Where the Wind Blows

"Into the Storm", directed by Steven Quale, takes us on a screen ride-along with a small group of storm trackers attempting to track and document an unexpected group of disastrous storms that touchdown in the fictional town of Silverton, Oklahoma in one day, leading to a super storm. On their track they run into a father searching for his son, and amateur storm chasers while tracking and documenting the storm of a

lifetime. "Ape not kill ape" ~ Koba

"That's the biggest tornado I've ever seen" ~Pete

The film makes you wait for the storm in a slow fashion, meanwhile there are a number of side plots burrowing in to make the story seem a little bit more interesting. Including drunken storm chasers (Donk (Kyle Davis) and Reevis (Jon Reep)), a high school crush (Alicia Debnam Carey (Kaitlyn) and Max Deacon (Donnie)), a desperate father searching for his son (Richard Armitage (Gary)), and the chase for the storm of a lifetime by researchers (Sarah Wayne Callies as Allison, and Matt Walsh as Pete). Despite the nearly forgettable characters, take note this is no real documentary or 1996's "Twister". Eventually they come face to face with the super storm they were searching for and its path of CGI destruction and danger it delivers. We see the storm through the lens of professional storm chasers addicted to the thrill and the eyes of the citizens wrapped into it as they attempt to film a high school based time capsule. The storm did build-up, but it was short and less dramatic as expected when it finally arrived.

With a production budget of \$50 million and a release date of August 27th, 2014. The film so far has gathered a domestic \$39 million domestic, and \$30 million worldwide while making its 3rd day round. Not a strong movement for a summer movie, but a short debut so far for what seems like an action-drama disaster film. This film may be recommended as a weekend time filler moviegoers.





Star Search

"Guardians of the Galaxy" starring Chris Pratt (Peter Quill), Dave Bautista (Drax), Zoe Saldana (Gamora), Bradley Cooper (Rocket voice), Vin Diesel (Groot voice), and Benicio Del Toro (The Collector), Directed by James Gunn ("Slither" and "Super Fame"). The sci-fi action comedy is adapted off its original comic. After the death of Peter's mother in 1988, he flees the hospital to an open field where he is supposedly abducted by space Ravagers led by Yondu (played by Michael Rooker). Twenty-six years later we find Peter Quill aka "StarLord" attempting to steal an orb on Moraq. The orb contains an artifact known as the infinity stone that can destroy anything it touches except for the most powerful beings that may wield it...

Guardians of the Galaxy is a fun movie of five unlikely heroes, formed of thieves and enemies in hunt to ultimately obtain, and defend a world destroying artifact from the hands of Ronan (Lee Pace). Laughs combined with action can't go wrong. Deciding to sell the orb Peter has a run in with Gamora an assassin and subordinate of Ronan, then bounty Hunters Rocket and Groot, which ultimately leads them into a run-in with Nova Corps who imprisons them in Kylin, where they meet Drax. "Drax the Destroyer", a sworn enemy of Ronan, who killed his family. The group assembles a plan and escape to sell the orb unaware of its powerful contents to a collector in an outpost called Knowhere. Once they arrive, they soon learn of its immeasurable contents and others who seek its power. They build on the plot, and the film quickly throws its band of misfits into a band of heroic misfits.

"So here we are: A thief, two thugs, an assassin and a maniac, but were not going to stand by as evil wipes out the galaxy. I guess we're stuck together, partners" ~Peter Quill

Expect a sequel from Gunn in July 2017 for this \$170 million budgeted film sparking over \$502 million worldwide so far and over \$250 million domestic, not including the biggest opening weekend for August 2014 as the 14th movie of the year to pass the \$300 million dollar mark and in just less than 10 days. This PG-13 film is still an all-around "Marvel" as far as summer movies go. Coming in second to M. Night Shyamalans, "The Sixth Sense" as the biggest grossing August film.

The Never Blinking Eye

I've become the subject of criticism in the past because of my periodic and vocal insistence that someone who simply takes "snapshots" with a camera in "auto" mode by simply pressing the shutter release button is not a "photographer." I've been called arro-

shots" with a camera in "auto" mode by simply pressing the shutter release button is not a "photographer." I've been called arrogant, elitist, and less polite things at times. In the interest of honesty, this is probably somewhat deserved. I'll be the first to admit, especially when it comes to photography, I am arrogant, but I have a reason for why I feel the way I do and I want to try to share and explain that.

Merriam-Webster defines a photographer as, "a person who takes photographs especially as a job." If you follow this definition literally and strictly then someone who takes a picture with a cell phone camera on "auto" is a "photographer." They made a photo. They are a photographer in the sense that they meet the bare minimum requirement of being someone that takes pictures. But by that simple standard any child that is old enough to have convinced their parent to give them a phone with a camera on it is a photographer. If we apply that standard, we might as well say that everyone is a photographer, and at that point the word and the title lose almost all meaning. There has to be some kind of exclusivity, there have to be people who are and are not qualified to call themselves photographers or the word/title is worthless.

Indeed, the perception that anyone who can press a button is a photographer is a relatively recent development brought about by the rise of the digital age and the incorporation of automation into cameras. Before the days of digital, "intelligent" automatic modes, instant replay, and instant gratification, the layman off the street would have never dared lay claim to the title "photographer" as they knew that it wasn't simply a matter of pushing a button. It required knowledge and effort to get a good image. The problem with this is when you're shooting in "auto" mode you're not really making that photo yourself and on your own. A computer chip in that camera is making a dozen small decisions for you that you may not even be aware of that lead to and influence the final image. It's like saying that you're an author when you're really just taking dictation, or – worse yet – randomly and haphazardly mashing keys. This is also limiting to the point of being crippling from a photographic and creative standpoint. There's a limitless universe of possible images that can be created - bounded only by human imagination - but the vast majority of what can be done in photography cannot be achieved with the camera in auto. It requires an educated human mind to take the helm and master the light.

So what is a photographer? I think at this point it becomes necessary to dig a little deeper and consider what photography and a camera really is.

The coining of the word "Photography" has been attributed in 1839 to Sir John Herschel based on the Greek $\varphi \tilde{\omega} \varsigma$ (phos, genitive: phōtós) meaning "light", and $\gamma \rho \alpha \varphi \eta$ (graphê), meaning "drawing, writing", together meaning "drawing with light." You'll notice that photography is "drawing with light." Light. Not a camera. "Camera" is the Latin for "chamber" or "room," and that's all cameras originally were, special rooms designed for capturing and controlling the flow of light. In comparing photography to writing, the camera is not your pen, nor is it your ink. The camera, or rather the film or image sensor within it, is your paper. Try taking a picture with a camera in a dark room without the onboard flash. You get a black frame, no picture. That is because you're seeing the photographic equivalent of blank paper.

The "ink" in photography is light, and the pen or brush is the light source. My brushes are my strobes, speedlites, hot lights, and the sun itself. My disk reflectors, soft boxes, umbrellas, barn doors and snoots are like my colorless blenders with which I modify the flow of the ink from the brush onto the paper. It should be remarked at this point that – within the scope of this analogy – the model is not, and cannot be, the photographer's "canvas" or anything else. The model is, rightly, simply the subject of the image. Such analogies and comparisons are largely undesirable as they tend to dehumanize and devalue the model, turning him/her simply into a tool for the photographer to execute their creative vision.

It is when photography is viewed in this light that calling a snap-shooter a photographer becomes problematic. A photographer tells a story with still images through the controlled application of light. The photographer chooses and shapes light, he/she does not simply take what is given to them.

Walking up and taking a snapshot of something in front of you is like Indiana Jones making a rubbing of an ancient stone tablet or photocopying a memo at the office. This is an act of documentation, not creation.

The shooter that walks around relying exclusively on an unmodified built-in flash that came with his camera is not a photographer. If he were compared to an orator he'd be that obnoxious fellow who runs up to you and spits in your face in his excessive zeal to convey some piece of information. By using that ugly light he/she has essentially spit upon the entire scene and the resulting image. He/she has not created "art" in any sense.

So then we run into the always thorny issue of what makes someone "good enough" to be called a photographer, but I'd almost rather avoid that question entirely. Let's not make this about skill; let's make the distinction about effort, knowledge, and heart. A photographer is someone who has or is currently undertaking the task of learning about photography, lighting, composition, etc., and learning the tools and skills of this trade. They don't have to be good at it yet. A new photographer that is still rough around the edges and trying to figure out how to take quality images is still a photographer, just a novice one. This person has still made the commitment to themselves to try to learn, grow, and improve. They aren't satisfied with just pushing a button and taking what they can get.
