The Fate of Country Music

I have been reading a lot of articles, blogs, and such about the current state of country music. The hardcore country music lovers, who still believe there are only two types of music, country AND western, have taken up issue with what is being penned, 'Bro-Country'. This is the music of country superstars like Luke Bryan, Jason Aldean and Florida Georgia Line and these critics are screaming these guys are, "destroying country music".

With this in mind, I thought I would share my perspective on this matter. Being in the music business for over 30 years I have seen a lot of changes on the music scene. I also have come to understand the business and what makes it tick. There's a harsh reality that a lot of fans seem to overlook, "Music is a business and Sales drives the music". The record companies are in the business of making money more than they are in the business of making good (or bad) music. The music is simply a means to an end, profit.

Let's take Florida Georgia Line and their huge 2013 mega hit "Cruise". This song smashed record after record from sales to weeks atop the Billboard Country charts. Many country music fans took serious issue with the remix of this that featured a rap by Nelly. That version of the song helped propel the song to be a huge hit among both the country fans as well as the pop fans. This was good marketing and good business. There really was nowhere during the summer of 2013 that you could not hear that song being played. Furthermore, it took the band from a little known group to superstardom.



This is no different from times in the past when country artists created a pop version of their music or made a more "pop" sound and crossed over from the country to mainstream music listeners. Take Charlie Daniels and the Oak Ridge Boys in the 80's. No one can tell me Elvira was a "country" song. It was really a lot like 'Cruise" just minus Nelly. Like the Florida Georgia line hit, you could hear Elvira on every radio station and every cassette player in America for a summer. I saw the Oak Ridge Boys in concert the summer of 81 and I think they did 13 encores of that song.

Let's take some more recent examples like Garth Brooks and Taylor Swift. The first two Garth albums could be considered country, but after that, he strayed to appeal to a more mainstream audience. In fact, in 1994, he performed with the rock gods KISS. In all reality, is there much of a difference between singing with the masked men or Nelly?

Then there is Taylor Swift. I have never understood how she could ever be classified as a country artist. She is about as country as Nelly is. Yet, Luke Bryan is hated because he sings "Bro Country" and Taylor Swift is the princess of the country music world. It makes no sense to me.

Luke Bryan and Jason Aldean are no different than Travis Tritt was in the 90's. His form of country was more Southern Rock than it was country. Guess what? People complained he wasn't country enough.



As long as there will be music there will be the critics of the "new stuff". Hank Williams, Patsy Cline and George Jones are no longer around to make "true" country music. There needs to be new music and with that it will evolve no matter what the genre. It is just a harsh reality that creates revenue for the record labels. If an artist does not sell records, it does not keep their record contract. With no contract, no one will hear their music. The object is to sell record, become famous and sell out concerts. The "Bro's" are very successful at doing that. They are selling a lot of records and making a lot of women hot and bothered at the thought of those guys singing. I'd say it is a win-win for everyone at the time.


What do you think is the sexiest thing about a man?

"Edge of Tomorrow" directed by Doug Liman and based on the novel by Hiroshi Sakurazaka titled "All you need is Kill". Edge of Tomorrow's complex science-fiction thriller brings us into the epic battle field of the future where man versus man is behind us, and man versus invading aliens is at the forefront as Lt. Colonel William Cage (Played by Tom Cruise) is forced into battle as a PR pencil-pusher with little knowledge of the battlefield. He directly dies on the battlefield as a result, but not before being doused in the blood of an alien invader alpha called, a Mimic. He immediately wakes up to a ground base in Heathrow Airport as the previous day before

"Edge of Tomorrow" is leading you on a roller coaster that seems to have multiple routes to the top. As groundhog day begins for the newly Pvt Cage, he is introduced to Sgt. Major Rita Vratalski aka the "Angel of Verdun" mid battle, as she warns him to find her when he wakes up. She once had the same abilities as Cage, but lost them. Cage soon realizes that the mimics were aware of their planned attack on the beach, as it will fail. He must continually learn and retrace his every step alongside Sgt. Major Vratalski to locate and destroy the hive mind of the Omega mimic. The film does require the viewer to think a bit on their part, rather than become a mind-numbed viewer as the undertone of love, looping, and camaraderie intertwine creating holes in the plot you fill as the story line proceeds. The dynamic action and fluidness of the movie is still there. Director Doug Liman may have only left slight holes in the tail end to figure for yourself, but it's acceptable with the quality of the film and its merged video game concept.

The film grossed nearly 29\$ million in its first week and over \$300 million worldwide so far as it thrives overseas with its production budget of \$178 million, coming in competition with "Maleficent" and "The Fault in Our Stars". "Edge of Tomorrow" isn't like other sci-fi films as it may appear in its PR debut ads, which may be what leads viewers to shy a bit on this great sci-fi film. With the competing films both with female lead roles, worth the watch as Emily blunt nearly steals the show going toe -to-toe with Cruise on bad ass credibility. The film deserves far more attention for a summer movie.

We are back as romantic plans for Michael (played by Terrence J) and Candace's (played by Regina Hall) wedding go a bit awry as the boys bachelor (including Michael Ealy, Romany Malco, Gary Owen, and Jerry Ferrara) and girls bachelorette parties (including Taraji P. Henson, Gabrielle Union, Wendi McLendon-Covey, and Meagan Good) simultaneously go down hill post-wedding day, and the antics leave everything nearly turned upside down as relationships are tested. Gambling, strippers, clubs, and an occasional arrest record, everything you could expect from a trip to Vegas.

2014's "Think Like a Man Too' has ditched it's previous 2012 molds and coupled its characters. It left most of the book and went for its own avant-garde production of the original film

nearly parting ways with its "Think Like a Man" charm. We have a film that circulates around Kevin Hart as "Cedric" Michael's Best Man. Yet many of its scenes were pretty much fillers filled with what else, but Kevin Hart, a somewhat drug induced music video, and even a montage. Let's not forget the cameos by other celebrities throughout the film. Many of its first film viewers were expecting some of the depth and characters involvement of this films predecessor, there were remnants.

Think Like a Man Too opened at over \$30 million box office with a film worth \$24 million to produce, and premiering on over 2, 225 screens. It's only contender for the weekend was "22 Jump Street". The film pitted female and male perspective on things which is always appealing according to Rory Bruer, Sony Pictures president of worldwide distribution as it's second No. 1 in only a few weeks in Canada and the US. Appealing to 63% female demographic and 59% over 30, the film did try to impart strong relationships, their struggles, and true happiness through relationships as a consolation take away. 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

Maple Whiskey Bacon Brownies

-Ingredients-

- 1/2 pound bacon, diced (save some for garnish)
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 1/2 cup melted butter
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1/4 cup white sugar
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup cocoa powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 cup of maple whiskey of choice (I use Crown Royal Maple or Cabin Fever)
- Maple syrup (for garnish)
- chocolate frosting
 - (I'm lazy, any store brand will do)

-Directions-

Preheat oven to 350 degrees Grease an 8-inch square baking dish.

Fry bacon in a skillet over medium-high heat until nearly crisp, about 5 minutes. Add honey and stir until the foaming subsides. Remove the bacon with a slotted spoon to a plate to cool.

Mix melted butter, brown sugar, white sugar, whiskey and vanilla extract in a large bowl; mix in eggs.

Sift flour, cocoa powder, and salt together in a bowl; add to the egg mixture. Fold bacon and chocolate chips into the mixture; pour into the prepared baking dish.

Bake in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean, 25 to 35 minutes. Allow brownies to cool for 20 minutes before frosting and cutting into squares. Drizzle with maple syrup. Garnish with extra bacon.

So I know what you're thinking: "Is this girl really going to sit there and try to convince me that a model's job is hard??" Not exactly. I'll be the first to tell you that looking sexy is not a difficult job. But when you shoot over 300 times a year and travel like I do, most of your shoots aren't commercial sets like you'd expect, but small local studios with photographers looking to work with a professional model or trying to expand their businesses and portfolios. This is where the rubber meets the road, and this is what gets difficult. Let's take a usual 24-hours-look into the life of a model.

May 22nd, 2014: At 6:00am, the alarm on my phone would howl through the room to remind me that it's time to start another day. I open my eyes to realize my laptop is asleep and staring me right in the face: I passed out while working again. Before I get out of bed, I remind myself what city I'm in, as you tend to forget traveling in and out of hotels all the time. After the usual morning routine, I begin cooking and check online to see what I missed in the 4+ hours I was unconscious. My banana-infused oatmeal hits the spot as it always does, and I head down to the gym by 7am so I can be sure I don't miss the full episode of Sportscenter. As I get into my routine of squats, lunges, leg-lifts, etc. I put on some workout music and look through last night's emails to see if there's anything that needs immediate responding.

8:30am hits as I hop into the my postworkout shower and by 9am, I'm still on time as I sit down to start doing my makeup while my hair dries. It's 10am by the time my makeup and hair are done, and it's time to check out of my hotel. Run down, pull up the truck, get the cart, head back up, load the cart, head back down,unload the cart, load the truck, return the cart - This is an almost everyday thing. Once I'm all loaded, I head to my first shoot. I haven't even started working yet.

See, my point is that the actual shooting aspect of our jobs that everyone knows about is the easy part. The actual work isn't done in front of the camera, but off set, where we spend countless hours in the gym, writing messages, responding to emails, interacting with fans and social media (which yes, I can assure you, IS a job in-and-of itself), as well as shoot prep. I'd say I spend 2 hours working off camera for everyone one hour on camera, at least. To think that our work ends when the lights stop flashing would be a tragic underestimation.



Once I get to my first shoot, I drag in my 3 shooting suitcases, my makeup, purse, and if I had time, a starbucks or something to drink along with my lunch I prepared the night before. I get settled in, and just doing that is somewhat involved. I'm pretty much walking into somewhere I've never been, never seen, that could hold any sort of surprises. You have to get settled down within 5 minutes to start going through wardrobe. I check on the makeup with the photographer, and double check to make sure I didn't mess anything up on the way here. For the next three hours, I'll have a pretty easy time today. He's a talker and a nice guy. We're shooting simple glamour

stuff: Lingerie and heels, jackets without bra's, topless and jeans, etc. 3 hours goes by in a flash, and before you know it, I'm packing up all my stuff which ended up sprawled across the studio and clocking myself as my next shoot starts in an hour. This is what most of my shoots are like. We do paperwork, handle the compensation situation, and I'm off by 1:45pm with a new friend and a good experience.

30 minutes later, I arrive to my next shoot a few minutes early, so I put together a quick snack for me to bring, and head up. I walk into the studio and this time, I'm not so lucky in the photographers demeanor and arrogance. On top of that, we were shooting Art Nudes for 2 hours. Now, I know what you're thinking, "How hard can it be to wriggle around on the floor in funny positions for a few hours??" Well, allow me to paint a picture: Imagine for a second, getting into some of the most uncomfortable positions on god's green earth (think drunken twister where the person touching the most circles in the most uncomfortable way wins), on not-quitecomfortable surfaces (generally hard floors or wooden boxes or anything that looks like the only thing you'd choose NOT to sit on after running a marathon), and having to stay in these poses on these surfaces for 5-30 seconds at a time all while wearing absolutely nothing. It can get rough.

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After those grueling two hours, I finally get finished and my body feels like it just went through a wash-and-dry cycle at the local "We Shrink Your Clothes". We handle paperwork, I get told a few more times how awesome he is and I finally escape with a little bit of sanity. Ego is a very big part of our industry, and being

able to assuage the ego of the other party



whilst not letting it Godzilla your Tokyo is an art unto itself. Of course, most people you encounter aren't like that, but they're out there.

4:35pm: I get into the truck, and check my phone. 15 text messages, 4 missed calls, 56 new emails, 28 Facebook notifications, 99+ Google+ notifications, 32 Twitter Mentions, and I haven't even posted anything yet today. I grab a selfie I took earlier in the day, and post that with a note of the cities I'll be in and when; basically a default fallback plan for when I'm really busy. Over the next 110 minutes, I'll drive 100 miles to my destination, while speaking to my 4 photographers for tomorrow. 3 are good to go, one had to cancel last minute. I would then listen to my voicemails. Turns out I have another photographer wanting to shoot tomorrow now, so that will make up for the one who canceled, but he can't do the same timing.

Now, here's where one of the biggest pains in the ass of our jobs comes into play: schedules. We somehow make an attempt to juggle the schedules and lives of multiple people together, all while mixing in our own needs on scheduling, and somehow come out with a cohesive shooting plan that includes traveling to location, timing needs of each, as well as dates available. In a week trip, I'll have to do this with 10-20 different individuals, all with different needs and wants and all whose schedules are in-flux and changing as the days go on. Oh, and we're not allowed to make mistakes, because if we do, it costs us money, costs people their shoots and makes us look terrible. This is probably the most stressful part of our jobs.

I finally arrive, and this photographer was a workhorse! He was determined to get 22



and a half different looks into our 3 hour shoot. So I finish the day at a mile a minute and head to my new hotel in my new city. I do my check out routine in reverse, get settled in, and I make myself a quick dinner, when I realize I've still gotten nothing done online today. So I get to work knocking out all those numbers I read you earlier, and that's no small task.

Now, the day I chose wasn't some anomaly from my schedule, but a normal day like any other. I usually shoot 1-3 times a day, depending on shoot lengths and times, I respond to about 100 different messages, emails, etc. a day on average, and I actually usually spend more time on social media than I got to here because of how busy I was. I'm not an extreme case, either. There's lots of us out there all doing the same thing day-in and day-out while everyone thinks that generally all we do is show up, look pretty, and leave. Now granted, I've been told I'm one of the harder working girls out there, and we have the same bell-curve of effort-driven people as any other profession, but for Freelance models, there's no guarantee on tomorrow, so we have to work as hard as we can today.

I'll stay up working until anywhere between 12 and 2am, usually whenever I pass out on the computer. It's not the easiest dream to chase, with any new cute face being the immediate popular kid on the block, but it is my dream. If they want to take it from me, they're going to have to work harder than me, and be willing to sacrifice more than me. Until then, I'll be on the road, working everyday, and living the "easy" life as some people see it. I don't have a home, and I don't take days off. This life has an expiration date, and I plan to extend that for as long as possible, because as much of an ego-pleasing, body-wrecking, sleeprefusing, communication-dreading, non-stop abusive-relationship-of-a-life that this is... it's still my dream, and deep down I love every second of it. Now if you'll excuse me I have work to do. ;)
