
Whatever You Do, Don't Be Yourself




What's one thing no one knows about you? I would rather have a night in playing computer games and watching movies, eating Thai food with good company than have a crazy night out partying and drinking


You're involved with a lot of charities, how did that start?

ATOWN CALLED PARADISE


Called Paradise - his fifth studio album, and by far his most commercial to date - as he looks to consolidate his place in the trouse trinity alongside Hardwell and Aviici.

Opening track Red Lights sets the tone right from the off. There is no easing into matters, as the listener is slapped across the chops with the first male vocal, hollow drum, and huge drop - all before the first minute and a half is up. This is Tijs in full, unabashed stadium mode.

What follows is a quick-fire series based on the same pattern, with the only points of difference being the changing guests - there are no less than seventeen on the album. The listener is treated to instantly likeable Balearic guitar, Coldplay piano lines and 'heartfelt' stadium emotion.

One of the album's biggest strengths is its most glaring weakness. The production is exceptional, without offering anything new. Strip away the middle of the road collegeromance vocals and huge synth lines, and beneath all the superficial feels, there is no soul behind the perfectly manicured outer

And then, just like that, the album takes a turn for the

he industrious folks at Toolroom have yet another release out – and it is a doozy. Split across three mixes – poolside, club and afterclub, there is plenty to say - so let's dive in.

The Poolside party begins with bassy tech-house before upping the funk with Arkon Fly's bouncy joyride Through The Fire. You can't help but get your smile on as the sun-infused tracks come thick and fast – this is smooth sexy house at its finest.

Tensnake's remix of London Grammar's Hey Now stands out, with its ethereal vocal oozing over the plucked bassline as the mix switches up. We are treated to some pacier piano house, as the dancefloor swells. Fans of Deep House 2.0 will adore the next turn in the road, as Beckwith's Anandia shimmers into one of the tracks of the year. Bonobo gives the Burial treatment to one of Maya Jane Coles finest. The two-step rattle offsets the wind chimes and coded vocal for three minutes of Balearic bliss.

Delightfully, it is a sustained change of direction as the disc stretches its way to all the environs of house music. By Wilfred Giroux's sharp garage cut U Make Me, I am calling it the best mix of the year. One disc in, and it's a keeper.





deadmau5 while (1<2)

peadmau5's long anticipated seventh studio album is here, and boy it's big. Coming in at 25 tracks, the outspoken Canadian drops a longplayer that will once again divide fans.

By far the most adventurous outing to date, while (1<2) begins with his signature sound. Avaritia kicks us off with a pensive intro which makes way for a rumble bass-driven effort that doesn't break down again until almost four minutes in. It is snappy and expertly produced as we have come to expect from one of the most hands-on players in the field.

The first eyebrow is raised on his remix of How To Destroy Angels' gorgeous Ice Age. Keeping the essence of the original, deadmau5 adds a stuttering march and intricate FX. It is wonderfully respectful of the elements that made the track so stunning and a real home run. You are not gonna hear it in a club set, but that right there, that's the beauty of it.



DONT BE AFRAID OF CARBS

Those muscles aren't going to be built without materials for the body to build them with. So you need to eat plenty of good foods throughout the day. You should be constantly giving your body fuels, which includes plenty of not just protein, but carbohydrates and good fats as well. While it sounds easy, normal life hurdles does make it hard to eat sometimes. So prepare plenty of meals to take to work or leave in the fridge.

SLEEP WELL

Your body needs time to get down to business in re-building those muscle fibres and that won't happen if you don't get sufficient rest. If you're not getting a solid eight hours, you're hindering the repair work. So switch off that telly and get some good shuteye!

DRINK UP

Water is vital for human life in general and it's no different for building muscle. You need to keep the H2O flowing through the body as it carries the nutrients to your cells and helps form the structures for protein and glycogen. Also, your muscles will not work as well if you are dehydrated, so be sure drink plenty of the clear stuff before, during and after your session. Every set, head to the bubbler or drink bottle and have a couple of mouthfuls, don't skull a litre in one go!

GET A TRAINER

It may sound a little bias coming straight from a trainer, but if you're not an expert at lifting weights, even just a few sessions with a PT will make sure you're doing all of the exercises properly. This won't just get you to your goal faster, it ensures you're not going to injure yourself long term with bad techniques. PT sessions can be very expensive, so if money is an issue I always recommend finding other people with similar schedules and fitness goals and split the bill. Having two to four people in a class can be easily handled by almost any PT and you'll get almost all of the benefits of having one-on-one sessions.




MERCEDES-BENZ CLS REVEALEN WITH NINE SPEED GEARROX

ercedes-Benz has unveiled the new CLS-Class which has a few tweaks to the body, upped engine specs, a nine-speed automatic transmission and a set of revolutionary new Multibeam headlights.

The base model, CLS 220
BlueTEC, comes with a 2.1-litre turbo-diesel producing 125kW and 400Nm, the CLS 250
BlueTEC gets upped to 150kW and 500Nm while the top diesel model CLS 350 BlueTEC gets two more cylinders with a V6 producing 190kW and a tyre

ruguay and Liverpool striker Luis Suarez was suspended from all football-related activity for four months for biting Italian defender Giorgio Chiellini during the Uruguay 1-0 win over Italy in the group stage of the world cup.

In addition, he was banned for nine international matches, that put an end to his 2014 World Cup campaign. He will also miss the first nine games of the Premier League season and was also heavily fined. The ban is the biggest in World Cup history, beating the eight games given to Italy's Mauro Tassotti in 1994 for elbowing Spain's Luis Enrique.

Chairman of the FIFA disciplinary commission, Claudio Sulser said, "Such behaviour cannot be tolerated on any football pitch and, in particular, not at a FIFA World Cup when the eyes of millions of people are on the stars on the field." Suarez lunged at Italian defender Giorgio Chiellini during their group game match in the World Cup 10 minutes from the end of the



GERMANY WINS THE 2014 WORLD CUP IN EXTRA TIME BECOMING THE FIRST EUROPEAN TEAM IN HISTORY TO WIN THE CUP ON SOUTH AMERICAN SOIL.

This win marks the nations fourth World Cup win (1954, 1874, 1990, 2014) and the first as a unified nation.


It came off the brilliance of substitute Mario Goetze deep into extra time. In the 114th minute Andre Schuerrle burst down the left flank and crossed for Goetze. The 23-year-old Bayern Munich star took the ball on his chest before booting it past Sergio Romero and into Argentina's net. The single goal would prove to be enough to give Germany a well deserved win in a very tight and hard fought final.

Just like Germany's last cup win back in 1990, the nation beat out Argentina 1-0 and in the process broke the hearts of the entire South American nation.

Coming into the finals you couldn't bet against Germany with many naming the team the early favourite of the tournament. They produced some of the best showing of football talent in all of their tournament games, especially in their win over Portugal and their 7-1 semi-final demolition of home nation Brazil.

Much has been made about the golden generation of European footballers taking the field for Germany and the long road the nation has taken to get themselves back to the top of world football.





Despite claims of appealing his suspension, the three time UFC title challenger instead decided to call it a

day on his professional fighting career. "I want to officially announce my retirement from competitive mixed martial arts," Sonnen said on UFC

Tonight. "These weren't secrets that I took these substances, this is what you have to take coming off Testosterone Replacement Therapy (TRT). The confusing part is that it is for a non-anabolic, non-steroid, ≥ non-performance enhancing agent that is perfectly legal and that I need for a healthy life. Essentially, they are saying you have to choose between your health and your sport."

"Sonnen was diagnosed with Hypogonadism in 2008, resulting in lower levels of testosterone. Sonnen went through TRT to counter this.

This announcement brings to an end the career of one of the most popular fighters on the UFC roster. His ability to sell a fight was unparalleled and he had an uncanny ability to get under the skin of his



The San Antonio Spurs cemented their place in sporting history with their 104-87 win in Game 5 of the NBA finals, clinching their fifth championship in 16 seasons. San Antonio took the series by winning four of five games, including the last three, putting an end to Miami's well-publicised quest for a third straight title. The victory was even sweeter for the Spurs given their recent history with the Heat. In last year's finals, the Spurs had a 3-2 series lead before it slipped away. They blew a late lead in Game 6, and then went on to lose the series in Game 7. After this many questioned whether the Spurs could go on another successful run with their current and aging line-up.

"Last year's loss was devastating," Coach Gregg Popovich said. "I've said many times, a day didn't go by where I didn't think about Game 6."

The Spurs responded by posting the league's best regular-season record before storming through the playoffs. The Spurs' Big Three (Tim Duncan, Tony Parker and Manu Ginobili) guided the team to a dominant run after escaping a seven game series with the Dallas Mavericks in the first round of the playoffs. San Antonio's combined 70-point winning margin over Miami was also the largest in NBA Finals history.
