Here's what we know about Dylann Roof ...

- Dylann Storm Roof confessed to killing nine people at a historic black church in Charleston because he hoped it would start a "race war."
- Roof created a website this year called the Last Rhodesian, a reference to the white-ruled African country, which fought a bitter civil war against black majority rule before it became Zimbabwe.



- Roof wore a jacket with the flags of Rhodesia and apartheid-era South Africa on the breast.
- Roofs website features a manifesto where Roof
 wrote he was radicalized via the Internet following the Trayvon Martin case. Roof wrote he researched "black on white violence," which took
 him to the website of South Carolina-based hate
 group the Council of Conservative Citizens
 (formerly the White Citizens' Council) where he
 wrote "Niggers are stupid and violent."

- Roof said "I chose Charleston because it is most historic city in my state, and at one time had the highest ratio of blacks to Whites in the country," he wrote. "We have no skinheads, no real KKK, no one doing anything but talking on the internet. Well someone has to have the bravery to take it to the real world, and I guess that has to be me."
- On February 28, Roof was arrested for drug pos-٠ session at a mall in Columbia. where he was searched by officers after storekeepers complained that he was acting unusually and asking questions about opening hours and the number of staff on the premises. The Wall Street Journal reports a police incident document said Roof was found to have strips of Suboxone, a pain drug sometimes used to treat opiate addiction. He did not have a prescription for the drug, which is commonly sold illegally on the street. Roof was banned from the mall for one year and was out on bond waiting for the courts to process his felony drug-possession charges when he was arrested in the parking lot of the same mall two months later.
- Roof was charged with trespassing on April 26 in violation of his ban from the mall. Roof was found guilty a month later and fined \$262.50.

Roof wrote in his Manifesto -

- "The event that truly awakened me was the Trayvon Martin case. I kept hearing and seeing his name, and eventually I decided to look him up. I read the Wikipedia article and right away I was unable to understand what the big deal was. It was obvious that Zimmerman was in the right. But more importantly this prompted me to type in the words 'black on White crime' into Google, and I have never been the same since that day."
- "Segregation was not a bad thing. It was a defensive measure. Segregation did not exist to hold back negroes."

- "Black people view everything through a racial lens. That's what racial awareness is, its viewing everything that happens through a racial lens. They are always thinking about the fact that they are black. This is part of the reason they get offended so easily, and think that some thing are intended to be racist towards them, even when a White person wouldn't be thinking about race."
- "Anyone who thinks that White and black people look as different as we do on the outside, but are somehow magically the same on the inside, is delusional. How could our faces, skin, hair, and body structure all be different, but our brains be exactly the same? This is the nonsense we are led to believe," he writes. "Negroes have lower Iqs, lower impulse control, and higher testosterone levels in generals. These three things alone are a recipe for violent behavior. If a scientist publishes a paper on the differences between the races in Western Europe or Americans, he can expect to lose his job."

And we're talking about a flag.

Once again, the media and politicians, for the most part, have missed an opportunity to talk about something of substance regarding the sickness' that plague this country.

Take a look at this photo...



Which is more disturbing - the Confederate flag in his hand or the 9mm in his other?

Which one of the two did he use to kill nine people?

Yet, we were not talking about the fact that a mentally questionable person with a criminal record has possession of a deadly firearm.

This doesn't make anyone dangerous...



This does!



What Rush Limbaugh mentioned during his radio show made a really good point (yep, I said it) about this last picture. Next we will be attacking Seagram's and Budweiser!

What we're not talking about is the fact that Roof purchased the gun he used in the murders on April 11th, a month and a half AFTER he was arrested for drug possession.

We're also not talking about the fact that during the murders he mentioned that Blacks were "taking over the country," a battle cry that was brought to the national stage by the Tea Party shortly after the inauguration of the nation's first African-American president. You want to talk about a symbol, how about these



During Donald Trump's announcement that he would be running for president, Trump referred to Mexican immigrants as drug dealers and rapist - this was after Roof killed nine African Americans for taking over the country and "raping our women."

Why aren't we talking about the fact that militia groups have risen over 400% since Obama has taken office.

The same can be said for gun sales in this country.

More than 70 million guns have been purchased since Obama was elected.

Lastly, why aren't we talking about the fact that Freddie Gray - a black man stopped for weapon possession in Baltimore - was folded in half like a piece of paper before being killed by a broken neck inflicted by the sudden deceleration of the police van carrying him off to jail while Dylann Roof - who murdered nine respectable members of the African-American community - complained of hunger and was treated to Burger King on his way to jail.

There lies the problem.

I agree with President Obama in that it is no longer polite to refer to a Black man as a nigger in public but that doesn't mean racism isn't still alive and well.

As long as we have media services like Fox News the most viewed cable news network - calling the murder of nine African-Americans an attack on faith.

Minorities in this country have 99 problems but believe me when I say the Confederate flag ain't one.

As part of my HW Retro series, it's a blast this month to look back at one of the wildest, weirdest and most hallucinogenic cult classic 60's flicks: "Candy". And Candy of course, is loaded with eye candy! The Number One requirement of my retrospective is that it must feature a hot, sexy chick who epitomizes the unique glamor of her era. For me, one of those women is the star of this bizarre romp -

a blond Swedish-born stunner named Ewa Aulin.

If you don't recognize her name, that's understandable. She didn't make many films and pretty much left the movie biz by the 70's Bummer! This babe should have stuck around a few more years to become a



mega star, especially for those of us who adore the pouty, innocently sexual look that she so artfully portrayed in iconic style. And without a doubt, the best thing about retro is that the girls were all natural – no collagen! Those voluptuous kissable lips are the real deal and so are the boobs! <sigh!>

When I reflect on the 60's era, I always think of Ewa as a symbol of that time in her role as Candy. This gorgeous teen nymph could flaunt a mini dress like nobody else! She's sexually taken advantage of by a series of lecherous, sleazy dudes.

That theme was rather common in the 60's, every guy's ultimate fantasy! Many critics felt that Candy was just an excuse to make a porno without actually calling it porn. Released in 1968, it was "X" rated, so a lot of kids in that era couldn't even get in to a movie theater to see it. Today, it would probably be "PG"! Ahh, how times have changed. You definitely won't recognize Brando, so it's worth it to catch his freaky, sexually manipulative outrageous antics. He's actually pretty damn funny.
