Kenny Wayne Shepherd

Every now and then something great comes along. Unfortunately, it often flies under the commercial radar and doesn't get much exposure. I have always believed some of the greatest music there is out there will never be heard on the radio. Furthermore, many people, unless you are a big fan of specific artists, will even know about some of the greatest music being released. The new Kenny Wayne Shepherd album, 'Goin Home' is plain and simply some of the best music I have heard in a very long time.

As he has gotten older, his music has matured a great deal. The 36 year old blues guitarist from Shreveport, Louisiana has been playing guitar since he was 3 years old. He says he is completely self-taught and learned by watching and implementing a style from the late-great Stevie Ray Vaughn. Kenny's father was a concert promoter and SRV was one of the artists he promoted so Kenny got a lot of opportunities to watch his idol play. It may be just short of sacrilege to say this, but I think Kenny has surpassed the talent we heard in the short amount of time Stevie was on this earth blessing us with his music. The other great thing about Kenny is that there is not many people of any age putting out true blues music these days. This is a real treat for blues fans.

The new collection of songs on 'Goin' Home' breathes blues that come right from the roots of the genre all the way to some great hard-hitting blues rock. If you like this style of music, this is something that is a must-have in your collection. I personally have been a big fan of Kenny Wayne Shepherd and when I began to listen to this album, I was beyond impressed. Most of the material is true to form blues with a few exceptions. My favorite song on the album is a heavy hitting rocker called "Palace of the King". To say this song kicks ass is a grave understatement. The guitar riffs are hard hitting while the down to earth, very heartfelt lyrics of this Leon Russell penned song is raw blues rock at its best. I assure you will not be disappointed in this song. Make sure to crank it up super loud when you listen to it.

The only song that really separates itself from the rest of the collection is "Breaking Up Somebody's Home". It has more of a 1970's classic rock sound than a blues. One thing to keep I mind, many of the old southern, classic rockers like the Allman Brothers, .38 Special, and the likes had strong roots in the blues and their sound reflected it as does this song. Truly the only song that I was not fond of was the Stevie Ray Vaughn staple, "If the House is Rockin". Many artists from country to rock and swing bands have recorded this song and I just don't like Kenny's version of it. I do admit, I am very partial to the Stevie Ray Vaughn version.

The rest of the songs are from some of the great names in blues that include Melvin London's, Cut You Loose, Muddy Waters', Still a Fool, Albert King's Born Under a Bad Sign, Willie Dixon's, I Love The Life I Live, B.B. King's You Done Lost Your Good Thing Now, another Leon Russell tune, Boogie Man, and lastly a blues rock themes song by John Watson called, Looking Back.

This is hard core blues at its best. The pain and agony of the blues lyrics can be felt straight through your soul and down deep into your bones. If you love real, true blues, this is a collection that cannot be missed. Kenny Wayne Shepherd has done his best work yet on this album.

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

"King of the Monsters"

"Godzilla", directed by Gareth Edwards giving us king of the monsters, Godzilla, the ancient alpha-bred, in a new American remake, forgetting the first 1998 attempt by director Roland Emmerich. Edwards's version brings the impact that pre-historical creatures bring and the restoration of balance by the king. After an earthquake which causes a severe nuclear reactor breach, forcing nuclear physicist Joe Brody (played by Bryan Cranston) to seal the shield doors on his wife a nuclear engineer subjecting her to lethal radiation. Joe fifteen years later still convinced that more was going on then just a natural catastrophe soon returns to the site with his son Ford (Aaron Taylor-Johnson) in what might be the beginning of the end for the age of humanity and proving his theory.

You have no Idea what's coming! ~ Joe Brody

The chain of events began in the 1950's where use of the first nuclear sub awakened something in the depths of the ocean. Beginning the use of what was supposedly nuclear bomb testing. Many of those were not test, but attempts to destroy primeval adaptable creatures which absorbed nuclear radiation as a food source. Godzilla's mixture of scenes reminiscent of "Cloverfield" and "Pacific Rim". Constant destruction and towering monstrous fight scenes, with unclear pending doom for humanity.

The film steadily focused more on Aaron Taylor-Johnson's character after the first thirty minutes, Ford Brody, more than what was supposedly the main character of the film,



Godzilla. While other characters including Ken Watanabe and Bryan Cranston, not much left to contribute but a few minutes and key lines of the film. The film continually hopped through cut away after cut away from fight scenes of the monsters to show plans to destroy the monsters by using their food source, or the destruction left behind in various cities as the creatures took course toward their destination. There were a couple of loose ends in the story line, but enough to make this Godzilla, the one. Godzilla still towering the box office its opening weekend with over \$93.2 million, and anticipated \$103million worldwide. A sequel is almost guaranteed in the works.

Singer shows us the X-men in what will become their grim future if what remains of the past's course is not altered in a last ditch effort to save mutants and non-mutants, by stopping a war before it begins with the creation of the Sentinel program. They must stop the program before it becomes government-sanctioned. Wolverine's (played by Hugh Jackman) consciousness is projected backward, 1973 into the mind of his younger self to convince fellow mutants to embrace hope and all mankind. Opposing forces must unite together, but will it be enough...

This film starts off on the edge as mutants are awaiting Sentinel attacks in the destined future of what remains the last strong hold. The Sentinels have now taken over. Targeting mutants and non-mutants through genetics, along with those who stand in their way. The sentinels' program creator Bolivar Trask (Peter Dinklage) has plans to arm his machines with mutant genetics

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so they can adapt to any mutant power. He is just missing the one mutant who can deliver those genetics, Mystique (Jennifer Lawrence). In the process of saving all mutant and mankind Wolverine must convince Dr Charles Xavier (James McAvoy) and Magneto (Michael Fassbender) to unite for the good of the future.

It's going to take the two of us, side by side at a time when we couldn't be further apart. ~Magneto

X-Men: Days of Future Past consistently brings something new throughout scene with easter eggs and more mutant characters in the mix including Bishop, Warpath, Blink, and Sunspot. At the same time we see main characters killed in the film, which will throw you for a loop. If you are an X-men fan, you may question when did Kitty Pryde get time travel powers and wasn't she to go back in time? Also what becomes of the mutant future since now the world knows they exist. Jean Gray also returns abruptly to the X-men. This new X-men film, changes everything in the X-men universe giving the big screen possible free reign over the next films. If you are into X-men, or just like to see things levitate, explode, or morph, this is the film to see as the summer blockbusters kick-off. Stay tuned after the credits. X-Men: Days of Future Past brought in \$111 million its first weekend domestic including Memorial Day, and \$191 million worldwide.



~ Garlic Pesto Chicken w/ Zucchini Spaghetti~


- zucchini
- 4 large garlic cloves
- 6 ounces skinless chicken breast (chopped)
- 1/4 cup fat free sour cream
- 1 cup fresh basil
- 1/4 cup fresh parsley
- 1 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes
- 1 tablespoon of pine nuts
- 1 cup of grape or cherry tomatoes
- 1 cup of mushrooms
- ¹/₄ cup of vidalia onion
- ¹/₂ cup of parmigiano-reggiano cheese
- marsala cooking wine
- extra virgin olive oil
- sea salt
- black pepper

1. Combine 3 cloves of garlic and sour cream in food processor. Pulse until the garlic is finely chopped. Add the basil, parsley, crushed red pepper, pine nuts and cheese. Puree until the sauce is smooth. Set aside.

2. Using a cheese grater or julienne slicer, grate zucchini long way as to make noodles.

3. In a saute pan, heat oil. Saute chicken, remainder of garlic and onion until chicken is browning. Add mushrooms and saute for a few minutes. Add zucchini and tomatoes. Add a splash of wine, salt & pepper to taste, and continue sauteing until chicken is cooked.

4. Remove from heat. In a large bowl, combine contents of saute pan with the per-made pesto sauce. Mix and Serve.

LIGHTING TECHNIQUES FOR GLAMOUR PHOTOGRAPHERS By: David Sutton Southern Vixens Staff Photographer

One of the wonderful things about photography is that for every rule, you can sometimes violate that rule to create amazing results. Such is the case with lighting techniques.

Every photograph is one-of-akind. That's part of the fun of this! Every time you combine the special beauty of a woman with the personal vision of a photographer, in a picturesque setting, and employ an effective lighting technique, you create a work of art that is unique. No matter how many people are taking pictures these days, there will always be a demand for fresh, interesting, material. It's not a fixed pie in this industry, folks. Seeing terrific images simply creates an increasing demand to see even more.

Here is one rule that I encourage you to start breaking as soon as possible to help bring your photography to the next level, and achieve more publications: Rule: Master one lighting technique; establish your personal style in the marketplace, and stick to it. The thinking behind this rule is that models and clients will identify you by your style, your "brand," and choose you from all the other people in the industry to work with, because they like what you do, and they can count on you to do pictures like that for them. Like going to their favorite fast food franchise. Customers want predictability. And you will become very experienced with your



Drag the Shutter. Question: What's best? A: Natural light, or B: Strobe lighting? In photography, as in life, often the key to finding exceptional solutions lies in avoiding A versus B narrow-mindedness. A creative combination of A + B may be way better than either one alone. In this case, to capture the motion of the crashing waves, you want to exploit beautiful natural light and use a shutter speed of 1/15 sec, or slower. Of course that means you cannot hand-hold your camera with its telephoto lens, so a monopod plus ultrasonic lens stabilization helps keep the rest of the scene motionless and crisp. Then you want to key light your lovely model, following the principles of Rembrandt lighting. In this case a strobe and an octabox with grid were chosen. That is because speedlights would not have provided enough power, and a beauty dish would have shown too narrow a spot of light for this scene. Model: Shawnee Boze. Bikini: Montce Swim.



Aperture Priority and Speedlights are for Amateurs, Right? Baloney. When the sun is setting fast, and the light is changing by the minute, Manual Mode and Strobes are not your buddies, because they take too dang long to get just right, then the light changes again. Why not make skillful use of the incredible automatic exposure technology inside your camera and ETTL in your speed lights to take care of providing a correct exposure and balance, so that you can devote your attention to inspiring your model, and to good artistic composition. Model: Kinzey Ray. Hair Stylist: Sunnie Rushton.

chosen lighting technique, and be able to reliably deliver consistently excellent results with that look. Baloney! Take a good long look at most photographers' portfolios on Model Mayhem, or Facebook, or Instagram, or wherever. Boring! Cookie Cutter. Realize that most photographers, (and most models, too, btw), are not managing to get their work published, despite all their efforts and investment. As in sports or just about any profession, less than ten percent of the people doing it are achieving more than ninety percent of the desired results. In our case that goal is publication leading to exposure leading to paid work. What I believe you will find in the portfolios of the vast majority of underachieving photographers is a boring lack of diversity of lighting styles. Do you really want to be as predictable as a fast food franchise? Or do you want to learn from those relative few who are managing to do something different from the rest, and succeeding despite the competition?

Once you become comfortable with many different lighting styles, you will be ready to exploit whatever situation arises. You won't be dependent upon the weather conditions, for example. You will be confident that you will be able to



Overpower the Sun. Sure, strobes, stands, batteries, and big modifiers are a pain to haul around. But, man, do they come in handy sometimes. With only natural lighting, it would have been impossible to balance the exposure of the background with that of the subject, and the model would have had horrendous shadows in unflattering places. If you can shoot strobes in a studio, you can shoot strobes on location. Similar principles apply, and the results are worth the hassle of getting things calibrated right. Be careful outdoors: you will need help on windy days! Model: Kalli Athens. Hair Stylist: Sunnie Rushton. Victoria Plant Makeup Artistry. create stunning pictures no matter what comes up.

So, yes, become very skilled at making the most of natural lighting, for example. But also learn how to use a set of speed lights and modifiers to enhance images. Learn how to use studio strobes outdoors to overpower the sun and create the vivid images that magazines love. Learn how to work with just one light indoors in a dark studio to create dramatic effects. Learn how to create stunning images with a simple white seamless background that publishers often use for magazine covers. Why? Because that way the publisher can surround the model with what they refer to as "copy," i.e. text titles for their feature articles. But does that mean they want all of the pictures in the feature inside the magazine to have been shot on white seamless, too? No. Vary it up, guys!

If you can provide a publisher with fifteen to twenty-five amazing images in at least Less is More. Don't fall into the trap of feeling like you have to use every piece of lighting equipment you spent tons of money to acquire. Nothing pisses away a model's gorgeous energy than getting bored while the photographer screws around setting up and tweaking lights. Look for the natural light, and its quality. What you want is an area where there are soft shadows. Then add a subtle hard highlight, and you're good to go. Next shot. Keep it flowing. Model: Capri Kay. Hair Stylist: Sunnie Rushton. Victoria Plant Makeup Artistry.



Get the Heck Outta Dodge. Travel. Play. Break out of your comfort zone. Experiment. Rediscover whatever it was that inspired you to go into photography in the first place. five very different looks, you will inspire them. Just as we photographers become inspired by seeing a gorgeous model or a terrific setting, and just as a model becomes inspired when she gets to wear a stunning outfit, the wheels in a publisher's head start spinning with layout ideas when they see a submission set with a good variety of looks to work with.

You might be thinking, but then I would need to shoot tons! I would need lots of different equipment, and lots of different cool locations. I would need more time to work one-on-one with each model than just one photoshoot or one typical workshop would offer. I would need to keep learning, and reading, and watching, and shooting, and practicing new lighting techniques all the time. I would need to force myself outside my comfort zone. I would need to experiment, and even make a few mistakes, until I create something fresh and interesting.

Yes, exactly. Welcome to the pros, man.

Think like a Chef. A really good cook knows how to use what's available, mix natural ingredients with just the right spices, to create something unique that everyone will enjoy, and that fits the occasion. In this image, the setting sun, plus the sky, plus a strobe in a large octabox, were used to make the image pop, complimenting the models' outfits, and the power truck. Mix it Up. What's better, Natural Light or Artificial Light through Modifiers? Sometimes the answer is Both. All you want to add is a little Rembrandt 45 degree key light using a speedlight in a small portable softbox, and you've got what you need to make the image pop. Southern Vixens: Where do you call home? Michael: Bronx, NY

Southern Vixens: How long have you been a photographer? Michael: Going on 9 years now.

Southern Vixens: How did you get your start in photography?

Michael: By trade I am a Theatrical Lighting Designer and in college I got my first camera (a film camera btw) to

archive the shows that I designed. After that, I started to design the lights for shows on cruise ships and I took more sunset pictures you have ever wanted to take in your life. In 2005, I thought I could start taking press and archive pictures for shows to make some extra money. Unfortunately, that didn't work. So then I thought I could take portfolio pics for the hair stylists that were using my wife as their hair guinea pig at a hair styling school. And that didn't work out. So I joined Model Mayhem and slowly started to shoot models from there. And now you see how that worked out.

Southern Vixens: Did you go to school for photography or are you a self-taught?

Michael: I am completely self-taught.

Southern Vixens: What type of cameras do you shoot with?

Michael: I shoot with DSLR cameras. Specifically the Canon 5D Mark III.

Southern Vixens: What is your favorite photography accessory, besides your camera?

Michael: Truthfully, it's my Hoodman. Before I got it I actually looked like Beavis and Butthead when I was outside trying to look at the LCD on my camera because I put the camera under my shirt and then lifted the shirt above my head to view the screen. Definitely interesting **Southern Vixens: If you had to choose one lens, which would it be and why?**

Michael: Good question. I just recently acquired my own 24-70mm f/2.8 L lens. Before that I would rent the 24-70mm L and sometimes the 70-200mm L when I went on my trips. But when I wasn't on these trips I actually used the 18-55mm kit lens that came with my 2nd Canon Rebel.

My philosophy is that it's not the camera that makes the photographer. With the prices of cameras nowadays you have those guys that buy the most expensive gear and then they think they are a "photographer". I believe that a good photographer with his knowledge of composition and light could take a point and shoot and create a better image than the GWC that just bought the most expensive equipment out there. So, to get

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back on track, because the 5DMIII does not accept EFS lens I upgraded to the 24-70 and love it. It's crystal clear and with the 2.8 f-stop I can shoot in all types of lighting situations. Bet you weren't expecting such a long answer to this question, huh?

Southern Vixens: What type of lighting equipment do you take on a shoot?

Michael: In my studio, I have Alien Bees. On-location I have 4 speedlights.

Southern Vixens: What is your favorite computer/editing accessory, other then your computer?

Michael: My Wacom tablet!!! Years ago before I bought my tablet I was afraid of the learning curve to use one, but there was barely any, and now I can't even begin to think about using a mouse to edit.

Southern Vixens: How important is Photoshop to your final images?

Michael: When attending the Shoot The Centerfold seminar, the one thing they kept telling us is to try and get it "right" in the camera from the beginning. Are we Photographers or Photoshop Experts? Relying on Photoshop to "fix" your images is not the right thinking one should have as a photographer. But of course with that said, I am still learning on how to get it "right" and there are some things that we cannot control, so Photoshop "helps" me along the way.

Southern Vixens: Are you a Mac or PC lover?

Michael: I am PC all the way.

Southern Vixens: How would you describe your personal style?

Michael: Another good question, lol. It sometimes hard for me to think that I have a "style" because I just go, have fun and shoot. But the one thing that I keep hearing is that my photos have a certain emotion to them. So I would say my style is "Emotional".

Southern Vixens: Who is your favorite photographer?

Michael: I'm not sure if I can say that I have a "favorite" photographer. When going through college to be a Theatrical Lighting Designer I always got the question "What/who was your inspiration for your design?" and I could never give a clear answer because I usually didn't know all the famous artists out there and what they did. If there is something I see that I like, that's my inspiration or that's where I got my idea from, and it's the same with my photography. I know there are many famous photographers out there, but I never studied photography, so I don't know their work well except for a few famous images that you see in everyday life. If something catches my eye it doesn't necessarily have to be from someone famous. I would change the question a little bit and say the photographers that I "look up" to and enjoy their work would be: David Mecey, Steven Bagley, Alex Manfredini and many others that catch my eye and there are plenty!

Southern Vixens: Have you been able to travel a lot for your work?

Michael: Surprisingly, thanks to the International Bikini Model Search (IBMS), the Sobe Shootout and soon the Black Tape Project Paradise Challenge, yes I have been able to travel at least 4-5 times a year to amazing locations. In the last 2 years I have been to the Bahamas, South Beach Miami, Cancun and Jamaica and it's been incredible. Plus, I also make other trips throughout the US for a weekend here and there. Always great to be able to do what you love and travel at the same time.
