
Strangers Knocking

"No Good Deed" directed by Sam Miller, brings us this doorstep thriller where Colin Evans (played by Idris Elba)is up for parole after five years following a manslaughter charge and previously believed responsible for the disappearance and assumed death of five young women. A second time escapee as well as proven malignant narcissistic convict and murderer returns to his fiancée after nearly five years in prison filled with the rage that she has moved on, he is on mission to take what was taken from him.

"No Good Deed" much exposes the cliché divider between a horror movie and a thriller when tall, dark and mysterious strangers come-a-knocking in the midst of a storm. While her husband is away, Teri (Taraji P. Henson) alone with her two children invites a stranger in after he claims to be involved in a car wreck and lives in the neighborhood. While their sister, Wendy is losing touch with her husband whom she once was in love with. Though life became complicated, the Altman's learn to compromise with life's hardships. The underlying story may be you can choose your friends, but you can't choose your family. If you've ever watched "Arrested Development" you may consider the fact that Jason Bateman was perfect for the dysfunctionally functioning dramedy role to be carried on his back.



This somber view film dropped in the calm of September with a budget of \$19.8 million producing nearly \$12 million on its first weekend out. "Italian Style Chicken Zoodle Soup"

I'm gonna start this recipe by saying I'm italian and anything I make something in a big pot, there's no measuring haha. So just use you're best judgement and you're own likening, potatoes

- INGREDIENTS
- Chicken
- Zucchini
- Carrots
- Celery
- Onion
- Garlic (I like to use jarred minced garlic)
- 1 can of diced tomatoes (I like to use Hunt's fireroasted)
- 1 small can of tomato sauce
- 1 large can chicken broth
- Spices (basil, rosemary, oregano)
- 1. Fill pot halfway with water. Add chicken, carrots, celery & spices. Bring to boil. Lower heat & skim off grease water. Continue cooking on low heat.
- 2. Using a spiral slicer make your zucchini noodles.
- 3. Remove chicken from water. Remove bones & skin from chicken. Cut it into pieces and return to water.
- 4. In frying pan or sauté pan add some olive oil, diced onion & garlic. Cook a few minutes. Add zucchini. Add diced tomatoes. Cook about 5 minutes than add contents of pan to soup pot.
- 5. Add extra can of broth, alil more of spices & can of tomato sauce to soup pot. If you like bold flavor, you can also add 1-2 chicken bullion cubes. Simmer on low 30-40mins.


Wail of the Degenerates By: William C. Pittman

I'm always amazed looking back throughout history to see how often artists have been marginalized for not doing what the artistic or political establishment thought was appropriate. People that are now considered luminaries of their time often had to fight for years, if not their entire lives against people that wanted to call their work terrible and ugly, or - worse yet - "vulgar," and "inappropriate."

When I took a class in art history a few years ago I was assigned a report on Edvard Munch. For anyone that doesn't know, he's the man that painted "The Scream." He didn't have a good or easy life. He was the son of a medical officer. The family stayed poor and he had four siblings. Their mother died of tuberculosis when he was five years old so his father tended to take his son with him to work for lack of child care. Edvard was in poor health through most of his life and was surrounded by death because of his father's work. This created an environment in which Munch saw death and sickness all around him and this occurred against the backdrop of his father's religious fervor. This ultimately inspired Munch to make some really morbid, haunting images, some of which had religious undertones that are less than flattering of Christianity.

He was 80 when he died – a long life for a man born in 1863. He spent most of his last two decades on a mostly self-sufficient estate, celebrating farm life in his artwork with a steady stream of young ladies who were the subjects for many a nude painting. I wish his story ended like that and his life had ended in happiness and peace; but that's not how it ended. He died in Norway in 1944 during the terror of the Nazi occupation.

In the 1930s and 1940s the Nazis deemed the work of Munch, Picasso, Matisse, Gauguin and many others "degenerate art" and 82 of Munch's works were removed from German museums. Norway fell in 1940 and he lived the last 4 years of his life with a nearly complete collection of his life's work sitting in the second floor of his house, living in fear of the day they would come, take everything he'd ever made, destroy it and kill him; but that still wasn't good enough. When he died, his Nazi-orchestrated funeral left the impression that he was a Nazi sympathizer. It wasn't enough to take his art out of the museums or to steal his peace of mind; they tried to corrupt his legacy.



Because his art did not fit in with what they wanted or a message they agreed with, it was cast out; it was removed from the public eye; it was under threat of destruction and had to be hidden to prevent that eventuality. Because his art did not fit in with what the ruling power thought was appropriate, a man who had suffered so much hardship in his life, a man who expressed those hardships in his work without ever harming anyone else, lived and died in fear in 1944.

In 2006 I met a man I've come to really respect as an artist and value as a mentor. He's about 17 years my senior and makes stunning artwork that happens to involve sexy women in various states of undress and distress with some heavy BDSM elements mixed in. This started when he was 16 years old and he made a picture of a sexy woman, had it professionally matted and hid it behind his bedroom door where he hoped it wouldn't be found... A month later he was forced to take it down and later destroy it. Roughly 26 years



later he is nearly completely alienated from his family and they have never accepted that part of him or his artwork. This man has, in my estimation, gone through absolute hell for his art. I can't imagine going through what he has or the strength that it took to endure that. I don't think I would have been able to.


This man and his work were a great source of inspiration for me when I decided to start making a series of abstract images based on the female nude in 2010. He and his wife were a great source of perspective and support when I ventured into photography in 2011. They were great friends at a moment when I needed someone to talk to while my conservative mother was telling me she thought I was going to be arrested for taking pictures of nude women. Much of what I've accomplished with a camera might not have been possible without this couple.

Visitors to my home have at times noticed a drawing hanging on the wall in the living room. It stood out because for a long time it was one of the few things hanging on my mostly white and bare walls. It is one of his original drawings, not a print but the original work itself. He drew it based in part on a photo I took of a young woman for him to use as a reference for his artwork.

It's not a very "tame" image though. It's not the kind of thing you'd normally expect to see hanging in someone's living room and it has prompted a few people to wonder why I'd hang something like that so prominently in my home while living in a conservative state. Why would I hang something that explicit where models and conservative friends might see it and be freaked out by it? I'm going to have people thinking I'm a freak and a pervert, right?

There are two levels on which I can answer that question. One that is more particular to my friendship with this man and another that is more general and deals more with my views on art and human expression in general.

For the first, this is a drawing by a good friend. It's a drawing that I was involved in creating in my own small way. I've always been really proud of my collaboration with him and that I've had the opportunity to help him create some really stunning artwork. Hanging that image in my living room lets me brag about it and tell people about him. I really respect him.



On the second level, I like the idea of hanging it prominently because of what happened to that first drawing of his and because of artists like Munch. My friend has the right to make his work and the right to be proud of it. I have the right to create my work and be proud of it. I have the right to display whatever I want, however I want no matter how much it might offend others. That image has a right to exist. Destroying a work of art is every bit as vile as burning a book. Preventing a work from being displayed is every bit as wrong as banning a book. It's a war against ideas. It's a crime against the human heart.

I hang that image in the living room because it deserves to be seen. It shouldn't have to be hidden from the world any more than my work should have to be hidden. I hang that image in the living room because the "degenerates" need to be defended. I hang that image in the living room because the day someone can tell me that I can't put it in the living room is the day I'll know something is desperately wrong in this place. Anyone who would judge or reject me for hanging it is someone who does not know or understand this history of art and does not understand the plight of those like Munch. Anyone that would reject me for having it is someone I probably don't need and don't want in my home anyway.

Generations of artists and photographers have faced public shame, outrage, and rejection of their work because a subset of society decided it was wrong. Because those that came before and their struggle to find acceptance for their work, the second half of the 19th century and the 20th century saw a vast expansion of what is accepted as art in the public realm. But it's not over and it's never going to be over. Every artist today owes a debt to every artist that came before, that had the courage to create what they wanted, even when everyone, including their own family, was telling them they were wrong, telling them that their work was vile, or calling them evil, foolish, or simply stubborn for making it. Don't be so quick to judge and condemn the work and self-expression of others. Chances are, there was a day, there was a time, in which your work would have been rejected and condemned as well.

That's a secret! You know what they say... "Lady in the streets..."





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
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
