"Sex Tape" Starring Cameron Diaz (Annie) and Jason Siegel (Jay), directed by Jake Kasdan. Despite having a good small crew of supporting actors, and a few cameos to this film. It pretty much fizzled as much as the films bases. There were a few good laughs, a lot of try hard acting and some soft pillow talk throughout. Which makes for a subpar raunchy comedy. This film is recommended to any sober married couple looking for a date or movie night...don't get any ideas.









All Hail Green Eyes

"Dawn of The Planet of the Apes", directed by Matt Reeves, brings us ten winters from the ape rebellion lead by Old Green Eyes himself, in which no man has been seen since then. Caesar (played by Andy Serkis), a biologically evolved chimpanzee now leads an ape colony based on resisting the habits of man fighting against man, including war. One day a group of surviving humans stumble upon the ape colony. Caesar still tethered to the nurturing humane side which was shown to him agrees to help the outsiders as the two sides agree to stay on two sides in return. He is forced to drive peace over war to protect the lives of those in his colony. Some agree and disapprove of Caesars action, but many follow, except his ally Koba.

Dawn has its calm before the storm moments that will leave you on the edge of your seat. Caesar is betrayed by those closest to him, including Koba his ally in a strike to take power. Koba with his strong hatred of humans due to testing and torture at their hands, wishes to enslave and execute the same punishment on humans. Both human and chimp sides must come to a short head in an effort to retain peace or the start of a new war in a post-apocalyptic world were humans, except for those few immune have been wiped out due to a genetically modified experimental virus known as the Simian flu. A Chat with Dutchie

How did you get your start in modeling?

After receiving encouragement from key, supportive people in my life, I began embracing the title of 'model' just this year (2014). A photographer saw something in me that I didn't know existed and from there, I began modeling under my nickname 'Dutchie'. Know your worth! From the beginning, I made it a goal to know my value, as I saw so many models working hard for free. Also, don't be afraid to be a bit picky with which photographers you work with. Even when you are doing trade-for-portfolio work, it is important that the photographer is talented because your portfolio needs to be top-quality right from the beginning, and reflect your talent as a model.

What would you say is your best modeling experience?

I have had many, but early this year I went to Cancun for the International Bikini Model Search, where photographers and models from all over the world have the opportunity to collaborate. I didn't participate in the actual bikini model search, as I was focused on doing photo shoots, and I had the opportunity to work with ten amazing photographers during fifteen photo shoots in just six days.

When you are not modeling what's your favorite way to relax?

Lying in bed watching trashy reality TV shows and eating junk food is how I unwind!

What do you do to maintain your body to keep it in shape?

When I am preparing for a photo shoot that requires me to be in top shape, I prepare by working with my personal trainer, usually 3-5 times a week. I do my best to eat clean as well. If I am not training for a specific photo shoot, I try to watch what I eat and not go overboard with huge amounts of junk food. I believe 90% of being in shape is your food intake. One of my secrets is sitting on a yoga ball while I am working on the computer. This keeps my abs strong!

What do you consider the perfect man?

To me an ideal person is someone who treats everybody with dignity, and doesn't see themselves as better than anyone else; someone who genuinely listens when they are having a conversation with you, and of course, a killer sense of humour.



What is the most adventurous thing you have ever done?

I went bungee jumping and it was the most terrifying thing I have ever done!

All food! I do love sushi and have weaknesses for chocolate, cheese, and candy.

He was the front man to the Stray Cats that delivered such top ten hits as "Rock This Town", "Stray Cat Strut" and "She's Sexy & 17" in the early 80's. He then went on his own with the Brian Setzer Orchestra and without them as a solo artist.

Through his entire career, his music has been filling the swing clubs (not that kind of swing, the dance kind) with his mix of rockabilly and classic original-style Rock N Roll. You could literally put him in a time machine and send him back to 1955 and he would fit right in without anyone knowing he came from the present. His new release Rockabilly Riot: All Original is a great mix of new rock-a-billy music by the contemporary master of this genre of music. The songs selected are comparable to the original rock n roll music of Elvis Presley, Ritchie Valens and the Everly Brothers mixed with Asleep at the Wheel and all of it will get your feet moving every step of the way.

One of the things I enjoy about the disc (what do you even call these anymore?? An album was vinyl, a disc was a CD... this is just digital music in a folder) Anyway one of the things I enjoyed about this folder of digital music is the unique song titles. "Cock-a-Doodle Don't" and "I Shouldn't Have a V-8" are two that are the most unique. Cock a Doodle is one that will get the poodle skirts a-flarin' for sure. Personally I think the addition of parachutes to all the seats would be great. I mean if we're going down I'd like the option to get out before we hit. Let's be real here, that floating seat ain't gonna save my life, at least with a chute I may have a 50/50 shot haha... Ok back on track here, my column is about food so ya'll must have guessed where I was going with this tangent. The one upgrade no airline has made and it would be the least expensive and probably the one to make their passengers the happiest is the freaking food! Like seriously I'd be happier with a PB&J or grilled cheese sandwich over any of the in flight meals any day, and not only would those be economical but quick and easy to prepare and could also

be made in advance and stored...just saying. On one flight I swear to God I actually saw this as a packaged item on the menu: a mini bag of pretzels, a cup of mustard & 1 Twizzler stick. Not only does that sound extremely appetizing, but it will definitely contain my hunger throughout this 6hr flight. (I hope you all caught the sarcasm in my voice) Oh, and the pricing! \$12 for the "gourmet sampler" which consists of 2 slivers of cheese, 1 cracker, 4 grapes & 3 almonds. BUT! A mini bottle of wine is \$4 haha and then America wonders why so many of us end up handcuffed by an air marshall to the bathroom door for unruly behavior. Since we are on the booze topic, that also needs an upgrade. Not too many stiff drink choices. However probably a safety precaution, because most of us would rather light our shot of Bacardi 151 on fire and chuck it the screaming child in seat 17C than drink it. My suggestion to beat to horrible airplane food & high prices? Bring your own. Believe it or not they will still allow food through airport security. Oh, and what better way to secretly piss off every one on the flight? Bring an egg salad sandwich with fish! ;)

Smoked Salmon Egg Salad Sandwich

- hard boiled eggs (amount depends on how many sandwiches you're making. 1 dozen usually does about 6-7 sandwiches)
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 2 tbsp Dijon mustard
- 1 tbsp Honey mustard
- 1.5 tbsp minced fresh dill
- capers
- chives (chopped)
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp pepper
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- slices of smoked salmon for each sandwich
- bread (I usually like a cibiatta or hearty whole grain)
- lettuce (I prefer arugula, romaine also works nicely)
- •

Place eggs in the bowl of a food processor fitted with a steel blade. Pulse about 10 times to break them up, do not puree. Transfer chopped eggs to a bowl and add the mayonnaise, mustards, capers, chives, dill, garlic, salt & pepper. Combine lightly with a fork.

Toast the bread. Lay slices of lettuce & salmon on each piece of bread, spoon egg salad onto salmon. Serve at room temperature.

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6 Tips to Buying Smarter

Each of us faces this problem on the regular basis. For some it's daily, weekly, or even monthly. I'm talking about grocery shopping. Grocery shopping the most common type shopping trip we make and the one that often costs us more then we realize. Let's see just how much it can cost. Say a single person has a food bill of \$100 a week. Now some simple multiplication and you get \$5,200; enough to put a down payment on a car or maybe even buy a used one. This fact made me think about how I could save money and I came up with 6 important tips to remember when shopping.

1: Never shop while you are hungry. However silly this one sounds, you really should follow it. Studies have shown that people buy more and in turn spend more on food when they are hungry. (I know, "duh" right?) But really, if you are hungry while in the store, especially near the bakery or deli, you are more likely to be tempted to buy something you really don't need. If you have no other choice but to shop while you're hungry, make a list and stick to it.

2: Buying in Bulk. Many of us try to buy the biggest packs of food, toiletries, etc. because we think we are getting more for less money. While buying in bulk can help save us money on things that freeze well or have a long shelf life, it could also cost us big when buying stuff that'll spoil quickly. Which means buying foods like fresh veggies and fruits can quickly turn sour. So feel free to buy that big pack of toilet paper, so long as you really are getting a better deal, but let's leave the jumbo pack of fresh berries for the party throwers or jam makers.



3: Freezing. Ground meat, beef, poultry, fish, and bread. Freezing can keep all these food items and more, fresher longer. However freezing isn't a miracle worker, which means even frozen foods go bad. It just takes longer. As a rule of thumb never keep a frozen meat more the 6 months to a year. Remember to follow the "first in, first out" rule which can help keep your food fresh and reduce spoilage. In other words rotate the new food to the back and the older food to the front.

4: Convenience Foods. Ah, the wonders of convenience foods: snack cakes, premade dinners, chips, fast foods, etc. While they are time saving many of this choices are not healthy for us nor our wallets. Convenience foods are normally "low" cost foods like heat to eat dinners. While \$5.00 doesn't sound like a whole lot, it adds up. Buy only 7 of these savings traps and spend up to \$35 bucks. A great and healthier alternative to this is some good old home cooking. Don't know how to cook complex meals? Start simple and work your way up. There are tons of great, healthy, and simple recipes on the web for you to browse. Don't be discouraged if it starts out tough, think instead about being able to eat for pennies a day. Improve savings by making large amounts and freezing it single portioned amounts.

5: Edible Portions. This is one of my favorite tips, and can really help you save some extra money. When comparing foods like meat check to see how much of it you can really eat and how much is inedible like bone and gristle. Meat with high amounts of fat in them will shrink as they cook meaning you get less food in the end. For example compare high fat ground beef vs low fat ground turkey. When cooked the ground beef will produce more oils and will noticeably shrink in size; while many times the turkey burger will have minimal shrinkage. In short pay attention to fat content when buying meat

Fun fact: Did you know that carrots with green tops still on can be used as a whole and that that green part can even be used? What other foods can you think of that have many uses?

6: Name Brand vs. Store Brand: Buying the store brand over a name brand is at most times, is a money saver. Store brands use most, if not all, the same ingredients as do the brand name brands. Not sure if you'll like the store brand? Try it. And not just the tongue poke try, the sit down to dinner and eat it kind of try. Maybe you, and if you have one, family will like it. Another bonus tip I want to include is day old bread. Many times a store will bake more then they need for the day, and because of store policies you can get \$3.00+ bread for \$1.00 just by buying it a day after it was made. It still tastes great and is fresher then the premade big brand breads on the shelves. With so many ways out there to save money on groceries, why spend more?
